What's Going On?

Join us to stand with this grove of coast redwoods, nearly 100-feet tall and 100 years old.

These redwoods are a roosting spot for eagles and filter runoff into Lake Washington. They sit in an **Environmentally Critical Area**, yet many are being removed for a retaining wall with no explanation why the wall must cut through these trees.

Please join us in asking the owner to protect this grove.

These are not just any trees. These are Seattle's critical natural infrastructure:

- Tree The largest redwood grove on private property in Seattle.
- Fire Seattle's natural defense against extreme heat and climate change.
- Water Living filters that protect Lake Washington.
