Uber's move is also driven by the success of Drizly, which partnered with Uber Eats in 2020. The partnership led to a significant growth in sales, with year-over-year sales spiking over 1,000 percent in April 2020. However, the company faced regulatory challenges due to security failures and data breaches. The Federal Trade Commission (FTC) discovered these issues two years before the breach that exposed personal information of about 2.5 million Drizly users. Uber acquired Drizly in an effort to address these concerns and improve its services. The integration of Drizly's offerings into the Uber Eats app aims to provide a seamless user experience, with more products available through a single platform. This move is likely to benefit both companies, increasing user satisfaction and driving business growth.
