Financial Resources: Employment, Income, Savings

Medical Care: Status, Needs

Mental Health: History, Risk, Needs, Treatment

Addiction/ Substance Use: History, Risk, Treatment

Educational: Attendance, Grades, Behavioral Referrals

Support System: Accessibility, Reliability

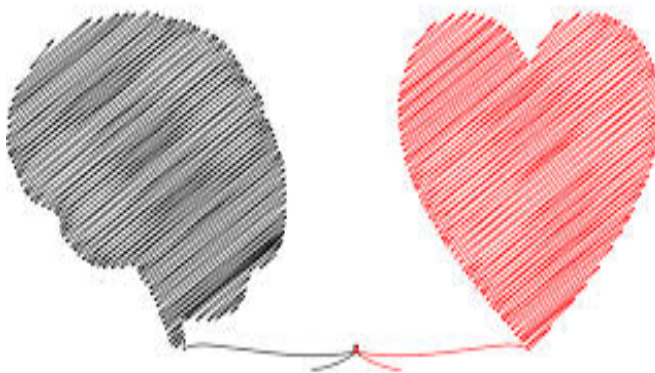

WHO ARE WE?

The Todd County AXIS Program is a pilot program formed through a partnership between the Todd County Health Department and The Todd County School District.

The Program is designed to offer FREE case management services to all students in the Todd County School District.

We have four case managers that work throughout each school in the district to provide direct services to students and their families.

Case Management in the school setting is wide-ranging. Our case managers are here to work with both youth and families to understand their individual needs.

With that knowledge, we can better connect youth and families to services within the community.

HOW IT WORKS

Our program is completely free and **voluntary**. We operate from referrals made by parents, teachers, staff, and outside agencies.

Once a referral is received, a case manager will reach out to a parent/guardian to gather information and form an individualized plan relevant to the need(s) of that youth or family.

SERVICE CONNECTIONS

AXIS case managers are available to families to assist them in setting appointments and developing plans for services.

MENTAL HEALTH SERVICE REFERRALS

Frequently, referrals are made to our program with the hope that we can assist families in connecting youth to mental health services.

Currently, Todd County has access to school-based counseling and therapy through outside community agencies that come into the school. One of our knowledgeable case managers will walk you through these options if a need arises. Our goal is to support families in choosing the best fit for their needs.

Connecting youth/families to outside resources is a major part of our program. All youth/families that we work with may not need the same services. Some may only need short-term assistance, and some may need longer-term assistance. Our goal is always to meet youth and families where they are.
