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HIGHLIGHTS OF CCA'S SIDELINE EVENTS AT THE 2025 UNGA

During the 2025 United Nations General Assembly in New York City, the Corporate Council on Africa (CCA) hosted a series of high-level sideline events bringing together global leaders, including H.E. President William Ruto of Kenya, U.S. Secretary of Energy Chris Wright. Discussions focused on advancing U.S.-Africa trade, investment, and energy partnerships. A key highlight was the signing of a Memorandum of Agreement between CCA and the Government of Mauritius to officially designate Mauritius as the host country for the 2026 U.S.-Africa Business Summit, further strengthening U.S.-Africa economic and diplomatic ties.

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
