PUBLIC SKATING RULES



1. You are NOT allowed on the ice WITHOUT SKATES
2. Rink does NOT supply protective equipment (Helmets & Gloves)
3. Helmets are recommended but not required.
4. Skate at your own risk.
5. Parents are responsible to watch and care for their own children.
6. Ice arena management is not responsible for lost or stolen items.
7. Keep out of unassigned locker rooms, score table area, player boxes and penalty boxes.
8. Skates are to be worn only on the ice or in areas covered with protective rubber flooring.
9. Follow any and all instructions from arena management staff
10. Figure Skaters: No jumps or spins during Open Skate hours.
11. Skate aids are to be used only by beginner skaters.
12. Keep all ice access doors closed when the Zamboni (ice resurfacing machine) is on the ice.
Stay off the ice until the Zamboni access doors are completely closed.
13. No food or drink allowed on the ice at any time.
14. Follow all posted or stated facility rules: Anyone not abiding by posted or stated rules and regulations OR conduct that may endanger the safety of self or others may be asked to leave the ice and/or facility without refund.
15. Prohibited: Tag, Keep Away, Sticks & Pucks (or other shooting devices), taking of hats/gloves, tossing of snowballs, etc.
