Corporate Council on Africa (CCA), in partnership with the Government of the Republic of Mauritius, announced that the 2026 U.S.-Africa Business Summit will be held December 6-9, 2026, in Mauritius. The Summit, which was postponed earlier in June due to concerns about the Ebola outbreak in Central Africa, will convene Africa's premier business and investment gathering at a moment of extraordinary momentum in U.S.-Africa commercial engagement.
