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DIRECTIONS

Lubbock Location: West Texas just 45 minutes East of Lubbock. If flying, the lodge will provide airport pick up if needed. OS will provide driving directions with your itinerary.

If flying, Arrival shuttle departs Abilene airport 1:30pm on departure dates do not schedule flights before 9am. OS must have your flight itinerary 2 weeks prior to class.

TYPICAL DAY

Arrival Day

- Arrive before 2:30 PM
- 3PM to 6PM - Orientation and Curriculum review
- 6PM to 7PM - Dinner
- 7PM to 8PM - Curriculum wrap-up

Day One

- 7AM - Breakfast
- 8AM - On the range and safety briefing
- 8AM to 12 PM - Known distance range
- 12 PM to 1 PM - Lunch at the lodge
- 1 PM to 5 PM - Known distance range
- 6 PM - Dinner
- 7 PM - Debriefing / discuss day's events

Day Two

- 7 AM - Breakfast
- 8 AM - Unknown distance range and safety briefing
- 8 AM to 12 PM - Hunting scenarios at various elevations
- 12 PM to 1 PM - Lunch back at lodge
- 1 PM to 4 PM - Shooting wind clock
- 4 PM to 5 PM - Timed shooting drills and competition
- 6 PM - Dinner
- 7 PM - Debriefing / discuss day's events

Departure Day

- 7 AM to 8 AM - Light breakfast and depart lodge

WHAT TO BRING

Below you will find a short list of things you should bring for our long range school

- Eye Protection
- Ear Protection (electronic preferred)
- Day Pack (you will use on Day Two)
- Rain Gear
- Apps (download the Geo Ballistics App and the ZEISS Hunting App to your smartphone)
- Rangefinder (helpful but not necessary)
- Comfortable Clothes
Wear comfortable clothing on the range that you don't mind getting dirty - jeans or tactical pants, ball cap, hiking boots.
- Personal Items

If bringing your own firearm, you will need additional items.

- Personal firearm (no caliber above .338)
- Firearm optic (Must have elevation dial MOA or MIL Radian. We teach the class using MOA.)
- 60 rounds of ammunition
- Apps (download the Geo Ballistics/Ballistics ARC **paid version**)
- You will need to know the twist rate of your barrel, ammunition used or bullet type, approximate muzzle velocity, and bore height (measure from center of bore to center of optic)

AVG TEMPERATURES

March: High 65 / Low 38 (good chance of rain)
