Content & Synthesis (10 pts)	Clearly synthesizes responses to all Your Turn questions from Unit 5, demonstrating deep understanding and a coherent vision of a life worth living.	Addresses most Your Turn questions with a good level of synthesis and coherence. Some areas could be more developed.	Addresses some Your Turn questions but lacks strong synthesis or coherence. Some gaps in logical flow.	Limited synthesis or understanding. Presentation is fragmented or lacks clear connections between responses.
Organization & Clarity (5 pts)	Presentation is well-structured with smooth transitions and a logical flow of ideas.	Generally well-organized, though some transitions may be unclear.	Some organizational issues make the presentation difficult to follow.	Lacks organization, making the presentation hard to understand.
Delivery & Engagement (5 pts)	Speaker is confident, engaging, and effectively uses vocal variety, pacing, and gestures.	Speaker is clear and engaging but may lack strong vocal variety or gestures.
