

1986 USAC NATIONAL LATE MODEL SEASON

THIS BILLY IS ANYTHING BUT IDLE

After a successful debut year for the Late Model series, a vastly expanded schedule was announced for 1986. Two pavement venues were included on the slate, and former competitor Bill Moyer served as the promoter for three-straight races in May deemed "The Stock Car Racing Spring Jamboree." Before the year began, it was announced that teenager Chrissy Oliver had joined the tour. Her father, Gary Oliver, a former stock car driver, owned Tri-City Buggy, a leading chassis manufacturer based in Rock Island, Ill. A young woman racing at this level was highly unusual in this age.

The season began on the first Friday in May at Sportsdrome Speedway in Jeffersonville, Ind. "Chargin" Charlie Glotzbach, the runner-up at the 1969 and 1972 Daytona 500, was the fastest qualifier, but Billy Moyer proved he could manage the pavement and led Dick Potts and defending series champion Charlie Sentman to the stripe.

The Spring Jamboree kicked off at Oklahoma's Tri-State Speedway where future National Sprint Car Hall of Fame inductee Gary Wright wheeled Charles Dupree's car to the win. The Hooks, Texas driver topped a stellar 50-car field. Jeff Purvis, in his pristine Imperial Motors mount, then proved to be the master of the Show Me State, taking back-to-back wins at I-44 Speedway in Lebanon, Mo., and then further west, he survived a duel with Larry Phillips at Monett Speedway. Later that summer, Purvis collected his third World 100 at Eldora Speedway.

Billy Moyer carried the point lead into the May 24 round at Indiana's Lincoln Park Speedway and wasn't inclined to relinquish it. Moyer wrestled the lead from Ray Godsey with 10 circuits remaining and Ray was soon sidelined with brake failure. At the checkered flag, Illinois driver Rick Standridge settled for second with fast qualifier Ray Guss Jr. rounding out the podium.

After a four-week break, defending champion Charlie Sentman beamed with pride when he finally muscled his No. 1 machine into victory lane in Wilmot, Wis. Sentman led all 40 circuits to best Bloomington, Indiana's Ernie Barrow. One day after the nation's birthday, the tour invaded the Terre Haute Action Track for the Firecracker 40. Steve Barnett, the future mayor of Franklin, Ind., was the quickest qualifier, but Ken Schrader led every lap for owner Harry Sieveking. With a runner-up finish, Moyer was still firmly in charge.

Rain hampered the July 10 appearance at Macon Speedway in Illinois, but the troops returned on July 24 for the running of the Decatur Herald-Review 100. Butch Garner led the first 46 laps but subsequently suffered mechanical woes. A good tussle over the second half of the event found Illiopolis, Ill. driver Jim Leka emerge as the victor.

The Junkyard 100 at the paved Anderson Speedway was one of the most intriguing tilts of the year. While Larry Moore was a versatile racer, he was best known for his exploits on dirt. A three-time winner of the World 100, Moore had never raced on the high-banked oval. He lost a motor the day before during a practice session, and after scrambling to get back into the fray, he arrived for qualifications with just 10 minutes to spare. He was armed with Roy Landrum's dirt car. With one lap at his disposal, Moore's time was the best of them all. His problems were not over. During a red flag condition, Moore's crew worked on the car, and as a result, he was sent to the rear of the field. It wasn't enough to keep him from victory.

Two races in August kicked off with an appearance at Santa Fe Speedway in Hinsdale, Ill. where Billy Moyer got back on track. Moyer passed Gibby Steinhaus just shy of the halfway point to score for the third time on the campaign. One week later, Kings Mountain, N.C. ace Freddy Smith passed Ernie Barrow in the late stages of the race to win at Lincoln Park Speedway. It was the second win for owner Roy Landrum.

The year closed with two big events. First, the tour stopped at the Illinois State Fairgrounds. Bob Pierce set the qualifying standard at the imposing mile while Illinois driver Ray Guss Jr. topped the field for owner Larry Branan. Missouri's Mike Wallace and Larry Moore completed the podium.

The year concluded with the 4-Crown Nationals at Eldora Speedway where Billy Moyer put an exclamation point on his year. Moyer was not present for the preliminary events held on September 27 and was forced to start the following day's last chance race at the rear of the field. After a second place run in the 15-lap affair, he had no choice but to start in the scratch position for the feature event. To the delight of the crowd, Billy moved to the front on the 32nd circuit and cruised to the win and the title. Moyer's car owner Larry Shaw was the entrant champion. For the second straight year, the champion was also named Rookie of the Year. Morocco, Ind. driver Dick Potts finished second in the season standings followed by Ernie Barrow.
