Aerial photos from 1936 show this fir existing among a forest here, before our neighborhood even existed.

Please join us in asking the developer, Mayor Wilson, City Councilmembers, and SDCI to stop removals like this from ever happening again.

- 📖 **Living history**, alive when much of View Ridge was a forest.
