His Kursi extends over the heavens and the earth, and their preservation tires Him not. And He is the Most High, the Most Great." Benefits: Reading this ayah is said to protect one from Shaitan or the devil. It is also a form of praising Allah SWT. The hadith narrated by Abu Hurairah (RA) tells us that reciting Ayatul Kursi can even catch the devil and promise protection for oneself and one's progeny. The Noble Verse of Kursi (Ayat ul Kursi) offers extraordinary protection from the evil influences of Shaytan and other negative forces. A prophetic tradition narrated by Abu Huraira illustrates this point. When someone attempted to steal Zakat-ul-Fitr, he was caught and told that reciting Ayat ul Kursi would safeguard him until dawn. Although the thief himself was a liar, the Prophet () confirmed that the verse indeed provides protection from Shaytan's evil intentions. Furthermore, Rasoolullah (peace be upon him) revealed that reading Ayat al-Kursi at the end of every obligatory prayer ensures entry into Paradise unless death intervenes. This virtuous verse not only grants Sawab but also serves as a shortcut to Jannah. One can read it at any time, including in the morning, evening, and before bed, which offers additional benefits. Reading Ayat ul Kursi after every Fardh Namaz is particularly recommended for its immense virtues. There's no fixed count for reading the verse; simply reciting it once is sufficient. For added effectiveness, consider reciting Durood Sharif before and after Ayat ul Kursi in the morning and evening.
