



SR 377 Shoulder Widening

MILEPOST 8 - PHOENIX PARK WASH

OVERVIEW

The Arizona Department of Transportation has initiated a shoulder-widening project on State Route 377 between Heber-Overgaard and Holbrook (mileposts 8-13). The purpose of the project is to improve safety by adding 5-foot shoulders along the highway as well as rumble strips along the shoulders and centerline. Other work includes a fog seal of the pavement, new signage and pavement markings.

The project is scheduled to begin April 2026 and be completed by the fall.

WHAT TO EXPECT


- ▶ SR 377 will be reduced to one lane only with alternating north- and southbound traffic between mileposts 8 and 13 from 6 a.m. to 4 p.m. Mondays through Fridays.
- ▶ Flaggers will direct vehicles through the work zone. Drivers should expect delays of up to 15 minutes.
- ▶ Drivers can also detour along State Routes 77 and 277.
- ▶ Restrictions will be lifted each day after work hours and on weekends.
