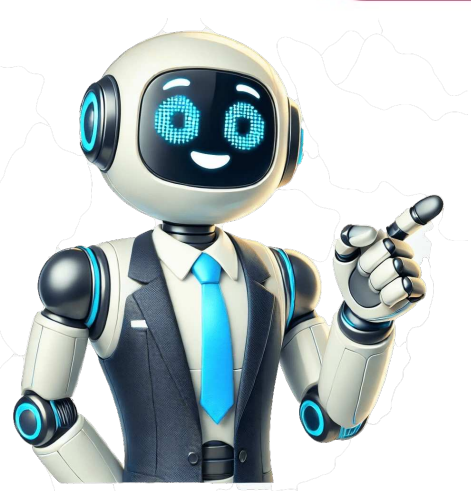

This vast resource helps users understand specialized fields by providing definitions, examples, and abbreviations. It's an essential tool for deciphering acronyms, verifying official titles, and finding equivalent terms across languages. A recent collaboration between the Translation Bureau and the World Intellectual Property Organization has enriched the space robotics terminology in TERMIUM Plus with 100 quadrilingual records. Additionally, an aid agency is an independent organization that provides assistance to countries experiencing difficult conditions or natural disasters. An airspace refers to the sky above a specific area of land or water, which a state claims control over. Albion, also known as Great Britain, has its own airspace. In the context of politics, an alderperson is a representative in local government. The American Revolution was a significant event that led to the independence of the United States from British rule. Amicus is the UK's largest technical trade union, formed by the merger of AEEU and MSF in 2001. Amnesty refers to the act of granting pardon or forgiveness to individuals, often for political crimes. The term anarchic describes a situation with no law or order, while anarchism is a belief system that advocates for the absence of government, laws, and authority. Anarchists believe that people should be free to live without any governing body. neci noun the absence of law and order, often caused by a government's loss of control or lack thereof. For instance, following the president's assassination, the country plunged into anarchy. ancillary adjective providing support or assistance in various fields, such as nursing and ancillary services. The island was incorporated into the neighbouring republic through annexation. announcement verb to inform the public or a group of people about something, often made by a returning officer or government official. The Foreign Secretary announced his upcoming trip to Nigeria. An announcement is expected regarding the election date shortly. announcement noun a public statement providing information to the general public. The Home Secretary will make an announcement later today. Annual General Meeting noun a gathering of all members of a society or shareholders of a company, typically held once a year. Articles of Confederation noun a document serving as the first U.S. Constitution, ratified by the original thirteen states in 1781. A bill verb to propose a law to Congress for consideration and passage. The proposed bill aims to address the growing healthcare crisis. Bill of Rights noun the first ten amendments to the U.S. Constitution, guaranteeing personal freedoms such as freedom of speech and religion. Bipartisanship noun when two opposing political parties work together to find common ground and a compromise, promoting unity in government. Bureaucracy noun the various departments and divisions that comprise the administrative structure of a large government. Cabinet noun a group of advisors working for the president, including the vice president and heads of 15 executive departments. Capitalism noun an economic system where private citizens own and control trade and industry for profit. Citizen noun a recognized legal member of a country, entitled to certain rights and freedoms. Civil Rights noun rights guaranteed to all citizens without discrimination, often advocated by organizations such as the African National Congress. Checks and Balances noun a system of government that prevents any one branch from becoming too powerful by limiting their authority. Congress noun the Legislative Branch of the U.S. Government, comprising the Senate and House of Representatives, Constitution noun the highest law in the land, defining the structure and principles of the U.S. Government. Amendment noun an addition or change to the Constitution, requiring ratification by three-fourths of the states. The framework of the U.S. government encompasses seven articles and twenty-seven amendments, comprising various entities to ensure effective governance. Key components include representatives who act as delegates for groups, a democratic system where power rests with the populace, and an electoral college that selects the President of the United States based on state population ratios. The Executive Branch is headed by the president, supported by key departments, while the Legislative Branch comprises the Senate and House of Representatives. Other essential features include impeachment procedures to remove officials from office, a judicial system led by the Supreme Court, and mechanisms like lobbying for influence and term limits for elected positions.

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
