Sand | Scattered Piles | Quadrants

Up to 5 players compete to stop a sand shot inside the quadrant(s). The player with the most points wins the challenge. One bucket of balls per player is needed.

✓ **How to practice?** Each player makes two piles of balls (half a bucket per pile) on two random locations in the sand, **anywhere between 5 y/m and 60 y/m** from the hole (not the green). On the green, use string lines or tees to form 4 quadrants [**9 ft | 3 m radius**]. Players randomly select a pile to start from and randomly select the quadrant to stop a sand shot inside. Each player hits one ball to the same quadrant and **each ball that stops in the quadrant wins a point**. The leading player randomly selects the next pile of balls to jump to and a different quadrant to hit to, until all balls are covered. **The player with the most points at the end wins the challenge.**

Note* occasionally clear the balls from the green.
