



Dorking booked their place in the 4th Qualifying Round of the FA Cup for the first time in their history, defeating Weston-Super-Mare 1-0 at a drenched Meadowbank. Callum Kealy's second goal in the competition was enough to secure the win on a day where Slav Huk battled through first half injury to not only finish the game but also collect the man of the match award, as the contest itself became perilously close to being abandoned late on as the heavy rain showed no sign of letting up. Wanderers had just started to make inroads venturing into the Weston attacking third, they got reward in the 14th minute. Briggs showed quick feet to shift the ball forward and surged towards the penalty area, from a central position he slid the ball into the path of Kealy who showed good composure to guide the ball beyond Kie Plumley and into the back of the net. The breakthrough spurred Wanderers on, and in the ensuing minutes they put The Seagulls' penalty box under serious pressure. McShane and Prior had quick-fire shots closed down very close to goal, before Kealy came mighty close to getting his second in as many minutes, striking the cross bar.

Midway through the half Huk went up to challenge for the ball in an aerial duel with Weston skipper Nick McCootie, the keeper coming off worse with an awkward landing on his ankle. After several minutes of treatment, and talk in the stands of which outfield player might have to potentially don the gloves, Huk was deemed ok to play on, despite visibly struggling with his weakened foot. In the run up to half-time Wanderers went even closer to doubling their advantage, Briggs playing a neat one-two with Fuller down the right before having his shot deflect for a corner. Prior then did brilliant to angle his neck and meet the resulting delivery with a header, but no one could get on the ball as it came back across the six yard box. Wanderers got back in the groove straight after the restart, Josh Taylor having a header well saved by Plumley, before Prior drove an effort just wide of the far post.

Into the final ten minutes the Weston attacking third was becoming increasing sodden as the rain continued to fall hard. Wanderers task of trying to kill the game off made all the more tricky. McManus tried to bend an effort into the top right corner after coming in from the left, and at the second time of asking sub Rutherford dug out an effort which was comfortably saved by Plumley. The ball was beginning to get held up on the surface in the late stages, the referee keeping good communication with his assistants and the respective dug out's and despite a couple of consultation stoppages, the game was deemed ok to continue. Wanderers managed to hang on, booking their place in Monday's 4th qualifying round draw for the very first time.

NICKNAME THE ROMANS COUNTY SOMERSET**

Bath, as one of Europe's world heritage cities has a long and distinguished history. Bath City was formed in 1889 and played at the Belvoir Ground in East Twerton until the 1st World War. After this they played at Lambbridge (now the site of Bath Rugby club's training ground), returning to their roots in Twerton in 1932. The club has been at Twerton Park for the last 87 years. Originally the Club played in local football competitions, then joined the Western League in 1908, progressing to the Southern League in 1921. City played in the Western section of the Southern League, which they won

in 1929/30 and 1932/33. Post-war the Club won the Southern League championship in 1959/60 and again in 1977/78, when they lost only two league matches during the whole season. In the first championship-winning season, in 1960, the Club played Brighton in the FA Cup when a record 18,020 attended Twerton Park. In 1979 the Club became founder members of the Alliance Premier League, now the Football Conference, a league in which they remained until 1995/97. Relegated in that season they bounced back to the Conference two years later. John Relish took over as manager in May

2005 and after coming second in 2006, City emphatically won the Southern League title in May 2007 to earn promotion to the Conference South. Relish left in October 2008 with his assistant, Ade Britton taking over. After successive 8th place finishes, City secured promotion back to the Conference National after finishing 4th and winning the play-off final at Twerton Park in 2010. After a 10th place finish in their first season City endured a miserable season only climbing off the bottom of the division with one game to go.



# Ones To Watch



## GOALKEEPER **RYAN CLARKE**

Ryan signed for City in the summer of 2018. He started with his hometown club of Bristol Rovers, but it was at Oxford United that he made his name as one of the outstanding custodians in the lower leagues. After leaving Oxford in 2015 he joined Northampton Town and then had spells at AFC Wimbledon, Eastleigh and Torquay United. Bath City debut: Dartford 4/8/2018



## MIDFIELDER **RYAN HARLEY**

Vastly experienced attacking midfielder who is probably best remembered for his two spells with Exeter where he racked up over 200 league appearances. Has also represented Bristol City, Forest Green Rovers, Weston-Super-Mare, Milton Keynes Dons, Brighton & Hove Albion and Swindon Town. Bath City debut: Winchester City 3/10/2020




## ATTACKER **ALEX FLETCHER**

Alex spent his formative years with Plymouth Argyle but couldn't hold down a first team place in-between loan spells with Torquay, Aldershot and Tiverton. Eventually signed permanently for Tiverton before signing for City in early 2021. Bath City debut: Havant & Waterlooville 19/1/2021




**Jason, last weekend we advanced into**

suspensions to deal with which isn't ideal. Hopefully it will improve when we have a settled side.

**Following that victory against Weston Super Mare, we were drawn at home against Hayes & Yeading United on what will be a historic day for the club, what do you make of that draw?**

We reflect on how members of Wanderers first team squad are doing out on loan in the early stages of the season. **Josh Barnett - Goalkeeper** - Josh joined up with Horley Town ahead of the new campaign for a season long loan, and made his debut on the opening day away at Bedshot Lea. Competing in the Combined Counties Premier South Division, it wasn't the best of starts with his new club as they suffered heavy defeats against Badshot and then Kennington in the FA Cup preliminary stage a week later.
