The realities surrounding abortion in America are eye-opening.

One in five pregnancies ends in abortion, with more than one million babies lost each year. More than half of the women making this decision identify as Christian, and many are already mothers. A significant number are living below the federal poverty level, facing overwhelming pressure, fear, and isolation. Today, most abortions happen through a pill, often in silence and secrecy, leaving women to walk through the experience alone.

That is where Embrace Grace steps in. We exist to replace fear with hope by connecting women facing unplanned pregnancies with a loving church community. Through practical, emotional, and spiritual support, moms find a safe place to belong and the courage to be brave.

Since 2012, Embrace Grace has helped more than **25,000** moms and dads across all **50** states and **9** countries connect with local churches. Through these life-giving relationships, women discover they are not alone and are empowered to choose life with confidence and support.

Our mission is to make abortion unthinkable by awakening hearts, strengthening churches, and surrounding women with love at the moment they need it most. With the help of our passionate community, this awakening is already underway.

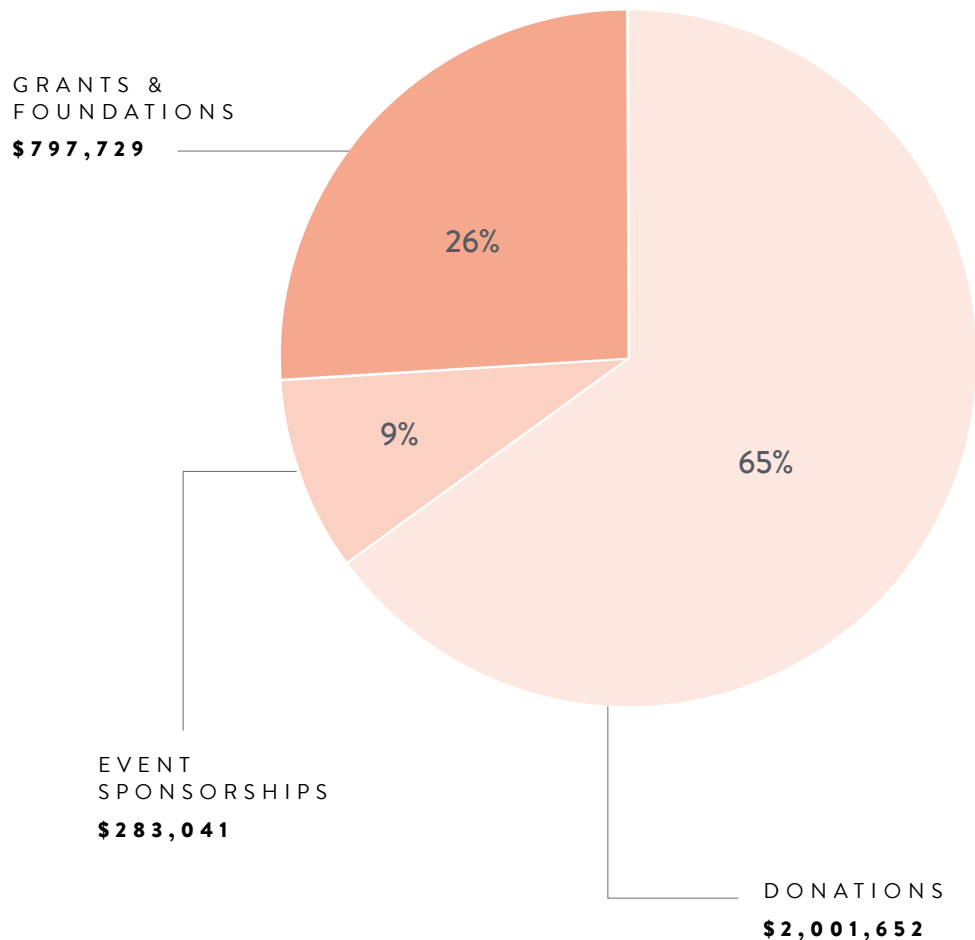

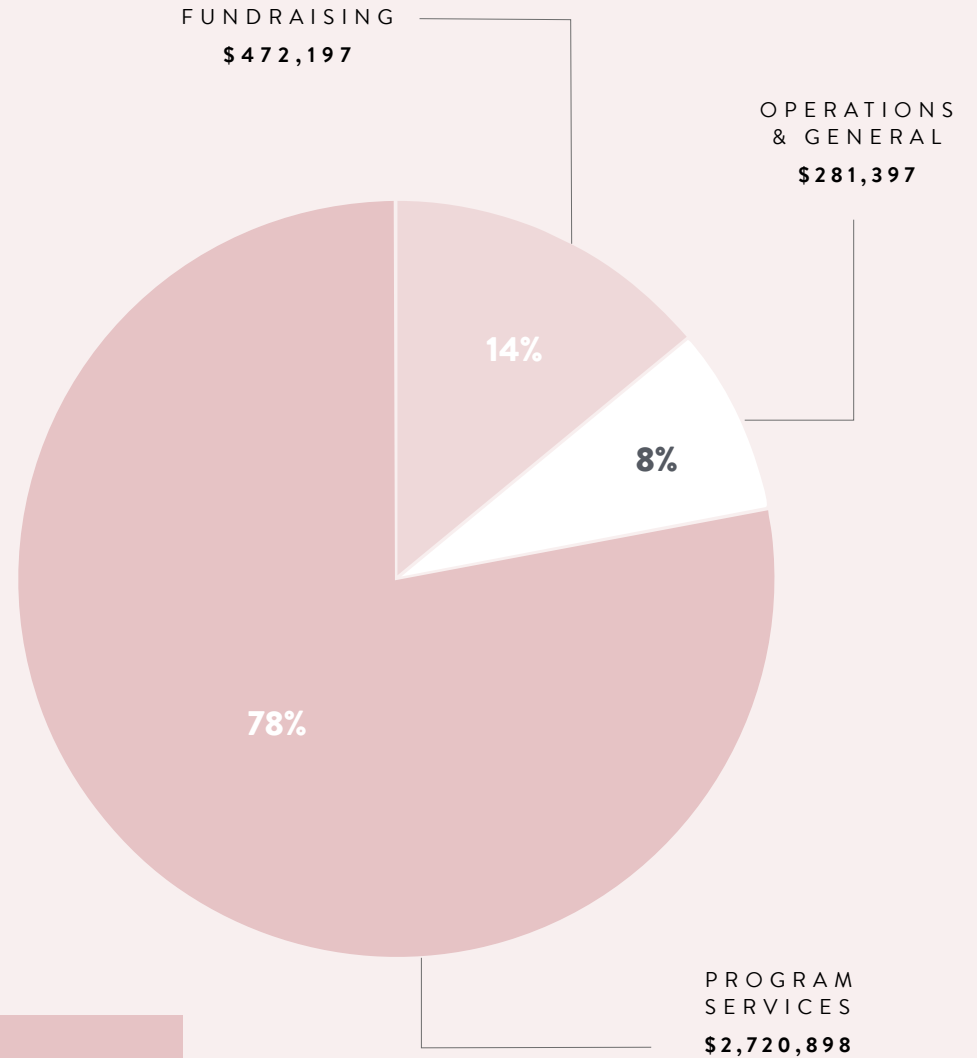

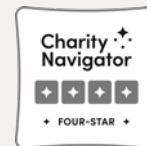

When I moved to Texas with my six-year-old daughter, I had no family or support. When I found out I was pregnant again, I felt completely alone and even considered abortion. That's when I was connected to Embrace Grace through The Lake Church and everything changed. What I expected to be a simple class became a loving community that welcomed my kids and me, my faith was renewed, and I grew closer to God than I had in years. The baby shower and ongoing support reminded me I wasn't alone. Embrace Grace gave me a new outlook on life. Instead of seeing my glass as half empty, I began to see it as half full. As my perspective changed, so did everything else. Before Embrace Grace, I was two years sober and running my own business. I had been told I could not get pregnant, so finding out I was expecting just two months into dating my boyfriend left me unsure. I had always believed I would choose abortion if the timing was not right, and my boyfriend initially felt the same. When I found Embrace Grace through Red Rocks Church, they welcomed me immediately. As I went through the program, my faith deepened, and something shifted. I realized that no matter what my situation looked like, I could do this and that God wanted me to have this baby. Embrace Grace gave me peace in the uncertainty and reminded me that I was not alone. By the time of my baby shower, my boyfriend and I had decided to raise our child together. Today, my faith is stronger than ever. I do not just believe in God. I trust Him, knowing He will provide exactly what I need. - **CATERINA**

My life changed when I learned I was unexpectedly pregnant. As a mom of two, I felt overwhelmed and afraid, especially when the baby's father told me I had to get an abortion. My mom and grandmother supported me and reminded me that every life has value. Though scared, I chose to trust God. At Bloom Pregnancy Center, I was introduced to Embrace Grace. When I joined the group, I was guarded and struggling to accept my pregnancy, but through the love, teaching, and support, fear turned into hope. I learned forgiveness, experienced healing, and rediscovered my faith. Today, my son is 10 months old, and choosing life changed everything. God met me in my hardest season and showed me His plans are greater than my fear. - **MICHELLE**



SUPPORT GROUPS

With 1,235 Embrace Grace groups and counting, spanning 50 states + Puerto Rico, and 9 countries, attendees from all over the world have encountered the love of God and found the restoration and healing needed to move forward with hope for the future. Leaders have walked alongside these young parents with ongoing support and virtual training. In 2025, we added thousands of new leaders and ministered to over 5,000 parents through our three support group curriculums.

THE EMBRACE LIFE SUPPORT GROUP FOR YOUNG + SINGLE MOMS

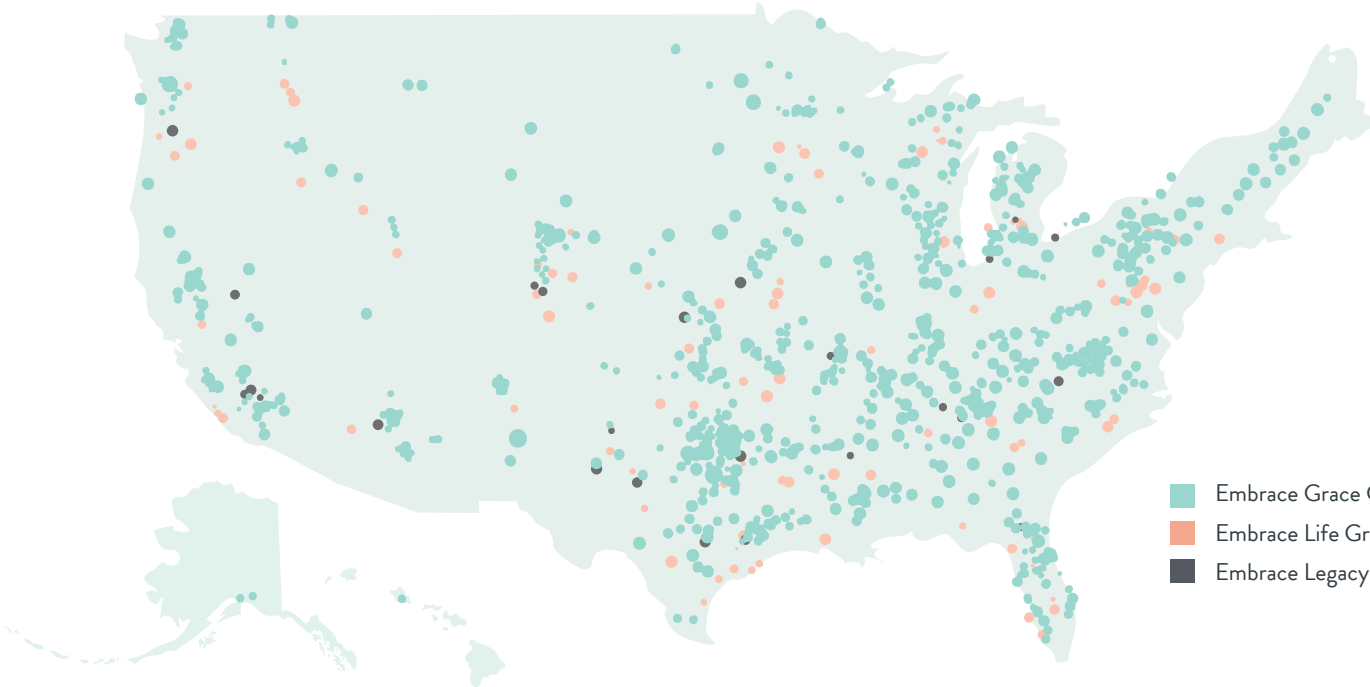
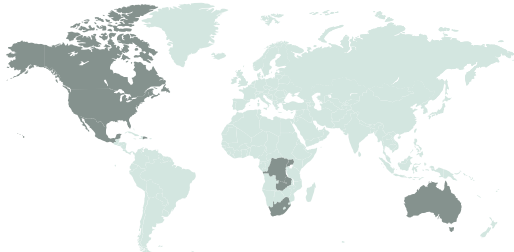
This 20-week curriculum helps single moms find hope, experience joy, and build community. Attendees learn spiritual and practical ways to help navigate through life.

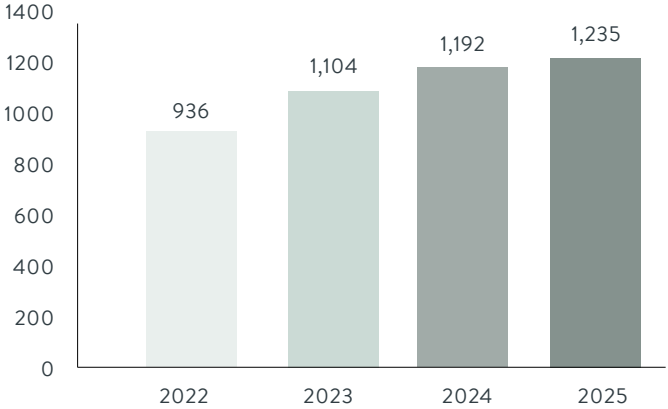

In December 2025, Embrace Grace reached a beautiful milestone: more than 150,000 Love Boxes delivered to women facing unexpected pregnancies across the United States.

Love Boxes are often given at pregnancy centers during one of the most overwhelming moments in a woman's life. Inside are encouraging words, real stories from other moms, and an invitation to an Embrace Grace support group at a local church. But more than anything, a Love Box is a message: *you matter, and your baby matters too.*

Recently, while visiting Bakersfield, California, Amy met a young woman who shared how a Love Box changed everything. She had already visited a pregnancy center and was still planning to go through with an abortion. On her way out, they handed her a Love Box.

She sat in her car and opened it.

Inside was a tiny onesie that said "Best Gift Ever." She held it in her hands and imagined a baby wearing it. And then she imagined *her* baby wearing it.

In that quiet moment in a parking lot, everything shifted.

She chose life.

Later she joined an Embrace Grace group at a local church, found the support and encouragement she needed, and today she is co-leading an Embrace Grace group at that very same church—helping other women discover the same hope she once received.

Behind every Love Box is a church ready to welcome a mom or dad with open arms. Through support groups, mentorship, and genuine community, women discover they are not alone and begin to find a place of belonging.

150,000 Love Boxes is a milestone worth celebrating. But even more than that, it is 150,000 reminders that when love shows up at just the right moment, lives can change forever.



HIGHLIGHTS OF 2025

BUILDING THE PRO-LOVE *community*

LO SISTER CONFERENCE PARTNERSHIP

At Embrace Grace, we are always looking for creative and meaningful ways to share the pro-love mission and invite more people into the work of supporting women and families facing unexpected pregnancies.

This year, we were honored to serve as a ministry partner for the LO Sister Conference with Sadie Robertson Huff, where more than 4,000 women gathered for a powerful weekend centered on faith, family, and purpose.

During the conference, Amy Ford was featured in a special Sister & Friend main stage conversation, creating an opportunity to share the heart behind Embrace Grace and the growing movement of churches across the nation welcoming moms and dads with open arms.

The response was incredible. Women lined up at the Embrace Grace booth to learn more, ask questions, and dream about what it could look like to bring Embrace Grace to their own churches. Throughout the weekend, seeds were planted as many expressed interest in starting groups in their communities. Moments like this remind us that when people hear the message of pro-love and realize there is a simple way to get involved, a movement begins to grow.

KCBI CHRISTMAS WISH

Embrace Grace was honored to nominate one of our Brave Moms, Tierra, for KCBI's 2025 Christmas Wish, through which she received \$10,000.

Tierra is a single mom of two who went through an Embrace Grace group at her local church. Her story deeply moved the church community as they watched her work tirelessly to build a better future for her children. She balances work, full-time schooling to become an airplane mechanic, and caring for her youngest daughter, Gracie, who has ongoing medical needs.

After the weight of financial and personal strain led to serious health challenges and forced her to take unpaid medical leave, her faith and the encouragement of her church family helped carry her through.

Through the partnership of KCBI, Embrace Grace, and Cornerstone Staffing, Tierra received a Christmas Wish that brought stability and relief during a difficult season. It was a powerful reminder that God is the God who sees and He often moves through His people, churches, ministries, and even a radio station to remind someone they are not alone.





GENEROUS FAMILY PARTNERSHIP

One of the beautiful things about this season is that single moms today have more tools than ever to help teach their children about God, kindness, and generosity ... and many of them are completely free.

This year, through a special partnership with Generous Family and Candace Cameron Bure, **more than 1,000 Brave Moms** received beautifully illustrated children's books designed to spark meaningful conversations about love, generosity, and living with open hearts.

These books create small, sacred moments between a mom and her child while reading together, talking about faith, and helping the next generation understand what it means to love God and care for others.

Partnerships like this remind us that when ministries and organizations come together with a shared vision, the impact multiplies. We are so grateful for friends like Generous Family who believe in empowering new moms and dads and investing in the families they are raising.

Together, we are helping build homes where faith, kindness, and generosity grow for generations!

HELP HER BE BRAVE PODCAST LAUNCH

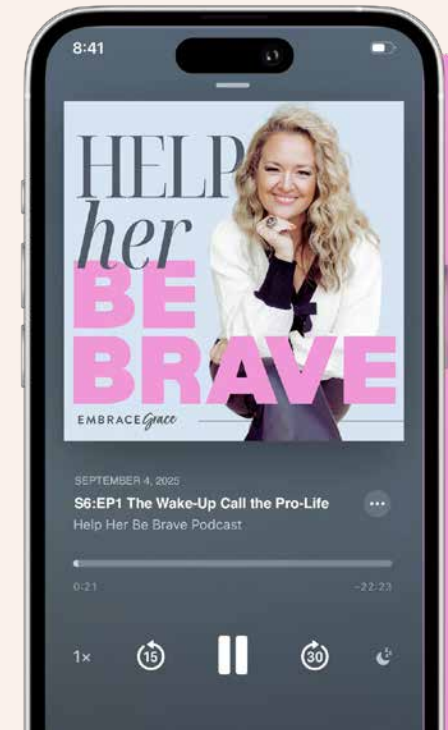

While the podcast speaks hope to those directly impacted by unexpected pregnancies, its greater purpose is to help the church grow in confidence and clarity about how to respond with love.

We are just getting started. With incredible guests and meaningful conversations ahead, the Help Her Be Brave Podcast will continue to spark new ideas, inspire action, and help more churches become places where moms and dads can find hope, belonging, and support.

A MOVEMENT THAT KEEPS GROWING

Some travel long distances, and we simply want them to know they are welcomed.

Seeing these moms return to church, stay connected, and keep growing after their babies are born has been one of the greatest joys. Many come back for Embrace Life, and we stay in touch long after the program ends. I believe God called me to this because I love life and I love babies. Through Embrace Grace, I help women see they are not alone and that their lives, and their babies' lives, matter.

25 YEAR PLAN

A NATIONWIDE CHURCH NETWORK WHERE NO SINGLE MOM **WALKS ALONE**

In October 2025, we shared a bold, long-term vision that has been growing in our hearts for years: **23,400 churches** strategically placed across the United States, one for every community where a woman could face an unexpected pregnancy. That number represents what it would take to ensure that no pregnant mom ever has to walk alone, and that every woman has access to practical, spiritual, and emotional support through a local church. This vision marked a defining moment for Embrace Grace. It clarified where we are headed, why it matters, and how the local church can become one of the safest places a woman turns when her life is suddenly filled with questions. Donors and partners were invited into a dream big enough to change outcomes, shift culture, and create a nationwide safety net of love and support.

Alongside that vision, we introduced new strategies that give churches more flexible ways to walk with moms and dads in every community. In 2025, we shared plans to launch Church Buddies and Mentorship, expanding beyond support groups alone and giving churches more tools to come alongside moms and dads through every step of their journey. These pathways create space for connection, belonging, and long-term discipleship, helping individuals feel supported not just for a season, but for life. As we move into 2026, we are stepping into the building phase, developing and releasing even more strategies to accelerate this vision. The foundation has been set, the direction is clear, and we are just getting started.

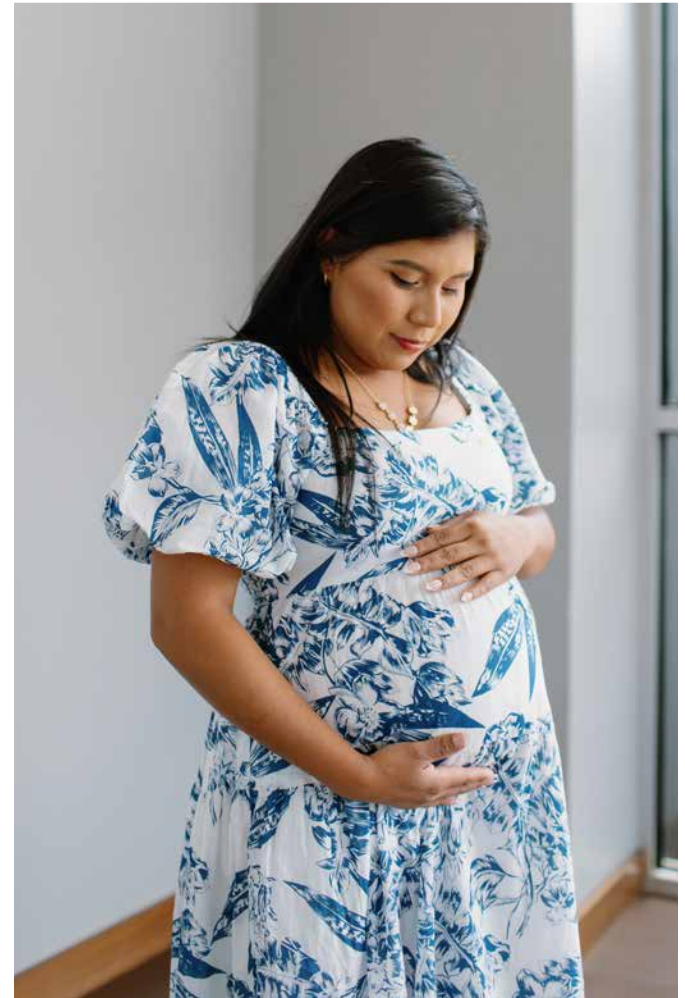
