

## 2015 USAC NATIONAL MIDGET SEASON

### HINES COMPLETES THE CROWN

By 2015, Tracy Hines had firmly established his legacy as one of USAC's all-time greats. He possessed 91 USAC National feature wins, USAC Silver Crown and National Sprint Car titles, and a laundry list of scores in events from coast-to-coast. Yet, there was still one piece of the puzzle that had eluded him after all this time: a USAC National Midget championship.

With nary a single win, nor a single lap led throughout the season, Hines proved to be consistent race-in, race-out, netting eight top-fives and 13 top-tens in 17 starts. He regularly started near the front of the pack by virtue of having never qualified outside the top-10 at any point in 2015. Hines' road to the title didn't come without its trials and tribulations, and he had the battle scars to prove it. During June's Indiana Midget Week round at Lawrenceburg, Hines broke his collarbone during a rough-and-tumble flip, requiring surgery that forced him to miss two weeks of competition. The following night's IMW finale at Kokomo was met with rain. Pushed to the following Sunday, it was rained out again.

Not that there's ever a good time to come down with an injury, but the timing of the mishaps was fortunate for Hines' sake. But not for long, as it turned out. Weeks later, a sore yet determined Hines fought through the pain to compete in Indiana Sprint Week. However, on the fourth night out, once again at Lawrenceburg, lightning struck twice and he flipped once more, resulting in cracked ribs which sent him to the sidelines yet again as he nursed his wounds and healed up until the midget season resumed three weeks later. Hines had been a consistent performer throughout his first seven starts, collecting a best of second in April at Kokomo and a pair of thirds to go along with a couple fast qualifying times, but had seen his grip at the top of the points loosen significantly following Angell Park, dipping him down to third, 27 points back.

New point leader Kevin Thomas Jr. solidified his new position at the top of the standings by grabbing his second victory of the season in late July at Kansas' Solomon Valley Raceway, this coming after winning his first career series race back in May at Plymouth, which had now been fully converted to a dirt track. Hines dug in and returned to form throughout the three-race Great Plains swing in late July and early August, knocking out a third at Solomon Valley and a fourth on both nights of the Belleville (Kan.) Midget Nationals, which launched him back in front of KTJ by seven points and headed east.

Thomas surged in front of Hines over the next two August races at Pennsylvania's Path Valley Speedway Park and Lincoln Speedway with a third and a fourth. Nonetheless, consecutive nights of wall contact at Illinois' Tri-City Speedway in September allowed Hines to climb back on top by 23 points despite only garnering a ninth and a 15th over the two night span. It was in this moment in mid-September that Hines made the surprising revelation that he would retire at the end of the season. That meant it was now or never for his title hopes with this being the swan song of a fantastic career.

At September's 4-Crown Nationals at Ohio's Eldora Speedway, Hines accomplished exactly what he needed to do – finish ahead of Thomas – doing so with a third to Thomas' fifth. Thomas Jr. contended early in the series debut at Illinois' Wayne County Speedway, but fell back to 10th with Hines 12th, setting up a final showdown at Perris (Calif.) Auto Speedway.

November's Turkey Night Grand Prix stage was set with Hines up 27 over Thomas and 33 over the emerging Tanner Thorson. Hines, needing a ninth place finish to clinch the title, wound up a solid sixth, walking into the sunset as the sixth ever USAC career Triple Crown champion with the final separation in points between first and third a record low 24 points.

"It's really just a relief to end it and do this on the final night," Hines said. "I've been running every race and chasing points for 20 years, and it just has worn me down. I'm happy to go out on top winning the championship in this division. It's been a trying year at times, but we persevered and met this goal. To join such a great group of racers who have won the Triple Crown is pretty cool, as I know them all and raced against all but one, and we've battled with each other all along."

Thorson finished as the runner-up just 18 points behind Hines despite missing two races in June following a devastating feature crash at Lincoln Park. He won four times in total, breaking through for his first career series victory in June at Gas

City, followed by a two-night sweep of the Gold Crown Midget Nationals in September and led the last six at Turkey Night en route to being named the Most Improved Driver. Spencer Bayston, fifth in the standings, was the Rookie of the Year.

Rico Abreu won a season-high five features with his second consecutive Lawrenceburg victory and second successive Indiana Midget Week crown, then used a final corner slide job to edge Thorson at the line by less than a tenth in July at Wisconsin's Angell Park Speedway. He followed that by picking up where he left off at Belleville to capture the opening night prelim, then lost the lead and gained it back late to slide by for the win in the series debut at Path Valley, and one night later, was victorious again, stealing the checkered like a thief in the night late at Pennsylvania's Lincoln Speedway.

Bryan Clauson set fast time at Lincoln to break Parnelli Jones' one-lap track record set in 1964. BC won thrice in 2015, first with a drive from 10th to win at Lincoln Park; in a breathtakingly dominant performance to become a three-time Belleville champion; and in a masterful drive to outduel Abreu for a \$20,000 prize in the Jason Leffler Memorial at Wayne County.

Christopher Bell won twice, duplicating his Bloomington victory while subbing for Thorson following his injury, then went wire-to-wire at Eldora. Darren Hagen opened the season to make it 11 straight years with a least one USAC National win. He also overcame the dominance of the Kunz Brothers (Keith and Rusty) whose respective teams won all but one race. The Keith Kunz/Curb-Agajanian juggernaut won 13 races while Rusty Kunz/Joe Dooling won three and Kenny Brown one.
