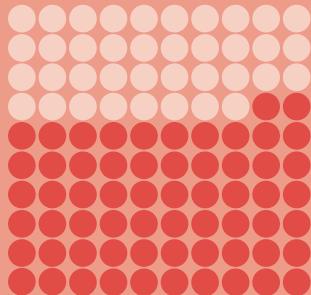

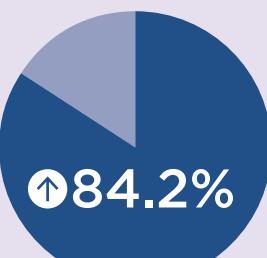

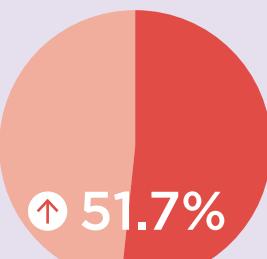

# Art

## ● INTRODUCTION

**My ministry sits at the intersection of art, faith, and formation. Over the last year, my focus has been on using my skills as an artist to create work that carries a clear Christian witness, while still functioning honestly and rigorously as art. This has meant resisting the pressure to make work that is merely illustrative or decorative, and instead trusting God to meet people through strong, thoughtful, materially grounded work.**

What feels close to the Lord's heart in this area is the renewal of the imagination: helping people to imagine again, to slow down, and to encounter Christ in ways that move beyond explanation into attentiveness. Exhibitions such as The Image of Christ have become spaces oriented toward formation, where reflection and prayer emerge naturally, precisely because they allow art to do what it does best: hold attention, invite contemplation, and make room for the presence of God.

This ministry continues to grow through exhibitions, sculptural works in shared spaces, and commissioned pieces, as well as through teaching that helps others learn how to read and engage art and culture in a Christian way. Throughout, the emphasis remains on faithfulness in craft and obedience in calling, trusting that this work will bear fruit over time.

## ● VISION FOR THE FUTURE

**My vision is for this work to be shaped by long-term formation rather than short-term output.**

I see this ministry maturing into a coherent and accessible body of teaching, practice, and presence centred on art, imagination, and formation. This includes a growing body of writing and teaching that can be shared through local churches, creative communities, and resources made available online, serving both artists and ordinary believers who are seeking a deeper integration of faith and creativity.

A key part of this vision is the continued development of short, formative courses, such as Art, Faith & the renewal of the Imagination. These courses are intended for people across a wide range of vocations who desire to reawaken creativity as part of their spiritual formation and daily practice.

Over time, this work aims to cultivate a network of creative practitioners who have journeyed with this content and are applying it within their own contexts, including churches, schools, studios, and spaces beyond the church. There is a growing sense that some of this work will also reach into more secular environments, where practices such as visual reflection, journaling, and attentiveness can open unexpected conversations and points of connection.

Within this broader vision, the campus itself continues to serve as a living model: a place where art, worship, and education are intentionally held together, and where shared spaces and permanent works reveal something of the kingdom's creativity over time.

## HIGHLIGHTS IN 2025

### IMAGE OF CHRIST EXHIBITION



**The Image of Christ exhibition** continued to bear fruit through its installation in multiple church contexts. In 2025, the exhibition was hosted for an extended period at Lighthouse Church, where it remained on display for approximately three months and had a deep pastoral and congregational impact. Following this, the exhibition has been invited to Highway Church, where it will be shown as part of the Easter season in April. The continued invitation and relocation of this work affirms its effectiveness as a space for reflection, and Christ-centred formation.



### THE WINDS OF GRACE SCULPTURE

**The Winds of Grace sculpture** was permanently installed on campus.

## ● 2026 KEY INITIATIVES

**A key initiative for 2026 is the extension of the Art, Faith, and Renewal of Imagination work beyond explicitly church-based contexts and into more public and cultural spaces. This includes exploring the possibility of hosting a month-long exhibition and workshop-based engagement in a rented venue within the city, creating a space where contemporary art, Christian imagination, and spiritual formation are held together in a confident and unapologetic way.**

The intention of this initiative is presence, offering an alternative vision within the contemporary cultural landscape that is grounded in faith, attentiveness, and integrity of craft.

As this initiative currently sits outside of the existing budget, it represents a faith project, one that seeks to make a meaningful cultural contribution through strong contemporary art and thoughtful Christian presence.

### INTRODUCTION

**In a world of much chaos, pain and injustice, ReStory Business exists to journey with leaders, through their businesses by connecting them to purpose – their originally intended purpose.**

*Three ideas can be used to describe this journey:*

1

#### **The Blindfold of “Babylon”**

Many people are unaware of where today's culture is leading us. Rather than living a life towards a restless soul, we aim to show leaders a better way. To find a better way, we must direct our lives toward what truly matters in God – relationships, creativity, meaning – we must choose less noise and more presence.

#### **The Connected Church**

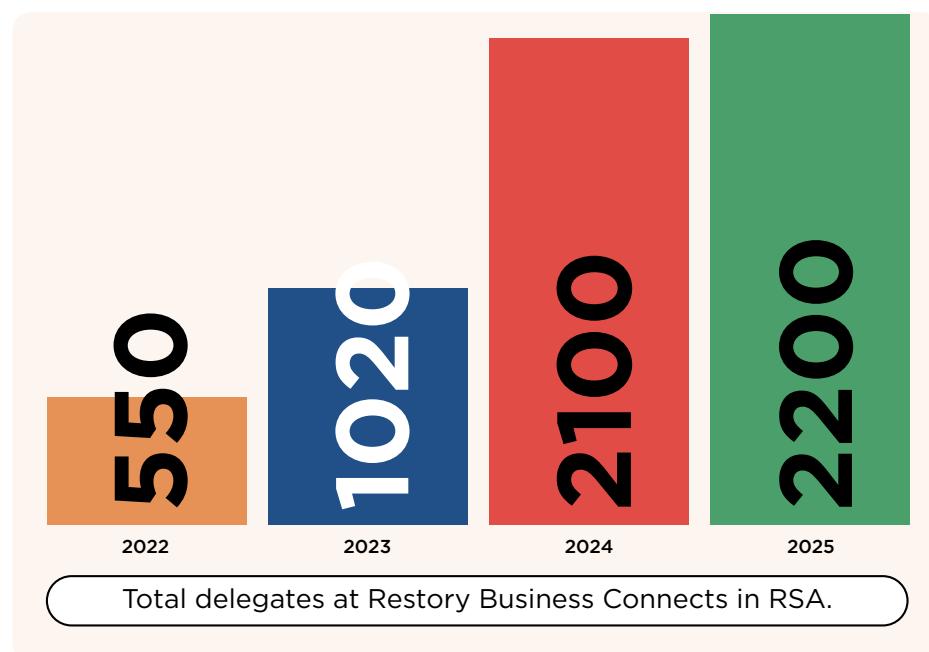

### Building a Social Capital Network

Social capital is a powerful and often overlooked form of capital. It refers to the actual and potential resources inherent to high-trust relationships within a connected community. In 2025, ReStory Business entered into a partnership with Love Our City through the Re:Story Together pilot project. The pilot project has employed a participatory change model that has engaged South Africa's Department of Education, public and private education leaders, business stakeholders and local community role-players committed to advancing quality

primary and secondary education in underserved communities in South Africa. The project's aim is to demonstrate how increasing the moral engagement of leaders across diverse social-relational networks can leverage social capital to break the vicious cycle of an inequitable education system, and begin addressing some of the challenges being faced in South Africa's (SA) and Sub-Saharan Africa's (SSA) education systems. Together, we can change the narrative and **restory** education on our continent.

**15 million shortage**

of teachers in Sub-Saharan Africa to reach the 2030 development goals.

**80% of teachers**

lack the content knowledge and pedagogical to teach their current subjects.

**94% of children**

in Sub-Saharan Africa have less than the basic skills from their education.

**49% of the workforce**

will retire in the next decade - SA currently has a 31 000 deficit, with an increasing net deficit of 10 000 p.a.

**1 in 7 children suffer**

major psychological problems; ranging from anxiety disorders to suicidal thoughts.

**69% of teachers**

have a medium to high degree of job-related stress (before COVID-19).

## **Love Our City**

### **INTRODUCTION**

**Ephesians 2:8-10 - Good works are not the cause of our salvation, but rather are, as Spurgeon states, “the great end of salvation”. We do not have to create or conjure them up, but have the joy and responsibility of walking into that which God has prepared in advance for us. We feel that we have had this joy over the past few years; uncovering and walking into what God has prepared in advance and stewarding this alongside the relationships and resources He has given. In the upcoming years we continue to align our pursuits to what God has revealed and purposed.**

We have restructured our approach this past year, focusing in the next three years on Education under the Re:Storying Education banner with the three pillars of Re:Futures (learner intervention and wellness); Re:Legacy (teacher support and wellness); and Re:Together (school transformation and leadership

journey). Our primary focus for the next three years is seeing transformation in the schools in our network, building the relationships and infrastructure to support these schools and open up avenues for the prophesied impact on education in our nation.

### **VISION FOR THE FUTURE**

- **3 Community Hubs - Kya Sands, Cosmo, and Diepsloot: Kya Sands operational and Cosmo and Diepsloot being initiated.** These will operate as a space for ourselves and other like-minded Non-Profit Organisations to provide services and interventions to the communities, particularly to support the schools in our network with some of the socio-economic challenges faced by their learners and thereby lifting the burden off their shoulders and placing it on the organisations that are equipped and experienced in the various socio-economic issues impacting learners and their families.
- **A further 5 schools on the Re:Storying Together journey with all 8 schools having established active advisory boards (Ibandlas).**
- **900 teachers impacted by Re:Story Legacy.**
- **100% eradication of period poverty in our schools.**
- **Mobile Library initiative active in all schools in our network that don't have a formal library.**

### **2026 KEY INITIATIVES**

**With registration as a PBO with SARS and the ability to apply for corporate social investment we are trusting for an amount of R2 million this year to extend our reach and allow us to work beyond what the church is able to fund, in particular for:**

- A laser cutter for Sustain Her
- Security, solar power and renovation for the first Community Hub
- School grounds and renovation
- Mentorship Journey for Takane Academy ECD; and
- Re:Story Together Leadership Training

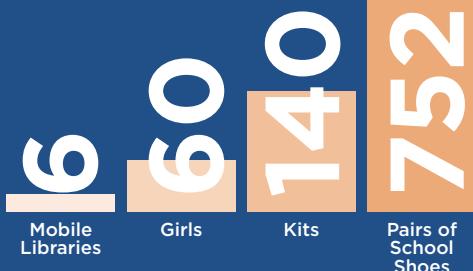

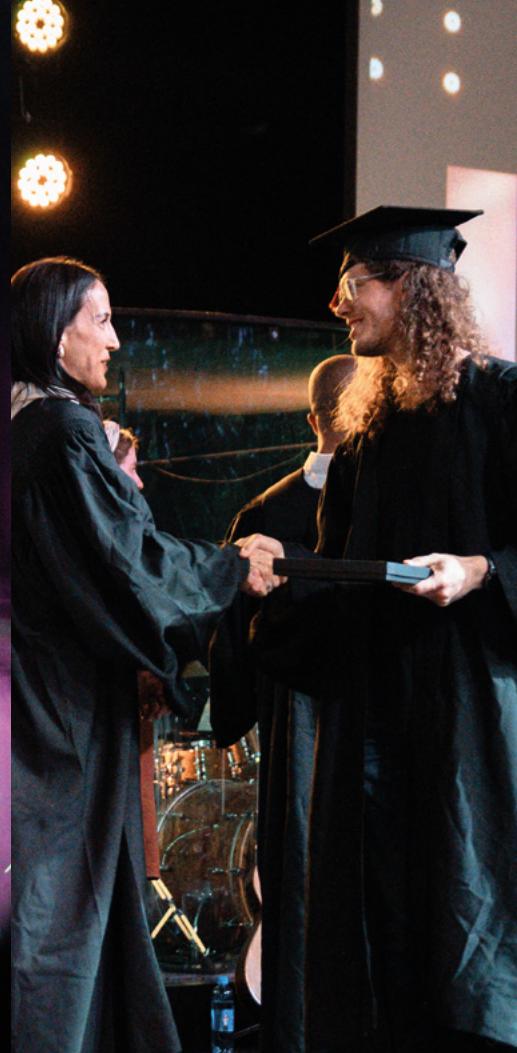

## INTRODUCTION

**WHEN I THINK OF WHAT GOD HAS BUILT AT OUR ADDRESS,  
I IMMEDIATELY THINK OF SOIL AND FRUIT, COUPLED  
TOGETHER WITH A TRELLIS AND VINE.**

We have become an 'Apostolic Hub', i.e. a community who faithfully gather to discern, release and send. We can be best described as a 'Missional Anchor. A place that holds people steady—so they can be sent far. Our leadership has always been committed to being a House with Open Hands. This is evidenced by our generosity, trust, and obedience to the Holy Spirit. By being a Holy Spirit-led sending community we keep agency with The Holy Spirit, not an institution. In recent times we have felt harmony with the idea of NCCB being an altar in the city, given relevance to being a worship fueled sending community.

Our clear reference to all of the above is found in Acts 13:2-4 (AMP) 'While they were worshiping the Lord and fasting, the Holy Spirit said, Separate now for Me Barnabas and Saul for the work to which I have called them. Then after fasting and praying, they put their hands on them and sent them away. So then, being sent out by the Holy Spirit, they went down to Seleucia, and from [that port] they sailed away to Cyprus.'

Safe to say that an NCCB with all its ministry expressions in harmony and movement, in full swing, will look like this:

- **"A Sending House like Antioch"**
- **"A Spirit-Led Sending Church"**
- **"A Rooted, Diverse, Sending Community"**
- **"An Antioch-Shaped Church for the Nations"**
- **"A Home Church with a Global Horizon"**

***Let's name it, repeat it, and build with it.***

Our calling has been made clear in Isa 54:2-3 (AMP) 'Enlarge the place of your tent, and let the curtains of your habitations be stretched out; spare not; lengthen your cords and strengthen your stakes, for you will spread abroad to the right hand and to the left; and your offspring will possess the nations and make the desolate cities to be inhabited.' This encourages us to be a courageous and faith-filled people, committed to living lives of release and surrender.

**THE AIM OF THE TRANS-LOCAL MINISTRY IS TO REACH OUT FROM THE BASE CHURCH TO AREAS OUTSIDE OF JOHANNESBURG AND INTO AFRICA. THE AIM IS TO PREACH THE GOSPEL MESSAGE TO RURAL COMMUNITIES, ESTABLISH CHURCH LEADERSHIP, EQUIP LEADERS AND TRAIN COMMUNITIES ON SUSTAINABLE FARMING PRINCIPLES.**

Since Covid, NCCBs global mission expression hasn't been as prolific as it once was. Moving forward, this is something that we want to change. Being a missional Church is not an optional extra, the Great Commission makes this clear. In 2025 we have been partnering with individuals in the mission field with whom we have long standing relationships with, seeking where we as a community can get involved.

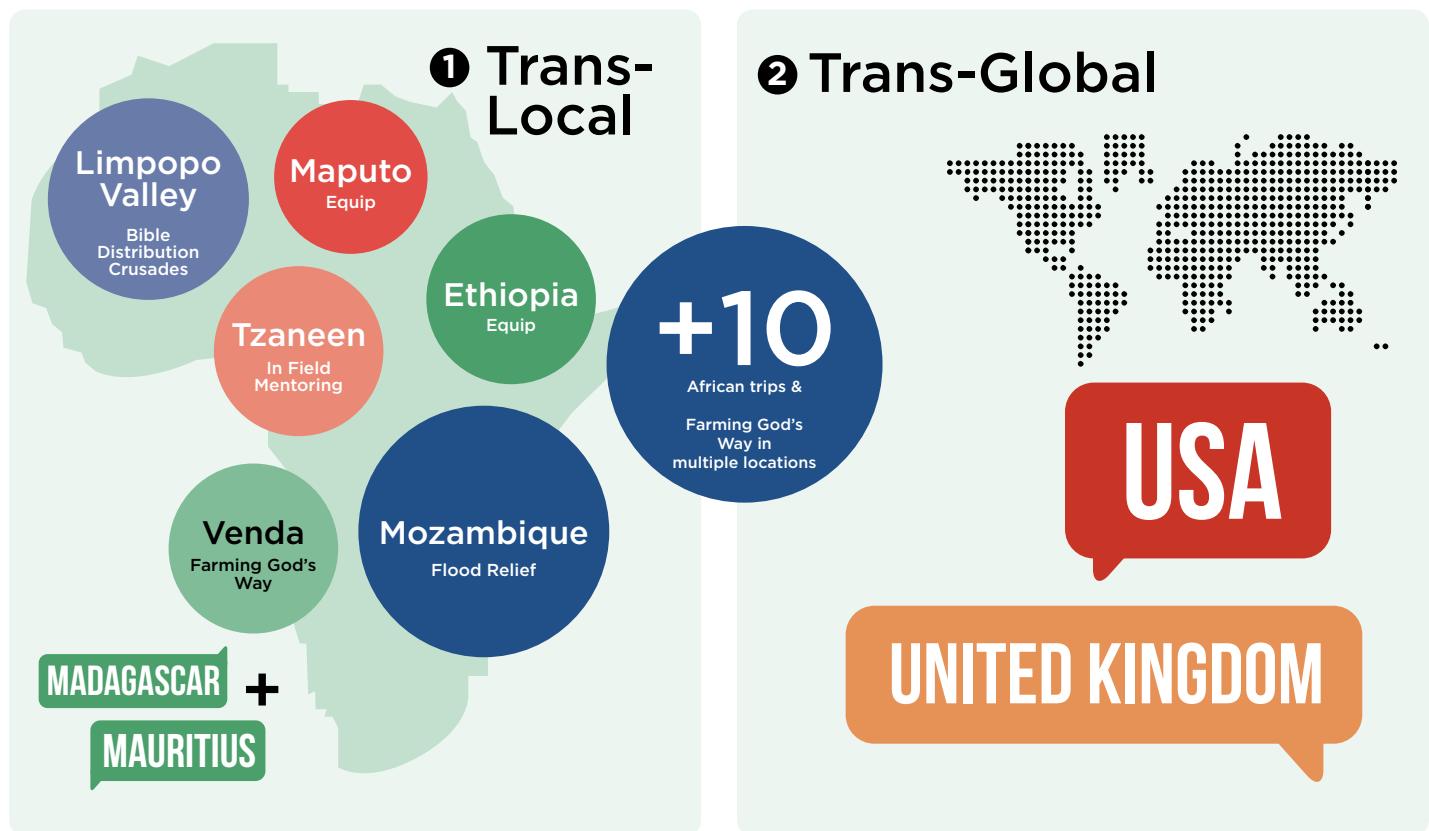
## ● 2026 KEY INITIATIVES

We want our community to be one that takes seriously the Great Commission. Going from our Jerusalem, to our Judea and Samaria and then to the ends of the earth. The priority for 2026 is for us to be well established with multiple mission sites globally and to have our NCCB community to be both aware of and involved in what we are doing missionally.

- We are trusting Jesus to build momentum on what He did during 2025. We hope to focus on the Limpopo Valley of Mozambique again. We are also looking to do leadership training and open-air crusades in the Maputo and Inhambane areas again and potentially expand into other areas. Recently opportunities opened to Zambia and Angola which we are keen to explore.
- Jonathan and Lyn Bremner have been faithfully stewarding the Farming God's Way initiative for many years, carrying their own expenses to travel into areas of South Africa and further north into Africa.
- 10+ African trips through the year focussing on leadership training, crusades etc.
- Farming God's Way in multiple locations throughout the year.
- Trips to the USA & UK.

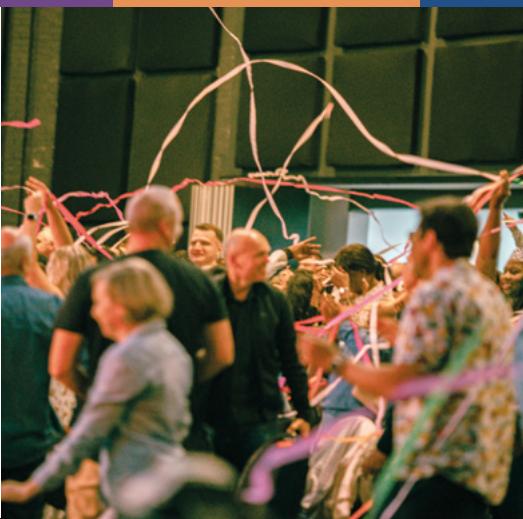
