If your IPC360 Home Camera is experiencing issues, here are some troubleshooting steps to help resolve the problem: 1. **Router Network Stability**: Use other devices to connect to the same router and check if the issue persists. 2. **Camera Re-powering**: Recharge the camera and wait for a minute before checking its status. 3. **WiFi Signal Strength**: Move the camera closer to the router to ensure a stable WiFi signal. First, insert the memory card into the MicroSD Card interface when the camera is off. The camera will recognize it normally. 1. After inserting the memory card, check if its status is Normal. If not, try formatting it. 2. Set the Record Storage Mode and Video Quality. In the live video interface, click SD Card to view saved videos. The camera's motion detection is always on and can't be turned off. To disable alarm notifications, turn off Alarm Push Notifications in the Alarm section. You can set the alarm sensitivity and time. Smart AI Detection and Human Detection require a subscription. You can also set up Alarm Sound and Alarm Light. With Alarm Sound set up, the camera will sound an alarm when it detects movement. Setting Alarm Light will activate a white light when motion is detected (available only with supported white light). View alarm messages in the Alarm interface. If you've inserted a memory card, click on the message to view the recording. Set the IPC360 Home camera's night vision operating mode in the Night Vision section or Live Video screen. Choose from Smart Mode, Colorful, and Black & White modes. In Sound Settings, turn off voice prompts, adjust sound volume, or disable the microphone. In Advanced, switch off LEDs using the Status Light icon. Follow an object with motion tracking in the Live Video screen by clicking Trace. Control the camera's rotation using Pan-Tilt in the same screen. Save the current position and recall it later. Set a timer to have the camera automatically return to this position after adjustments or motion tracking. In the Live screen, click the first icon to enter multi-screen mode. Add another camera by clicking + (not available without internet). To resolve connectivity issues between your mobile phone and IPC360 Home camera, first ensure that your Apple device has the Local Network permission enabled. If not, simply reset the camera and try reconnecting. If this doesn't work, there might be an issue with the camera itself; in this case, reach out to our technical support team for assistance. If you're still experiencing problems, try the following troubleshooting steps: Press and hold the reset button on your camera for 5 seconds until it flashes red three times per second. Alternatively, unplug and replug the device, then restart the process from step one.
