

Your Turn 6: Peer Interviews (~30 minutes)

- In pairs, interview each other using questions 2 and 3 on p. 76. You can focus on just the main questions and not the starred subquestions
 - Consider the subquestions as follow-up questions as necessary
- One Interviewee and One Interviewer, then switch roles:
 - One person should ask the questions and type the responses of the other down as they speak, either directly into their running Google Doc or in a separate one, which they will then send to the interviewee to cut and paste into their doc
 - Then switch and repeat
 - Responses should be in your ongoing class Google Doc
- The aim here is to promote extemporaneous responses *and* active listening
- Don't worry about following the rubric too closely this time around
 - Aim for at least one chunky paragraph per question
 - Try to make connections to the ideas and perspectives from the readings
 - Tangents are ok as long as they're relevant to the question of the chapter, *What should we hope for?*
