



2026 Rules

Players must be 55 years old in 2026

Choose your division (tee)

White Division – A & B flights, white tee, white handicap – Net stroke play

Green Division – A & B flights, green, blue, or black tee, using respective tee handicap – Net stroke play
If choosing Blue or Black tee player must inform Len len.i.osullivan@gmail.com and play that tee all season

NEW FOR 2026

Handicaps will be calculated by the league using SrLg scores only

Playing Rules

Ball is played down

Unless otherwise stated by pro shop

All putts must be holed

Max score per hole is triple bogey

4 Days to post score ... Sunday, Mon, Tue, or Wed.

Record all your gross scores and handicap you played the round with in league book

League will use your “best net” score for the week

Example Player A plays 3 times during the posting window (Sun-Wed)

shoots 91, 87, 94 ... posts all 3 gross scores in the SrLg book

League will use his “best” score of 87, less handicap to get his net score for the week

Player(s) can play anytime of day with whomever.

Score from other games (Bogey Club, Rat Pack, Men’s Club weekly game etc.), can be used.

Player must record

Gross score

Handicap he played round with

In the league book, located in pro shop, by end of play Wednesday

Regular Season Standings

Players who post score, receive points each week based on where they finish

Standings by average points

Total points divided by total rounds posted

Weekly Points

1st 25pts, 2nd 23, 3rd 21, 4th 19, 5th, 18pts ... 15th 8 pts ... post a score 5pts

Minimum of 10 posted scores, required to qualify for playoffs

Player is allowed to miss 3 weeks with no penalty

See exemptions below

Flight Playoffs

***Post your best score eliminated**

***Must declare which day during Sun to Wed window playoff score will be played**

***Declare to Pro shop personnel who will initial and date players scoring area in league book**

Playoff points gained will be **ADDED** to regular season points average

Round 1 - Top 20 and ties

Round 2 – cut to top 10 and ties

Rd 3 Flight Championship(s) Top 4 – played during closing shotgun

Flight Championship Top 4

seeding tie breaker – Higher Regular Season Finish*

Flight Championship Format

Points eliminated

1 round of Net Stroke Play

1st starts -2 / 2nd starts -1 / 3rd starts -0.5 / 4th starts even

Tie Breaker – Higher Regular Season Finish*

Senior League Champion – Shootout #18

4 Flight Champions – Aggregate scoring from:

- Champions with handicap of 10 or less 115 yds
- Champions with handicap of 11 or more 100 yds
- Winner additional \$100

Tie Breaker – chip off from designated spot, closest to the pin

*Regular Season Finish Tie Breaker

- Regular season rounds played (most weeks with posted score)
- Regular season lowest net scoring average
- Regular season lowest gross scoring average

Consolation Division Competition

Division Consolation Format

- 1 round net stroke play
- Separate White and Green consolation
 - 1st \$30
 - 2nd \$25
 - 3rd \$20
 - Tie breaker retrogression

Exemptions to minimum 10 round rule:

All exemption requests must be sent to Declan declandunn5458@gmail.com

All requests will be considered and voted on by committee.

Medical – Regular season

For player(s) who miss 4 or more weeks of play due to illness or injury.

If exemption is granted and the player(s) Avg/Pts would have been in the top 20, he, will enter playoffs as the “last” seed, increasing the total number of players eligible to participate in playoffs.

Vacation - Regular season

Player must contact league “before” vacation period begins

Player knows he will miss more than 3 weeks of regular season play.

He may ask league to post a “next week score” during current week posting “window”

Example:

Week 11, player “A” posts his current week score on Sunday.

On Mon, Tue, or Wed of same week, he posts his “next” week 12, score

No exemptions for Final Championship round.
