

1995 USAC NATIONAL MIDGET SEASON REVIEW

STEWART'S "TRIPLE" CROWNING ACHIEVEMENT

Tony Stewart repeated in his quest for a USAC National Midget driving championship in 1995, finishing off a masterpiece season that saw the Columbus, Ind. native complete a feat once thought to be unattainable – the USAC Triple Crown.

After notching the Silver Crown and National Sprint Car titles in the preceding months, the third rung of Stewart's crowning achievement came in the Midgets in which he completed a remarkable comeback after nearly abandoning his title run at one point, but it was crew chief Bob East's confidence that kept him on-track and motivated for a poised run to the finish.

"The early part of the season was a struggle, but Bob kept pushing me to be the best I could, and his support was vital."

Stewart and car owner Ralph Potter, with whom Stewart won the 1994 title, struggled during their first four starts of the season. The pair parted ways in the middle of the May 13 program at Indianapolis Raceway Park with Stewart immediately taking over the reins of the Steve Lewis No. 9 for the subsequent heat race and feature event that same night.

The combo instantly clicked, winning their first feature together two races later in June, a 30-lapper at the Terre Haute (Ind.) Action Track, but it wasn't all easy sledding from there on as the team's resilience and patience were put to the test.

Dan Drinan led all 30 laps to emerge as the victor on July 3 at Richmond (Ky.) Raceway following a skirmish with Stewart while battling for the lead on a restart with four laps remaining that left Stewart spinning to a disappointing 13th place finish. As a result, USAC issued Drinan a \$1,000 fine and the forfeiture of all the feature points he gained that night.

On August 2 at IRP, it was déjà vu as the rivalry between Drinan and Stewart reached a fever pitch. Drinan's attempt at a double slide job from third to first, with 17 laps to go, went awry with Drinan contacting race leader Stewart, which sent him and the second-place car of Andy Michner into the outside wall, while Drinan continued on to win the event.

Drinan was assessed another \$1,000 fine and the loss of 30 feature points to go along with a suspension for the following two events at Kansas' Lakeside Speedway and Missouri's I-70 Speedway, which all but concluded his title chances. Stewart was buried back in the sixth position, 68 points out of the lead following IRP, but that was where Smoke's fire was lit.

Stewart's six wins gave car owner Steve Lewis his second career entrant title, with five of Stewart's six in his Beast/Gaerte coming after August. He took Lakeside, then IRP in mid-August with his defining title moment arriving in September at Terre Haute. "The Hut 100 capped it all off," Stewart admitted. "It seemed like I could do no wrong after that."

Michner DNF'd with mechanical issues at Terre Haute, slicing his point lead to just seven. Stewart overtook the point lead following September's 4-Crown at Ohio's Eldora Speedway where he and Kenny Irwin Jr. swapped the lead on the final lap while Michner dropped out. Stewart then added a third straight score in October at Louisville (Ky.) Motor Speedway.

Now with some separation, Stewart clinched the title with a seventh place finish in November's Turkey Night Grand Prix at Bakersfield (Calif.) Speedway and a 63-point final margin over Michner, who finished as the runner-up once again.

Billy Boat made the end-of-year California swing historic as he became the first driver to win the final three USAC National Midget features in a season, doing so at Ventura, Bakersfield and in the first ever USAC National event held at Perris.

Drinan dropped to ninth in points in the end as he curtailed his appearances after the suspension. He earned 10 fast times and opened the season by capturing the fastest race in series history, averaging 128.821 mph for the 25-lap distance in the Copper World Classic at Phoenix International Raceway, which ended spectacularly with Drinan and Davey Hamilton touching wheels in the final turn, and vaulted the oncoming car of John Sarna over the inside wall and into the pit area.

Third in the final standings was Brian Gerster who was named the Most Improved Driver while Ryan Newman finished 10th and earned Rookie of the Year honors. Eventually, he'd become the first individual to be named top-Rookie in all three USAC National series in his career. Meanwhile, IRP became the first racetrack to earn the Jim Blunk Memorial Award.

Wheel inspection after qualifying revealed stress-related cracks, which forced cancellation of June's event at the newly repaved Winchester (Ind.) Speedway. Meanwhile, Bob Cicconi experienced a scare on the way to April's race at Louisville when the landing gear on his airplane collapsed upon landing before going on to finish 10th in that night's feature.
