



Contractor of Records Service Terms and Conditions Use

Date of entry into force: 9 March 2026

Scope and Relationship with General Terms

These Contractor of Record Service Terms and Conditions (these "Product Terms") govern solely the Contractor of Record service (the "CoR Service") provided by TMS SolarWeb Limited through the Mellow platform (the "Platform"). These Product Terms are "Product Terms" for the purposes of, and are supplemental to, the Platform General Terms of Use (the "General Terms").

These Product Terms apply only within the scope of the CoR Service and do not apply to any other services accessible through the Platform.

In the event of any conflict or inconsistency between the General Terms and these Product Terms, the documents shall be construed as applying within their respective scopes. To the extent that a matter is expressly regulated by these Product Terms in connection with the CoR Service, these Product Terms shall prevail solely for the CoR Service. In all other cases, the General Terms shall apply.

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DEFINITIONS
For the purposes of these Product Terms the following definitions shall have the following meanings:
" Customer " means a legal entity or an individual entrepreneur that registers on the Platform for business or professional purposes and enters into a Customer Agreement in connection with the CoR Service..
" Operator " means TMS SolarWeb Limited , a company duly registered and operating under the laws of the Republic of Cyprus under registration No. HE 329931, registered at: Cyprus, Limassol 3030, Theklas Lysioti 17, PISSAS BUILDING, 5&6 th floor, and its subsidiaries and affiliates if applicable.
" CoR Service " means the Contractor of Record service provided by the Operator, as described in the applicable Customer Agreement and/or Subcontractor agreement and the relevant functionality within the Platform enabling contracting, administration, compliance, and payments workflows in connection with such service..
" Platform " means the online platform made available via URL https://www.mellow.io and any associated subdomains, and the Mellow mobile application, through which one or more services (including the CoR Service) may be accessed.
" Personal Profile " means the account (profile) created on the Platform and used to access and use the CoR Service.
" Sanctions " means any laws or regulations relating to economic or financial, trade, immigration, aircraft, shipping or other sanctions, export controls, trade embargoes or restrictive measures from time to time imposed, administered or enforced by a Sanctions Authority.
" Sanctions Authority " the EU, the USA, the UK, the United Nations (UN) and any other governmental authority with jurisdiction over the Parties or any part of its business or operations, and in each case their respective governmental, judicial or regulatory institutions, agencies, departments and authorities responsible for the implementation and enforcement of sanctions, including (without limitation) the Council of the European Union, the Office of Foreign Assets Control (OFAC) of the US Department of the Treasury, Her Majesty's Treasury, the UK's Office of Financial Sanctions Implementation, the UN Security Council.
" Sanctions List " any of the lists issued or maintained by a Sanctions Authority designating or identifying persons that are subject to Sanctions, in each case as amended, supplemented or substituted from time to time, including (without limitation) the EU Sanctions List, the OFAC Sanctions List, the UK Sanctions List, Consolidated List of Financial Sanctions Targets in the UK and the Consolidated United Nations Security Council Sanctions List.
" Sanctions Proceedings " any actual or threatened: • litigation, arbitration, settlement or other proceedings (including alternative dispute resolution, criminal and administrative proceedings); or



- investigation, inquiry, enforcement action (including the imposition of fines or penalties) by any governmental, administrative, regulatory or similar body or authority,
- in each case relating to, or in connection with, any actual or alleged contravention of Sanctions.

"Sanctions Target" a person that is:

- listed on a Sanctions List;
- owned or controlled by a person listed on a Sanctions List;
- resident, domiciled or located in, or incorporated or organised under the laws of, a country or territory that is subject to any Sanctions;
- otherwise identified by a Sanctions Authority as being subject to Sanctions.

"Subcontractor" means an individual, or an individual entrepreneur, or an individual registered as self-employed person or having another status under the laws applicable to such person, who registers on the Platform and enters into the Subcontractor agreement applicable to the CoR Service.

GENERAL PROVISIONS

1. Introduction and Acceptance

These Product Terms establish the principles and conditions of use of the CoR Service provided by the Operator through the Platform. These Product Terms constitute a legally binding agreement between the person accepting these Product Terms (whether acting as a natural person or as an authorised representative of a legal entity) and the Operator with respect to the CoR Service.

By accessing or using the CoR Service, or by entering into any agreement in connection with the CoR Service through the Platform, the Customer and/or Subcontractor (as applicable) acknowledges that it has read, understood and agrees to be legally bound by these Product Terms.

2. Description and Definition of the CoR Service

For the purposes of these Product Terms, the CoR Service includes the workflows, tools and functionality within the Platform that are made available by the Operator in connection with the Contractor of Record service, including the creation and administration of Personal Profiles, onboarding and compliance steps, the creation and administration of engagements, and payment and document workflows to the extent they relate to the CoR Service.

Use of the Platform outside the scope of the CoR Service is governed by the General Terms and/or other applicable product terms.

3. Scope and Applicability

These Product Terms apply solely to the CoR Service. These Product Terms are incorporated by reference into, and form part of, the contractual documents governing the CoR Service entered into through the Platform, including (as applicable) the Customer agreement(s) applicable to the CoR Service and the Subcontractor agreement(s) applicable to the CoR Service.

These Product Terms do not apply to any other services available on or through the Platform unless expressly stated in the relevant product terms applicable to such services

4. Registration and User Profile Requirements



By registering on the Platform, You agree to these Product Terms by actively selecting the corresponding checkbox during the registration process. Such acceptance constitutes a legally binding agreement between You and the Operator from the moment of acceptance.

The Customer acknowledges and agrees that information provided in the Personal Profile forms part of the operational records of the CoR Service and may be relied upon by the Operator for the purposes of providing the CoR Service, compliance, billing, and record-keeping. For the avoidance of doubt, the enforceability of these Product Terms is not conditional upon completion of any particular Personal Profile fields, provided that access to certain features of the CoR Service may be restricted unless the required information is provided.

You further agree that upon completing Your Personal Profile, the updated information will be incorporated into and considered part of these Product Terms. The Terms remain legally binding from the moment of initial acceptance, with Your full and updated data being deemed as an integral part of these Product Terms.

5. Rules for Use and User Representations

By accepting these Product Terms and agreeing to be bound by them, You agree that Your access and use of the CoR Service must be at all times performed in strict accordance with the following rules:

- You must use the CoR Service in accordance with its designated purpose only;
- Your accessing and use of the CoR Service must be performed by You in full compliance with these Product Terms, other applicable documents related to the CoR Service and all applicable laws (including but not limited to legislation and regulations regarding economic sanctions, anti-money laundering, combating terrorist financing, anti-corruption);
- You must always provide correct, true, current, and complete information about Yourself and parties You represent, whichever is applicable;
- You must not perform any action listed in the "*Restrictions*" section of these Product Terms.

By accepting these Product Terms and agreeing to be bound by them, You represent and warrant that You have not been included in any trade embargo or any international and/or economic sanctions list as published from time to time by applicable international bodies and/or government authorities of any country concerned, and You do not intend to use the CoR Service neither for the benefit of any sanctioned person nor for the acquisition/delivering/providing goods or services which are subject to an export or import ban under applicable laws of any country concerned.

USER ELIGIBILITY

1. Eligibility for Subcontractors/Principals

If You intend to use the CoR Service as a Subcontractor/ Principal under Agency Agreement for Managing of Agreements with Customers, You must have reached the minimum age required to independently enter into civil transactions under the laws of Your country of residence. At that if You are a minor in the jurisdiction of your residence, You shall obtain all necessary permissions and consents for performance of Works and/or rendering of Services under this Offer Agreement if such are required under the applicable laws. The Operator reserves the right to report use of the CoR Service by minors to the appropriate officials.

2. Eligibility for Customers

If You intend to use the CoR Service as a Customer, You must be duly authorized by the legal entity You represent to register with the CoR Service and use its functionality. The Operator reserves the right to



investigate attempts of use of the CoR Service by parties not officially authorized to represent legal entities these parties claim to represent and report such attempts to the appropriate officials.

1. Registration Data and Identity Verification

Depending on Your intended use of the CoR Service (i.e. as a Subcontractor or as a Customer) You may be asked to provide certain registration details and personal data for identity verification in order to access the CoR Service and use the CoR Service.

2. KYC Compliance and Due Diligence

By agreeing to these Product Terms, when You register as a user of the CoR Service or at any time in the future after Your registration, you accept that KYC compliance procedure in relation to a user of the CoR Service, including the user's identity verification, may be required in certain cases and in this regard You authorize the Operator to undertake these compliance checks on You, either directly or by using relevant third party service providers which on the Operator's behalf will carry out such verifications, and/or by using third party databases and other sources. The Operator reserves the right to monitor and review on an ongoing basis any information You provided as necessary to satisfy any applicable law, regulation, sanctions program, embargo, legal process, or competent authorities' request. You authorize the Operator to request necessary information and conduct necessary investigations directly or through third party service providers to (i) protect the Operator, General Contractor, CoR Service's business partners, Customers and Subcontractors from any illegal activities to which the CoR Service may be exposed, (ii) in case there is a suspicion of money laundering, terrorist financing, fraud, other illegal activities conducted through the CoR Service, (iii) verify the information You provided (if necessary, including but not limited to, Your residential address, specialization and payment-related information) and Your information against third party databases and other sources, (iv) meet goals set in the "*Consent to Monitor*" section of these Product Terms, or (v) as required by applicable laws. You also agree that for these purposes additional information about Yourself (including but not limited to information about Your business, professional experience, expertise in relation to works and services to be performed or performed under a relevant agreement on performance of works and rendering of services) may be requested by the Operator at any time considered necessary and You agree to cooperate with all reasonable requests made by the Operator and You permit the Operator to keep records of such information. The Operator will collect and process such information in accordance with CoR Service's Privacy Policy. You also expressly agree that in case of failure to verify Your identity (whatever the reason) or to provide the relevant information, or in case there is a good reason to suspect that you are behaving fraudulently and/or criminally or that Your use of the CoR Service could damage CoR Service's reputation, the Operator has the right to refuse, suspend or terminate Your access to the CoR Service or any of its resources and to suspend or terminate Your Personal Profile at any time.

3. Update and Maintenance of Information

You expressly agree that all of the information You provide upon registration with the CoR Service must be correct, true, current, and complete, and agree to timely update any information You provide to the Operator to maintain the integrity and accuracy of the information, and also provide any other additional documents and information on reasonable request made by the Operator and/or as required under applicable laws.

If the Customer is located in, or otherwise subject to tax regulations of, the United States, the Customer must provide a complete, accurate, and up-to-date physical address (including state and local details, where applicable) prior to creating any tasks. The Customer expressly acknowledges and agrees that the provided address is used to determine the applicability, rate, and calculation of U.S. sales tax. The CoR Service is not responsible for any incorrect tax calculation, reporting, or charging resulting from inaccurate, incomplete, or outdated address information provided by the Customer.

If the Customer is located in, or otherwise subject to tax regulations of, the European Union, the Customer must provide a valid and correct VAT identification number prior to creating any tasks. The Customer expressly acknowledges and agrees that CoR Service applies the VAT number only starting



from the VAT reporting period in which such VAT number was provided; and any VAT number submitted or updated after the start of a reporting period shall not apply retroactively to prior periods, transactions, invoices, or other finalized documents.

4. Consequences of Providing False Information

Providing misleading or false information about Your identity is forbidden and constitutes a material breach of these Product Terms. If the Operator believes that the information You provide is not correct, truthful, current, or complete, or is false or misleading, the Operator has the right to refuse, suspend or terminate Your access to this CoR Service or any of its resources and to suspend or terminate Your Personal Profile at any time.

CUSTOMER PERSONAL PROFILE REGISTRATION AND ADMINISTRATION

1. Creation of the Customer Personal Profile by the Customer Representative

A representative of the Customer ("**Customer Representative**") creates a Personal Profile of the Customer on behalf of the respective Customer. The Operator shall verify the identity of the Customer Representative and assess his/her authority to accept these Product Terms on behalf of the Customer. The Customer Representative, by completing the registration, expressly represents and warrants that he/she has the necessary authority to bind the Customer to these Product Terms.

2. Management of Affiliated Customers

The CoR Service allows a single Personal Profile to be used for multiple affiliated legal entities ("**Affiliated Customers**"). Within the Personal Profile, the Customer Representative may add and manage multiple Affiliated Customers and switch between them as necessary. The Operator shall verify the authority of the Customer Representative to act on behalf of each Affiliated Customer added to the Customer Personal Profile and to accept these Product Terms on their behalf. The Customer Representative shall ensure that all information provided regarding the Affiliated Customers is accurate, complete, and up to date.

3. Changing the Customer Representative

If the Customer appoints a new Customer Representative for its Personal Profile, the following steps collectively constitute an amendment to these Product Terms, recognizing the substitution of the Customer Representative: (i) The current Customer Representative sends a written request to the Operator to replace them with a new Customer Representative, specifying the details of the new Customer Representative, (ii) The Operator successfully verifies the identity and authority of the new Customer Representative and grants them access to the Customer Personal Profile, (iii) The new Customer Representative accesses the Customer Personal Profile and begins using it.

Upon the completion of all three steps, the replacement of the Customer Representative shall be deemed a binding amendment to these Product Terms between the Customer, the Operator, and the new Customer Representative. The Customer remains responsible for ensuring that the new Customer Representative complies with these Product Terms.

TEAM MANAGEMENT AND TASK ASSIGNMENT

1. Creation and Notification of Customer Tasks

The Customer, upon registration in the CoR Service and entering into its Personal Profile, can create a team of Subcontractors, and thereafter upon invitation of the Subcontractors into the team, the Customer can make tasks for execution by a Subcontractor. Upon creation by the Customer of a respective task at its Personal Profile, the Subcontractor receives at its email a notification of new task receipt. At that the task is in "*not confirmed*" status.

2. API Integration and Responsibility for Task Transfer

If the Customer creates a team of Subcontractors by means of API method (API protocol, hereafter referred to as "API"), the Customer undertakes to ensure that each Subcontractor of such a team read, accepted, and executed the terms of the Subcontractor Offer Agreement on Performance of Works and Rendering of Services prior to their use of the CoR Service, as well as the Subcontractor is in compliance with and follows the terms



of the Subcontractors Offer Agreement on Performance of Works and Rendering of Services in their subsequent accessing or using the CoR Service. At that, in case of transfer of tasks via API, the Customer undertakes risks independently for correct execution and acceptance of tasks by Subcontractors, as well as for the transfer of rights under these tasks. In addition, the Customer undertakes to ensure the identity verification of the Subcontractors in accordance with the rules of the CoR Service on mandatory identity verification and to cooperate with the Operator in passing the KYC compliance procedure by the Customer's team of Subcontractors and/or in providing information at the request of the competent authorities or payment partners of the Operator.

3. Formation of a Subcontractor Team

The Subcontractor upon registration in the CoR Service and entering its Personal Profile has the option to create a team of Subcontractors (by inviting Subcontractors to the CoR Service). Each Subcontractor invited to join the team must register with Mellow in accordance with the procedure set forth in these Product Terms. A list of all Subcontractors invited to the team is displayed in the "Team" section of the Personal Profile of the Subcontractor who created the team.

Upon creation by the Customer of a respective task for execution by the Subcontractor, the Customer undertakes to request exclusively the work / service type which is selected. The Subcontractor, upon acceptance of such task, undertakes to perform exclusively the accepted work / service type. Any deviation by the Customer or the Subcontractor from the selected service type is prohibited and shall entitle the Operator to immediately terminate Your access to the CoR Service or any of its resources and to suspend or terminate Your Personal Profile at any time and claim compensation for any and all losses, damages, costs or expenses arising from such breach. In case of fraudulent conduct, the Operator reserves the right to notify and cooperate with the competent law-enforcement authorities, without prior notice.

PRIVACY, PERSONAL DATA AND COOKIE POLICY

The information required to be provided in connection with Your use of the CoR Service may include certain personal data. Collection, use and processing of Your personal data by the Operator, as well as the applicable cookie file policy, are governed by the Privacy Policy, available at <https://mellow.io/documents/privacy-policy> and Cookies Policy available at <https://mellow.io/documents/cookie-policy>.

You represent, warrant, and agree that when You provide the Operator or the CoR Service with information about third parties- y -subjects of personal data (including your Customer, Subcontractor, and persons invited to the team of Subcontractors), You have a legal basis for such disclosure and You have complied with all applicable legal requirements (including obtaining all required notices or consents, where consent is the appropriate legal basis)

INFORMATION DISCLOSURE

By accepting these Product Terms, You authorize the Operator to disclose information related to Your use of the CoR Service ("User Information"), including confidential and commercially sensitive information, to third parties as specified below. Such authorized disclosures shall not constitute a breach of any confidentiality obligations under these Product Terms, Customer Agreements, Offer Agreements, or any other agreements between You and the Operator, or You and other companies of the Operator's group (as applicable), and You hereby explicitly waive any claims regarding a breach of confidentiality that You might have under relevant agreements between You and a company of the Operator's group (as applicable). These disclosure provisions supersede and take precedence over any contrary or inconsistent confidentiality provisions contained in any other agreement between You and the Operator or You and a company of the Operator's group.

User Information includes contracts and all related documentation, financial and transactional data, including payment history, balances, and fund movements, business communications and correspondence, technical usage data, tax status and all related documentation, documents required for KYC/AML/CTF purposes, and other commercial information processed through the CoR Service.

The Operator may disclose User Information to:

- (i) any company within the Operator's group, subsidiaries, affiliates, or parent companies;
- (ii) banks, financial institutions and payment service providers;



- (iii) third-party service providers, contractors, and agents performing services for the CoR Service;
- (iv) business partners involved in the provision of the CoR Service;
- (v) professional advisors, including lawyers, auditors, accountants, and consultants;
- (vi) compliance and verification service providers (KYC/AML/CTF service providers, sanctions screening providers, identity verification services);
- (vii) regulatory authorities, governmental bodies, law enforcement agencies, and courts in any jurisdiction when required.

Disclosures may be made for:

- (i) compliance with laws, regulations, court orders, or governmental requests;
- (ii) performance of compliance procedures (KYC, AML, CTF, sanctions screening) and prevention, detection, and investigation of illegal activities including fraud, money laundering, and terrorist financing;
- (iii) provision of the CoR Service;
- (iv) protection of the Operator's rights, property, safety, or legitimate interests;
- (v) fulfillment of contractual obligations with business partners and service providers of the Operator;
- (vi) response to legitimate requests from authorized third parties where disclosure serves the interests of the CoR Service and its users;

The Operator shall exercise reasonable care in protecting User Information, require confidentiality from recipients where practicable, and limit disclosures to what is operationally necessary.

For the avoidance of doubt, disclosures under this section that involve personal data shall be carried out in accordance with applicable data protection laws and the CoR Service's Privacy Policy. The Operator shall remain responsible for ensuring that any such processing and transfer of personal data complies with its legal obligations.

SANCTIONS

1. By accepting these Product Terms You warrant that:

- You are not a Sanctions Target and have not been a Sanctions Target and nothing has occurred that could reasonably be expected to result in it becoming a Sanctions Target;
- You are not contravening and have not contravened any Sanctions;
- You, your owners, controlling persons and officers are not included in Sanctions Lists;
- none of Your clients or counterparties is Sanctions Targets;
- Your business activities are not directly or indirectly intended to benefit, or be used in connection with, any Sanctions Target or any activity that would constitute or result in a breach of Sanctions.

2. At all times during the term of these Product Terms, You shall not contravene any Sanctions and not do, or omit to do, any act that will cause or lead the Operator to contravene any Sanctions. You further undertake that any Works or Services You request shall not cause, or be reasonably expected to cause, the Operator to violate any applicable Sanctions.

3. You shall as soon as reasonably practicably notify the Operator in writing if:

- at any time during the term of these Product Terms, there is any fact or circumstance that would give rise to a breach of warranties given in this Section; or
- it becomes aware of any breach or suspected breach of this Section,

and You shall provide such information about such fact or circumstance or about the breach as the Operator requires to comply with its obligations to any Sanctions Authority or otherwise reasonably requests.

4. The Operator may in its absolute discretion disclose information or documents (including as received or obtained from You) to a Sanctions Authority if:

- it knows or has reasonable cause to suspect that there has been a breach of Sanctions; or
- requested by a Sanctions Authority.



Notifications and disclosures made pursuant to this Section shall not breach the confidentiality obligations and shall not be subject to any restrictions set out in those provisions.

If at any time during the term of these Product Terms You become a Sanctions Target, the Operator may in its absolute discretion and without affecting any other right or remedy available to it terminate these Product Terms and/or suspend or terminate provision of the CoR Service to You with immediate effect by sending a written termination notification.

RESTRICTIONS

By accepting these Product Terms You expressly agree that You are expressly prohibited to, and are prohibited to allow any third party to, perform any of the following actions, and any actions similar in nature or intent thereto, and that performance of any such actions shall constitute a material breach of these Product Terms:

- display, copy, store, modify, adapt, reverse engineer, sell, publish, make available to the public or redistribute the CoR Service or any services or functionality made available to You via the CoR Service;
- allow any third party to access and use the CoR Service using Your login and password;
- use the CoR Service for any illegal purposes;
- impersonate (equal to using any data of a third party in the Personal Profile) or falsely claim affiliation with any person or entity and register as the Subcontractor a group (association) of persons or a legal entity;
- use (link) payment means in Your Personal Profile and/or withdraw remunerations to payment means that do not belong to You and/or are issued in the name of third parties, except in cases where You notify the Operator in advance and provide sufficient information and documents for the verification of such third parties. The Operator reserves the right to request You any documents necessary to verify the holder of payment means linked to Your Personal Profile. You must provide these documents to the Operator within 3 working days from the date of the request;
- misrepresent, defraud or defame others;
- negatively present the CoR Service and/or the Operator and/or its affiliates;
- transmit malicious software code on or with help of the CoR Service;
- collect information of other users through the CoR Service;
- interrupt the normal operation of or tamper with the CoR Service or any functionality contained in or provided through the CoR Service, or any servers used in providing the CoR Service, or to unreasonably affect others' use of the CoR Service in any way;
- invade privacy of other CoR Service users by means of phishing, identity theft and other means;
- use bots, spiders, offline readers or other automated software systems to access or use the CoR Service;
- use the CoR Service to create, promote, or distribute gambling, adult, hate, violent, defamatory, or other content deemed offensive or inappropriate by the Operator;
- engage in any activity that infringes upon or violates the intellectual property rights, privacy rights, or other legal rights of any third party;



- use the CoR Service to engage in or promote discriminatory practices based on race, gender, religion, nationality, disability, sexual orientation, or any other protected status;
 - circumvent, disable, or otherwise interfere with security-related features of the CoR Service, including features that prevent or restrict the use or copying of any content or enforce limitations on the use of the CoR Service;
 - use the CoR Service in any manner that violates international trade restrictions, sanctions, or embargoes imposed by any jurisdiction where Mellow operates;
- otherwise use the CoR Service for engaging in any activities that are illegal under laws of any jurisdiction or that encourage criminal conduct;
- use the CoR Service for any purposes other than those expressly permitted under these Product Terms.

You explicitly agree to provide, upon the Operator's request, sufficient, accurate, and up-to-date information and documents necessary for the Operator to confirm Your compliance with these Product Terms, including the "Restrictions" Section. Breach of this "Restrictions" Section shall constitute a material breach of these Product Terms by You and a direct violation of applicable laws and may result in the immediate termination of these Product Terms by the Operator without prior notice.

Unauthorized access and use of the CoR Service, including any use in contravention of these Product Terms and the "Restrictions" section of these Product Terms, is prohibited and may result in criminal prosecution and/or civil and/or disciplinary or administrative liability, including court action against You initiated by the Operator or relevant law enforcement authorities.

The Operator reserves the right to suspend access to the CoR Service and terminate these Product Terms without prior notice if ongoing KYC checks indicate a potential violation of the law by You in any country where the CoR Service operates, or if the Operator becomes aware of a potential legal violation by the counterparty from open sources.

The Platform and the CoR Service are intended exclusively for business, professional and commercial use in connection with Your entrepreneurial, trade or professional activities. You may not use the Platform or the CoR Service for personal, household, family or other consumer purposes.

REPORTING VIOLATIONS OF PRODUCT TERMS

You may inform the Operator about violations of these Product Terms by other users of the CoR Service by sending an e-mail to the following address: support@mellow.io.

SUSPENSION/TERMINATION OF CoR SERVICE

You may terminate Your access and use of the CoR Service if You no longer wish to use the CoR Service subject to any outstanding obligations under agreements applicable to the CoR Service. Termination or deletion of Your Personal Profile on the Platform is governed by the General Terms..

The Operator reserves the right to investigate any and all suspected violations of these Product Terms and to take any and all necessary or appropriate actions to remedy such violations, as the Operator may determine appropriate.
