



Greenhouse Gas Emissions Reduction Target

J.S. McCarthy Co., Inc. (J.S. McCarthy Packaging + Print) is committed to reducing the greenhouse gas (GHG) emissions of its operations. Building on more than eighteen years of powering our facilities with 100% certified renewable wind electricity, we have set the following time-bound, absolute GHG reduction target at the corporate level. Emissions are accounted on an operational-control basis following the GHG Protocol, covering our manufacturing plant at 15 Darin Drive and off-site storage, which together represent 100% of company operations.

Our Target

Reduce absolute Scope 1 GHG emissions 30% by 2030, from a 2024 baseline.

- Baseline year: 2024. Baseline Scope 1 emissions: 145.7 tCO₂e. Target: 102.0 tCO₂e by 2030.
- Scope 1 covers direct emissions from propane used for heating and fuel used by our vehicle fleet.
- We will pursue this reduction through heating and equipment efficiency, fleet optimization, and reduced fuel use.

Maintain 100% renewable electricity and zero market-based Scope 2 emissions through 2030.

- We will continue to match 100% of our electricity with certified renewable wind power, holding market-based Scope 2 emissions at 0 tCO₂e, and will continue to improve electricity efficiency across operations.

Progress to Date

Our emissions are already on a clear downward path. From 2024 to 2025, combined Scope 1 and Scope 2 (location-based) emissions fell from 1,103.0 to 1,026.8 tCO₂e, a 7% reduction. Scope 1 emissions fell from 145.7 to 119.7 tCO₂e over the same period, a reduction of 18% against our 2024 baseline and roughly 59% of the total reduction required to reach our 2030 target. We will report progress against this target annually. This target covers Scope 1 and Scope 2. We do not yet quantify Scope 3 and will begin tracking with downstream transportation and purchased goods as our carrier data matures.

This target was adopted by J.S. McCarthy Packaging + Print as a public statement of our climate commitment.
