



# SR 377 Pavement Rehabilitation Phoenix Park Wash – SR 77

## PROJECT FACT SHEET

### OVERVIEW

The Arizona Department of Transportation is initiating a pavement rehabilitation project on State Route 377 between Heber-Overgaard and Holbrook (mileposts 13-34). The purpose of the project is to extend the life of the roadway and create a smooth driving surface. The work will include removing and replacing the surface pavement, restriping the roadway and other related work.

The project is scheduled to begin July 2025 and be completed by the fall.

### WHAT TO EXPECT

- ▶ **SR 377 will be closed in both directions between milepost 13 and State Route 77 from 6 a.m. to 6 p.m. Mondays through Fridays.**
- ▶ Drivers can detour along State Routes 77 and 277. Allowances will be made for local traffic and emergency vehicles to access SR 377.
- ▶ Restrictions will be lifted each day after 6 p.m. and on weekends.
