



Initiate a full inspection

From the mobile app, scan the driver's licence card and the vehicle disk to capture the details of the customer and the vehicle you're inspecting. Take note: certain details must be captured manually.







Capture Vehicle Condition

You can capture the extensive details of the vehicle damage using the inspection tool, including the estimated reconditioning amount and images of the damaged area.

The built-in camera feature provides a Ghost function and Stabiliser that guides the inspector to capture images at the correct angle.
