




A Prayer Devotional

Psalm 17:6

I call on you, my God, for you will answer me; turn your ear to me and hear my prayer.



Prayer Prompt #1

Pray for repentance of our our sin.

Jesus, when we pray for a horrible injustice like human trafficking it's easy to forget our own sins that play into this atrocity. We all have root sin causing us to desire to rule over others, even God himself. God, we also acknowledge that we struggle with selfishness, lust, and greed, three factors that greatly feed the evil of human trafficking. Please forgive us for our sins. Help us to repent and change. Enable us to serve and love others. Shape us into your likeness. Help us shine like the stars in the heavens.

Luke 5:32

"I have not come to call the righteous, but sinners to repentance."

Psalm 103:6

"The Lord works righteousness and justice for all who are oppressed."

Acts 16: 25-34

Prayer Prompt #2

Pray for liberation and justice to be brought to the individuals being trafficked

Father, we beg for the liberation of people who are being trafficked. Please bring freedom to the 40 million people who are being oppressed through human trafficking. Remove the chains of their oppressors and help them escape. Just as you helped Paul and Silas escape the jail, free these people supernaturally. Free them through the repentance of oppressors. Free them through the work of your people to administer justice. However you do it, please grant freedom.

Psalm 146: 7

"Who executes justice for the oppressed, who gives food to the hungry. The Lord sets the prisoners free."

Psalm 130: 1-3

"I waited patiently for the Lord, he inclined to me and heard my cry. He drew me up from the pit of destruction, out of the miry bog, and set my feet upon a rock, making my steps secure. He put a new song in my mouth, a song of praise to our God. Many will see and fear, and put their trust in the Lord. Father, you are a God of Miracles."

Prayer Prompt #3

Pray for healing, restoration, and purpose for those being exploited.

God, you are a God of miracles. You are a healer, restorer, life-giver. We know you can bring life, purpose, and joy back to people who have had the years stolen away as if by locusts. Father, we ask that you would enter into their lives through other people, through your word, through opportunities, and through peace to enable healing. Put a new song in their hearts.

Joel 2:25

Prayer Prompt #4

Pray for salvation of people being trafficked.

Jesus, would you save those being trafficked not only from the slavery they are held in, but from the slavery that is in their hearts. Save them from the sin that, no matter where a person is born and what life they live, is always there. You are good and forgiving, abounding in steadfast love. Cause these dear people to call upon you so that you can save them. Grant them an eternity where every tear will be wiped away and every injustice against them made right. May You be their hope.

Luke 15:7

"Just so, I tell you, there will be more joy in heaven over one sinner who repents than over ninety-nine righteous persons who need no repentance."

Prayer Prompt #5

Pray for opened eyes, repentance, and salvation for traffickers.

Oh God, how hard it is to pray for our enemies. But you have called us to do just that. Iesus demonstrated this when he prayed for us, your enemies, and so we pray for these traffickers. We ask that you would remove the sin that blinds them and open their eyes to the evil they commit. We ask that they would turn from their sin and repent. We pray for your faith and salvation for them, that they would seek your forgiveness and find it. We pray they would seek and receive the forgiveness of those whom they've victimized. God, only you can do such a work. If you have done it on our lives, you can do it in theirs. No one is too far for the reach of your gospel.

Psalm 37: 17

"For the arms of the wicked shall be broken, but the Lord upholds the righteous."



Prayer Prompt #6

Pray for arrest and prosecution of traffickers.

Heavenly Father, you are a just God. Our very notion of justice comes from you. You are perfect and holy. You are without sin, and because of this, you require payment for sin. We ask for justice to come to those who traffic people. We ask for authorities to locate, arrest, prosecute, and sentence these lawbreakers.

Psalm 7:9

Prayer Prompt #7

Pray for governments to help stop trafficking.

Father, we pray for governments to stand on the side of those being trafficked. Your word says that you hold the king's heart like a stream in your hand. So we ask that you would turn the hearts of leaders, that they would enact laws and systems to protect the vulnerable. We pray against corruption in all levels of government and law enforcement. We ask you to change governments so that they hate evil, love good, and establish justice at their gates.

Prayer Prompt #8

Pray against poverty, lust, and greed.

Jesus, you know the roots of this atrocity. Some of them are poverty, greed, and lust. God, first we want to pray for those in poverty. Would you help bring people out of positions that lead to desperation, making them vulnerable to traffickers. Please bring work into these areas. Father, grant a way for people to care for their families and themselves so that they are not easily stolen away. We are so broken over the other roots as well, lust and greed. Would you open hearts and eyes to the sickness of lust and greed. Would you make them see that feeding off the flesh and backs of others is wrong and leads to nothing but emptiness.

Luke 12:15 (Greed)

"And he said to them, 'Take care, and be on your guard against all covetousness, for one's life does not consist in the abundance of his possessions.'"

Luke 12:2

"Nothing is covered up that will not be revealed, or hidden that will not be known."

Prayer Prompt #9

Pray for awareness to grow.

God, would you help the public to see this as a problem for us all, not just those directly touched by human trafficking. As hard as it is to see and hear the truth and reality of what happens to people who are being exploited, we ask that you would help awareness increase. Show us how this is not only a problem overseas, but right here in our own cities. God, reveal to people how pornography plays into human trafficking. Give favour to those who are giving a voice to this cause. Help the truth of what is happening both locally and globally and allows us reach all races, ethnicities, and socio-economic classes. Pierce our consciences with the truth.



Prayer Prompt #10

Pray for the church.

Father, we pray for your church to rise up and speak for the helpless, vulnerable, imprisoned, and oppressed. We ask that you would awaken this issue in our congregations and bring unity between denominations so that we can unite to end this evil. We pray for new laborers to come out of the church for this cause, people willing to work daily to bring an end to human trafficking.

Prayer Prompt #11

Pray for Fight4Freedom and other anti-trafficking organizations.

God, we pray for Fight4Freedom and other organizations that fight for this cause. We ask that you would grant your blessing and favour over these people. Give them safety, both physically and spiritually. Give them endurance to keep fighting the fight. Give them light and encouragement as they engage in such a dark place. Most of all, we pray that you would grant them your love so that they can pour out love on these people who so desperately need it.

Prayer Prompt #12

Pray for us to take action.

Father, raise us up to action! Raise up your people to go in and rescue. Raise up your people to fight for education and prevention. Raise up your people to risk their lives so that others can be saved. Father, you are a God of freedom, your whole purpose in sending Jesus was to provide freedom to the captives. Please provide freedom for these individuals and provide arms waiting to help restore them. Raise up an army of people willing to take action in a variety of different forms so that an end can come to the evil of human trafficking.
