

2014 USAC NATIONAL MIDGET SEASON

RICO SMOOTH FROM THE START

There is no such thing as a perfect season in auto racing. Sure, a driver or team could win every single race, but in the strive for perfection, there are always areas where one can find areas of improvement. In 2014, Rico Abreu needed to be just about as perfect as possible to defeat his teammate and defending series champ Christopher Bell, and he nearly was.

The second year driver amassed podium finishes in each of his first nine feature starts, collecting top-three results by the barrel full, from the beginning of the season in April all the way through the deep, sweltering months of summer, garnering four feature victories, 13 top-fives, 15 top-tens and led the standings from start to finish to edge Bell by a mere 10 tallies.

Abreu made a statement with a blistering start, opening the season with back-to-back victories in the inaugural Kokomo Grand Prix in April at Kokomo (Ind.) Speedway. He wired all 30 laps in a KKM podium sweep of night one, then capitalized on a restart after race leader Bell bounced through turn three with a broken right rear stop. On the ensuing lap 14 restart, Bryan Clauson assumed the lead, but Abreu was wound up on the top and shot to the lead and the 40-lap victory.

Rico conquered a frenetic affair in June at Lawrenceburg Speedway on his path to the Indiana Midget Week crown. At The Burg, the deciding slide job came three laps from the finish line when he and leader Alex Bright made contact as they fought for the same turn two real estate, with Abreu speeding away to the win. In August, Abreu made it abundantly clear that he had tired of finishing second in the finale of the Belleville (Kan.) Midget Nationals as he had the previous two years. Abreu used a mid-race slider for the lead and flawlessly rode the rim of the legendary half-mile for an emotional victory.

At this juncture, Abreu had been practically flawless. He'd accumulated 12 top-10 finishes in 12 starts, and with a 111-point lead, he was sailing unheeded to the championship shore. But with Bell in his rearview, he couldn't count his chickens before they hatched. Bell kept pace with Abreu in terms of victories to that point, winning four times, and survived a grueling 40-lap bash in May at Illinois' Belle-Clair Speedway, but a massive flip during his heat race in the IMW opener at Indiana's Lincoln Park Speedway stifled his momentum and forced him to miss the rest of the night's program.

Still feeling the effects of a wicked tumble, Bell wasted no time rebounding and topped the field at Bloomington Speedway the following evening. He rolled into July on an epic heatwave when he convincingly captured both nights of the Firemen's Nationals at Wisconsin's Angell Park Speedway, leading the charge in two-straight complete KKM podium sweeps.

The final leg of the season, following the Belleville Nationals, found the tables turned quite drastically between Abreu and Bell. This time around, it was Bell who turned in A+ workmanship as he notched a pair of feature wins, two runner-up finishes and a third-place result in his next five outings. Bell picked up right where he left off at Angell Park to score his third win of the season at the track in August's CornFest, then posted a cogent performance in a November prelim for the Western World Championships at Arizona's Canyon Speedway Park. In that same timeframe, Abreu recorded feature finishes of 13th, 11th, 9th, 6th and 13th, which collapsed his commanding point lead to just 26 entering the season finale.

Bell finished with a flourish as his winning ways continued in the final round, the Turkey Night Grand Prix at Perris (Calif.) Auto Speedway. He maximized his point output by leading the final 70 laps and celebrated his series-leading seventh feature triumph of the year. Meanwhile, Abreu was able to stem the tide with a fifth-place finish to put the title race on ice as the series driving champion by just 10 points. It was a full-on celebration for the Keith Kunz/Curb-Agajanian Motorsports bunch with their number 97 machine eking out the entrant championship over their number 71 team car.

Clauson put three in the win column, celebrating his 25th birthday in victory lane during the IMW finale at Kokomo (Ind.) Speedway in June, the same victory lane that was named for him just a couple years later. He snuck by Zach Daum on a mid-race restart to collect July's Chad McDaniel Memorial at Kansas' Solomon Valley Raceway. On a Sunday morning in September, Clauson went flag-to-flag to stave off Bell's charge after he became embroiled in a three-car flip on lap two.

Four drivers won once in 2014. Tracy Hines started on the pole, fell to fifth, then worked his way back to the front to win the Western World opener. Darren Hagen waited until the penultimate round to score his first win, and he made it a big one in the Western World finale, narrowly avoiding a repeat of last year's heartbreak to hold off Tanner Thorson by a car length. Dave Darland led the distance of the IMW opener at Lincoln Park after nearly getting entangled on the initial start by front row starter Thorson who spun in front of the field. Zach Daum cruised to the win on the opening night of the Belleville Midget Nationals, starting in row two before vanishing into the distance with a 6.920 second margin of victory.

Kevin Thomas Jr. became the first driver hailing from the state of Alabama to be named series Rookie of the Year, finishing 13th in points with a best feature finish of sixth twice in April at Kokomo. A pair of "firsts" also marked the 2014 season. For the first time, no first-time series winners emerged during the season. Furthermore, for the first time ever, no races on pavement tracks were scheduled on the USAC National Midget trail with all 18 events taking place solely on dirt.
