SCHOOL HEALTH STAFF

Todd County Health Department and Todd County School District work together to safeguard the health of your students. Day-to-day care for students is provided under the care of a Registered Nurse (RN) located at each school in the district.

REGISTERED NURSE (RN) SERVICES

- Acute care RN visits with over-the-counter (OTC) medication treatment
- Flouride Varnish
- Vision Screenings
- Hearing Screenings
- Flu Vaccines
- Age designated immunizations
- Rapid Testing: Flu A&B, Strep, COVID-19
- Prescription medication administration (Daily & Emergency)

REVIEW MEDICATIONS AT SCHOOL

MEDICATIONS AT SCHOOL

When possible, give medications at home.

The school nurse will administer approved medications to students during the school day when it is necessary to help them stay in school. In order to administer medication or treatment to your child at school, the following conditions must be met:

- **Prescription medications:**
 1. Must have a doctor's order
 2. The parent/guardian must deliver the medication directly to the school nurse.
- **Over-the-counter medications:**
 3. Administered after nurse assessment as needed

WHEN YOUR CHILD IS SICK

Staying home when sick helps your child get well and protects classmates. Do not send your child to school if s/he has:

- Fever, severe cough, eye infection, vomiting, severe sore throat, diarrhea, head lice
- Sickness: Your child must be free of fever, vomiting, and diarrhea without medication for at least 24 hours.
