Antony Zito is an Italian-American portrait painter, sculptor, muralist, and musician whose career began in New York City's Lower East Side in the early 1990s. His work has appeared in Jim Jarmusch's films Coffee and Cigarettes and Broken Flowers, and he is Director/Co-founder Emeritus of 4heads Inc., the nonprofit behind the Portal Art Fair, hailed by The New York Times as the "Art Fair for the 99 Percent."

Now based in East Granby, CT, Zito serves as Associate Director of Parkville Art Gallery in Hartford, guiding curation and exhibition design. His classes at the West Hartford Art League are consistently filled, and his murals can be found throughout New York and New England. Zito's mixed-media portrait work explores layered narratives, inviting viewers to uncover their own meanings.
