Communities Network: Belonging, Accountability, and Support

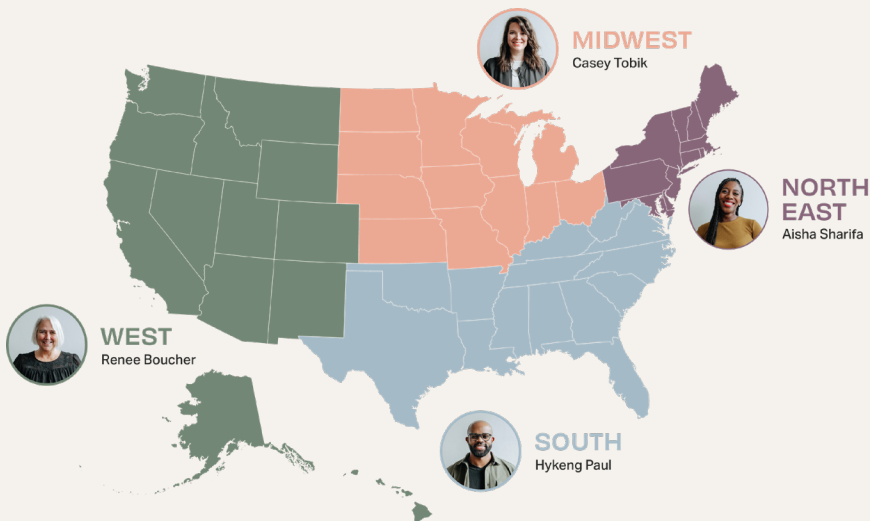
