

Elliott Fox 'Saint Grey' art exhibition inspires and moves across Australia

The 'Saint Grey' art exhibition has been the biggest project and the busiest year of my life, and all the hard work and perseverance has come together! When I started planning my début solo exhibition two years ago and I decided the theme was to be in honour of my rescue greyhound and artistic muse, Adam Barker, I wanted to do right by him and all greyhounds.



As part of this effort, I've announced that all 18 artworks in the 'Saint Grey' art exhibition are being auctioned with all proceeds donated to the ten supporting greyhound charities and advocacy groups. The auction began with the opening of the first exhibition and will finish on 21 January 2026 with the final exhibition close. The 'Saint Grey' exhibition has a new Principal Sponsor and Friend of the Exhibition, GREY2K USA Worldwide, who are a major greyhound advocacy group around the world. The exhibition launched with a sold-out opening night on 15 August 2025 in Surry Hills, Sydney with over 100 people and 11 greyhound guests of honour! I was also thrilled to welcome to the opening night, Emma Hurst MLC from the Animal Justice Party who have become a Major Sponsor. Abigail Boyd MLC from the Greens also attended the exhibition during the week. A special thank you as well to Mark for volunteering at the bar.

There has been growing awareness and media interest for the 'Saint Grey' exhibition, and I've delivered several radio, podcast, and published interviews. In addition, the artwork 'History Won't Be Kind / Minister,' was even tabled in NSW Parliament by Abigail Boyd MLC at the NSW Budget Estimates on 26 August 2025, calling on the Minister for Racing to consider "What is your legacy?" In February 2026, I will also be at the Animal Rights Forum to speak about art and advocacy.

The 'Saint Grey' art exhibition tour continues from strength to strength! Following Sydney, the exhibition travelled to Canberra, ACT (12–25 September 2025) and Melbourne, VIC (10–23 October 2025), with full-house openings and many more greyhounds! I also announced another location to the tour, a Pop-Up Gallery at the Hoomans Helping Hounds boutique in Shearwater, TAS (1 November – 6 December 2025), before the artworks head to their final exhibition in Perth, WA (13–21 January 2026). I want to give a big shout out to my fiancée, Isaac for his unwavering support and encouragement.

It isn't cheap to work as an artist without a steady income, let alone delivering a major art exhibition that is travelling across the country to raise awareness and funds for greyhounds. There are two ways you can support the exhibition:
