Welcome to our Family!

Thank you for taking the first step in helping to make more young people's dreams a reality.

Destination Florida Children's Charity organises life enhancing trips to Florida, every two years, for 72 children with life-threatening illnesses from across the North of England. The children who are nominated to join our trip are dealing with medical issues every day of their lives, so we are honoured to be able to deliver much needed joy and happiness to the children.

Coping with an illness can be a lonely place, especially when you are a child. Our team-based approach creates a mutually supportive environment, caring for the children both medically and non-medically so they have a space to thrive and can build confidence, make magical memories and form friendships for life.



All-encompassing care

High quality medical and pastoral care is provided by 110 adults throughout the time we are away in Florida. This is achieved through the delivery of a mobile hospital consisting of doctors, nurses, and physiotherapists.

Additionally, adult helpers work with the medical staff to create six 'caring teams' to enable one-to-one support to be provided for each child.

Caring for the children (who are taken on a trip) is often a full-time responsibility for their parents or guardians. Therefore, it's only the children who travel to Florida, allowing their carers a priceless eight days of respite whilst having the reassurance of knowing their child will continue to receive professional medical care.

This is so much more than just a trip to Florida...

We empower children facing the most unimaginable difficulties to put their everyday health worries to the back of their minds and embark on a journey beyond their imagination with an eight day adventure to the sunshine state – a place where dreams and happiness soar!



As you can imagine, organising a trip of this scale is huge and takes a lot of planning. The wheels are set in motion almost a year before the trip begins, starting with the volunteer applications in the November prior to the trip year.



We receive hundreds of applications which are then whittled down to 55 medical and 55 non-medical volunteers each time. All volunteers are interviewed, and DBS checked and are expected to help with fundraising in the lead up to the trip. The medical volunteers will all have paediatric qualifications and will be selected to fulfil specific roles so that every team has a full quota of lead nurses, junior nurses, physiotherapists etc.



Volunteers are split into six coloured groups, with each child and adult wearing a t-shirt in their group colour. They'll have a new t-shirt every day, each with a different logo on to represent that day's sponsor.

The VIC's (Very Important Children)

Now to the most important people – our VIC's (Very Important Children!) Nominations for child applications usually open in the December prior to a trip year and will remain open for several months. Anyone can nominate a child aged between 7 and 16 living in the North of England as long as they meet the criteria.

Our head doctor and lead nurse will visit each child and their family several times prior to the trip and will get to understand their conditions and medical history fully so that everything can be in place ahead of the trip.



If there is ever any extra equipment needed, or physical considerations that need to be made, we'll make sure we sort it so that nothing can stand in the way of these children having the best time of their lives.



The children will get to meet their matched volunteer prior to a welcome meeting, so that they can get acquainted and familiarised, as they will be the child's primary carer throughout the week.



The Welcome Meeting

We love this bit! The children all get to meet one another and spend the day together, along with the volunteers, a few weeks before the trip. Friendships are formed, and contact details are exchanged as the children are assigned their groups. This is also where we give the children their suitcases, and everything that they'll take with them. It's a really brilliant, fun day and the excitement is huge!!

We love hearing how well the children are doing and we get many children who, along with their parents, will go on to fundraise for us.

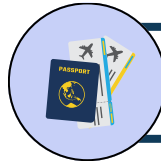


The Costs

A trip of a lifetime for children with lots of extra requirements doesn't come cheaply. We need to raise around £600,000 to fund 72 places, every two years.

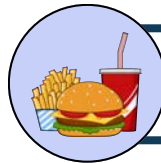
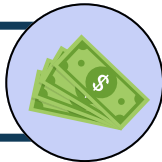
We cover all costs for the children for the entirety of the trip, from passports (if required) to suitcases, US Estas for each child, meals, snacks and drinks. All travel, accommodation and theme park passes plus spending money each day.

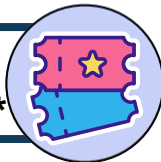

How you can help

Fundraising is a really important source of income for us, and is something that you can easily do whether you're looking to do something as an individual, as a group of friends or within the workplace. There are loads of fun ways to fundraise, but here are a few ideas to get you started...

Organise a Sweepstake

A sweepstake is a really easy way to add some competitive fun to your fundraising. It could be for a sporting event or for something as simple as guessing how many sweets are in the jar.



Hampers

You could ask your friends, family and colleagues to donate items for a hamper and then raffle it off. It could be a specific theme or seasonal.



Potty mouth?

Why not introduce a swear jar and encourage a donation for every expletive used.



Bake Sale

Who doesn't love a bake sale? Get your baking skills honed, host a competition, then sell off the cakes!





Come Dine with Me

Invite friends over for a themed charity dinner party. It could be something casual or a more formal affair – plan some games and activities/entertainment and charge accordingly. You could also run a raffle to boost profits.



Don't forget Gift Aid!

Donating through Gift Aid means charities can claim an extra 25p for every £1 you give, and, even better, it will not cost you anything extra.

You must declare that you want to donate to us through Gift Aid and that you are a UK taxpayer. This can be done on one-off, regular and sponsorship donations. All we need is your full name and home address to be able to claim this.



Fundraising 5 Top Tips

1

Plan it – Whether your fundraiser is big or small, you'll need to put quite a bit of thought into the planning stage. From the date and venue to your guest list to how many volunteers you'll need and what your estimated expenses vs profit will be. Don't forget to give yourself plenty of time to plan the event.

2

Share it – Once you have your fundraising event confirmed, share your fundraiser with friends, family and colleagues via whatsapp and social media. Spread the word and let as many people as possible know about it.

Enjoy it – By planning and prepping well in advance, you will hopefully be able to relax and enjoy the day itself. At the event, connect with people and be proud of what you have achieved.

Celebrate it – After your event, celebrate how much you've raised and thank everyone who has helped. Feel proud of the impact you've made to a local charity through all your hard work!

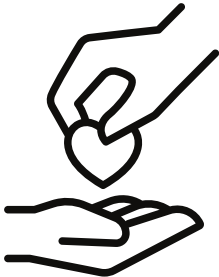


How we can help you

Important factors

Food and Alcohol

If you are providing food and drink at an event, it is worth visiting the Food Standards Agency for guidance on preparing food. Caterers will also need to provide their food hygiene certificates and Public Liability Insurance. Visit www.food.gov.uk for more information.

Fundraising literature

If you are designing posters or leaflets to promote your event, please make sure that you use our logo and include our registered charity number: 1003674. Our logo can be downloaded from our website, but please do not stretch it or change it in any way.

Street collection

If you are planning on holding a collection in the street as part of your fundraising, you will need to apply for a Street Collection Licence from the local authority. Visit www.gov.uk/street-collection-license for more information. You are not permitted to collect cash door-to-door.

Health and Safety

If you are organising a large scale or physical event you will need to make sure that you have first aid cover. Organisations such as St John's Ambulance or the British Red Cross can help you to determine the type of cover you'll need.

Raffles

There are strict rules surrounding the running of raffles. If you are selling raffle tickets you will need a license regardless of when the raffle is drawn. This can be covered under our raffles and lottery license, but you must complete the licensing form within 90 days of the completion of a raffle. Please contact our office and we can send you the form via email. We can also supply raffle ticket books should you need them.

Insurance

If your event involves the public, you will need to make sure that you have Public Liability Insurance. Your venue may already have this so check with them first.

Branding and Event Guidance

If you're planning on running an event in aid of Destination Florida Children's Charity, firstly, thank you so much! If we could just ask that you let us know what you're planning ahead of the event, either by emailing us at info@destinationflorida.org.uk or calling us on 0161 789 7788.

Hughie's Story

“IT'S A ONCE IN A LIFETIME OPPORTUNITY”



Hughies trip to Florida!

13 year-old Hughie Higginson captured the hearts of many when he was awarded the Pride of Britain's Good Morning Britain Young Fundraiser of the Year and the Pride of Manchester Fundraiser of the Year in 2021.

Despite his battle with leukaemia, Hughie's determination to make a difference has been recognised and celebrated. Together with his best friend Freddie, Hughie raised a remarkable £300,000 in gratitude to the doctors and nurses at the Royal Manchester Children's Hospital.

His battle with acute lymphoblastic leukaemia began in September 2020 and thankfully Hughie was given the-all clear in January 2024. Hughie was one of 74 children who went on our 2023 trip, whilst he was still in the middle of his treatment. On learning he was selected to go on the trip to Florida, Hughie expressed "it's a once in a lifetime opportunity"

Payroll Giving

A regular donation through your salary is a great way to support us.

Payroll Giving allows you to directly donate from your salary before tax is deducted. This means if you give £10 a month to us and you are a basic rate tax payer, the gift will only cost you £8 from your net pay.

If you pay a higher rate of tax, £10 a month will only cost you £6 from your net pay, but in each case, the charity would still receive £10.


