Ending Scripture Poverty in Africa

In villages throughout Africa, audio devices are being used to translate the Bible in Discovery Bible Study (DBS) groups.

During one of these DBS groups, a young girl heard the gospel, and it touched her so deeply that her life was radically changed. She had always worn a charm that attracted men, mystically. After hearing the gospel, she removed the charm and gave her life to Jesus Christ.

The leaders of the DBS took the charm and burned it, after the prayer meeting. Just like the Samaritan woman in the Bible, the powerful testimony of this well-known girl attracted several other community members to Christ. The DBS of 7 members now has 40 disciples who are willing to reach out to neighboring villages.

This testimony has inspired many leaders in neighboring regions to also use Audio DBSs to grow the church and change lives.

Bill* is an inmate in a Texas prison. He came to faith while incarcerated and has been trained as a discipleship leader to reach other inmates with the Gospel and disciple them. “He has been walking out his calling inside the unit,” said Dave*, an e3 missionary who has helped disciple Bill. “His assignment one day? Sit with a man named Jim* on suicide watch. A hard place. But this wasn’t just a man wrestling with despair—Jim was an outspoken Satanist. And not quietly so—he was in a full-blown manic episode, preaching Satan’s gospel with intensity.” Jim had drawn three massive sixes on the wall. He claimed Satan had been cast to Earth to create chaos and raise up his “trinity”: witches, warlocks, and minions. He was evangelizing for the kingdom of darkness.

But thank God our brother was an ambassador for the Kingdom of Light!” Dave said. “Calmly, compassionately, full of the Holy Spirit, Bill leaned in. He began to share the true story—the story that changes everything. That God is love. That He created the world in perfect design and harmony.

That we broke it when we joined Satan’s rebellion. But even then, God didn’t turn away. Instead, He stepped in.”

Bill told Jim about the hope of Jesus — how He came into the brokenness, went to the cross, bore our rebellion, died for it, then rose again to give us new life. “Then, in a most powerful reversal, Bill took a marker and drew the 3 Circles right over that demonic symbol.” Dave said. “A holy takeover. And right there in that cell, something broke. The man who once gave himself to darkness surrendered his life to Jesus Christ.”

Jim was eventually removed from suicide watch, because he had found hope in the only one who can truly save. Now Jim is sharing that hope with other inmates too. That’s the power of the Gospel. That’s the mission we’re on. “This is what happens when the Gospel is unleashed in the darkest places,” Dave said. “Being on mission is messy. Sometimes it takes us to tough, dirty places. Being obedient is costly, but it’s worth it!”

Imagine a single bold decision setting off a ripple of transformation.

In South Asia, a young couple's choice to follow Jesus and marry in a Christian ceremony became the unexpected spark that drew hundreds to hear about His love for the very first time.

The Father of the Groom

Pavan comes from a well-known and highly affluent business community. He is known and respected among his own people, with his influence stretching across three states in South Asia. Imagine the surprise for Pavan and his traditional Hindu community when his son decided to become a disciple and follower of Jesus. Imagine his surprise again when his son chose for himself (rather than submit to an arranged marriage) his own bride. And yet again, imagine the shock when that woman turned out to be a girl from a well-to-do, upper-class, community with a different religion. She too is a devout follower of Jesus.

We know for sure God is at work and John 6:44 is yet again being fulfilled (no one comes to Jesus unless the Father draws him). When a disciple maker, Brother Adam, was asked to perform the wedding and to speak to the participants, he agreed as long as the couple would first inform their parents of their wedding plans and get their permission. He also made it clear that the marriage ceremony would be a Christian marriage.

Both sets of parents decided to support the marriage. They invited more than 340 relatives and friends to attend. And at least that many people showed up on the day. Brother Adam had the unique opportunity to share about the love of Jesus. He read from 1 Cor. 13: 7, and he raised the question about why and how all of us need that love in our lives, using the story of the woman at the well.

After the ceremony, Adam stayed up late into the night, talking with and answering questions from many extended family members who came to him and wanted to know more. Pavan, the father of the groom, has invited Adam into his home and into his extended community. In rocket science terms, we could call this a successful lift-off. So, now pray for Adam as he follows up on this opportunity. He has already begun introducing that family to more stories in the Bible about Jesus.

True Forgiveness Brings Peace

About thirteen years ago, Mr. C* had a quarrel with his brother over land. Mr. C became angry, killed his brother, and served a twelve-year jail sentence. He was released just a few months ago. For twelve years, Mr. C has carried the guilt of his crime and repented, but he didn't know how to relieve the burden on his heart. Because Mr. C was a devout Hindu, he tried to follow all the rules for atonement of sins according to Hinduism. But he did not find peace of mind.

Last week, Mr. C met one of our volunteers. Mr. C read the gospel literature thoroughly and learned that Jesus died on the cross for his sins. When he understood this truth, he started weeping. After crying for a long time, he felt at peace in his mind. He realized that only Jesus can free him from this sin. That's when he gave up everything else in which he had sought peace and accepted the Lord Jesus as his Savior. He regularly attends the local church, reads the Bible, prays, and participates in a Christ Group. He testifies loudly to others that he has been born again through the Lord Jesus.

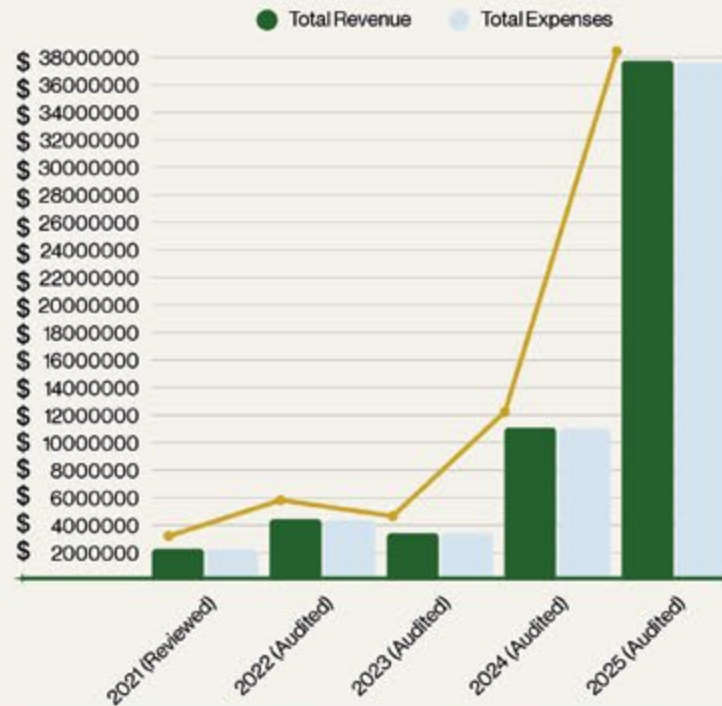

ACHIEVE Togo/Benin Project

Through iShare, a mapping software that identifies every village within a country, villages are categorized through data collection and identified as **red** (no Christians and no church), **yellow** (Christians present but no church), or **green** (Christians and a church present). In Togo, this comprehensive mapping and data collection has been completed, giving rise to the *ACHIEVE Togo/Benin Project—A Church in Every Village Everywhere*.

The goal is simple: to see a church established in all **7,000 villages in Togo** that currently have none. Through this project, we are partnering to help plant **625 churches** in villages without a church. Please pray for the Lord's favor, provision, and guidance as this work moves forward.



Gujarat and Beyond Project

The Gujarat and Beyond Project extends far beyond the state of Gujarat, encompassing **11 additional states** across India as well as the neighboring countries of Nepal, Bhutan, the UAE, and Oman. The project's 2025 goals are progressing remarkably well and are on track for completion.

These goals include engaging more than **12,000 geographic gaps** and **80 Unengaged, Unreached People Groups (UUPGs)** with the Gospel; training **30,000+ individuals** in disciple-making, church planting, leadership development, and research; launching **two new research hubs** and training centers; baptizing **18,760 people**; planting **6,720 new churches**; and seeing **115,643 people** make professions of faith. As this project moves closer to completing these ambitious objectives, let us ask the Lord for His continued strength, favor, and guidance to help finish the task He has set before us. - **NOTE: The Photo Faces Are Blurred for Security**



Love Your Neighbor Mobilization Kits

Doulos, in partnership with one of our strategic ministry partners, has developed a powerful resource called the **Love Your Neighbor Mobilization Kit**. These kits are currently being used across the Americas, a nation in Southern Asia, and the United States to equip churches to train and mobilize their members to go door to door, share the Gospel, start small groups, and connect new believers with local churches.

This project focuses on the printing and distribution of **81,000 Mobilization Kits**, including **20,000 across the Americas** (with **4,000 designated for Brazil, 50,000 for a nation in Southern Asia, and 11,312 for the United States**). Please pray the Lord would use these tools to strengthen local churches and reach many more people with the life-changing Gospel of Jesus Christ.



Expanding High Quality Translation of God's Word in Sign Language

There are approximately **400 sign languages** worldwide, yet **80% have no Scripture in their heart language**. Imagine being a follower of Jesus with **no access to the Bible** in your native language. To address this critical need, we have partnered on a highly technical project to advance translation within the deaf community.

Goals: to develop a consolidated **three-year, competency-based curriculum** and design a learning management system to accelerate the training of international deaf workers in translation and consulting. Additionally, a minimum of **six instructional videos** will be produced to support the curriculum and consultant training, with these tools set to be utilized beginning in 2026 with existing Language Consultants in the deaf translation space. This initiative is equipping and empowering deaf communities with access to God's Word in their heart language, transforming lives and strengthening the global Church.

This Was The End

Yusuf* steadied himself by placing a hand on the back of the chair and looked up at the rope dangling from the ceiling.

His whole body felt heavy, as if his financial troubles were physically pressing down on him. Alcohol used to provide some relief, lighten the load, but even that didn't help anymore. There was no way out. He was being crushed.

With an effort, Yusuf heaved himself up to stand on the chair. He stood there a moment.

He wouldn't be able to say later what, or who, made him do it. But suddenly, even the weight of his shirt was too much for him. As he began to tug his shirt off, he felt something hard in the pocket.

Yusuf removed a small card. Vaguely, he remembered someone giving him the card on the street a day or two before. He began to read. The card turned out to be printed with a Christian prayer of repentance.

At that moment, Yusuf's mother burst into the room and screamed, realizing what her son was about to do. She wrapped her arms around him, holding him tightly.
