From Heart Language to Heart Transformation: Bringing Jesus to Kenyan Sign Language

DOOR International's report about Riziki is One More Important Reason Why Doulos is Helping Complete the Kenyan Sign Language Bible:

“Riziki is a young Deaf girl from Kenya.

“She grew up in a hearing family that never learned sign language. Like many Deaf children in similar situations, she had no access to language at home. She did not learn sign language until she was sent to a Deaf school.



“Riziki was born into a Muslim family. Had she been hearing, she likely would have attended the mosque regularly and been taught the Quran. But because her parents did not know sign language, she was sent to a Deaf school instead.

“At that school, Riziki met Deaf Kenyan missionaries who shared God’s Word with Deaf children. When she arrived, she did not yet know sign language. One of the first things she learned was her name. She was given a name sign by the other children. As she learned to sign, she also learned about Jesus.

“Through God’s Word in Kenyan Sign Language, Riziki learned that her Savior had always known her name, that she was known and loved, and that she was created in His image. This was possible because Scripture was available in her heart language and because a Deaf Kenyan missionary faithfully came to her school each week to share God’s Word.

“Today, Riziki knows the name of her Savior. She has grown, and she is now sharing the Gospel with other Deaf children at her school, other children who are just beginning to learn language and to learn their own names.

“Riziki knows Jesus because someone shared God’s Word with her in a language she could understand.”
