REDEMPTION: SCHUDY MAKES COMEBACK TO CAPTURE USAC MWRA TITLE

One year after a rib injury shelved his title aspirations, Kory Schudy put together a complete season in 2021 to capture his first career USAC Wholesale Batteries Midwest Wingless Racing Association Sprint Car championship.

The 36-year-old Battlefield, Mo. native was in the thick of the series title race midseason in 2020 when a rib injury forced him out of competition for five races and halted his championship aspirations. Though he'd return before the end of the season, his championship hopes would have to be put off for one more year.

The time arrived in 2021 with Schudy winning on three occasions in his Jon Sawyer Racing No. 28, spurred on by back-to-back midseason victories at Winston, Missouri's I-35 Speedway and at Central Missouri Speedway in Warrensburg. A triumph in the penultimate round at I-35 in late August solidified his position at the top of the standings.

Schudy's "worst" finish all season long came in a 10th place performance in the second contest of the year at Double X Speedway in California, Mo. Outside of that brief aberration, Schudy's performances were phenomenal with only a single finish outside the top-five in 13 appearances: 2nd, 2nd, 4th, 1st, 1st, 5th, 5th, 1st, 3rd, 3rd, 2nd, 3rd.

The main nemesis for Schudy throughout the 13-race calendar was Wesley Smith (Billings, Mo.) who elevated to the second position in the standings, 45 points behind Schudy, after finishing third one year ago.

Smith led all drivers with four scores at four different venues aboard the John Helm Racing No. 12 in 2021, at Missouri's Bethany Speedway, at Kansas' 81 Speedway, at Missouri's I-35 Speedway and at Missouri's Valley Speedway.

All Jack Wagner needed was four starts to corral two wins during the campaign, in May at Double X and in August at Lakeside Speedway in Kansas City, Kan. as the pilot of the Jesse Hockett Racing No. 77.

The 2020 series champion, Wyatt Burks (Topeka, Kan.), posted his all-time series leading eighth USAC MWRA victory in June of 2021 at Osborn, Missouri's U.S. 36 Raceway en route to a fifth-place result in the final standings in the self-owned No. 11w.

Three drivers – Cody Baker, Xavier Doney and Luke Howard – all became first-time series winners this past season. Baker won for grandfather Ted Hall behind the wheel of the No. 9H in the season opener at Nevada, Mo. Xavier Doney (Odessa, Mo.) notched his first at Salina Speedway in Kansas during the month of August for car owner Dan Lawson's No. 74. Luke Howard (Overland Park, Kan.) got his "W" at the dawn of September in his family-owned No. 2H at Bethany.

Tim Kent (Bristow, Okla.) reigned victorious in the 65th Hutchinson Grand National Auto Races in his own No. 79, which marked the series debut at the Kansas State Fairgrounds in Hutchinson, Kan., a non-points special event for MWRA.

MWRA stalwarts and consistent frontrunners Chris Parkinson (Gladstone, Mo.) and Chad Goff (Spring Hill, Kan.) collected top-five placements in the final MWRA standings with Parkinson fourth and Goff fifth.

Parkinson and Goff were among the four drivers able to start all 13 points-paying feature events throughout the season along with Schudy and Smith.

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BAKER COOKS IN NEVADA'S USAC MWRA SPRINT OPENER

Nevada, Missouri.....The USAC MWRA Sprints kicked off the 2021 Season with a bang Saturday night at Nevada Speedway!

Cody Baker of Lone Jack, Missouri, driving for his grandfather Ted Hall would be victorious in the 25-lapper after holding off the advances of Battlefield, Missouri's Kory Schudy driving the JSR Racing #28 of Jon Sawyer, and Chris Parkinson in his #65 CPR non winged sprint.

In a great effort by all involved, including Jerry Davis of Nevada Speedway, the rain that fell on the track both Friday, and Saturday, would not keep the show from going on.

29 Non-Winged Sprints from Missouri, Kansas, Colorado, Illinois, and Iowa made the trip to Nevada for the first time in series history to race in front of a near capacity crowd.

Kansas City's Tom Curran won the first heat over Zach Clark and Brian Beebe. While in a stacked 2nd heat, Kory Schudy would get the W over Cody Baker who started in 6th place and defending series champ Wyatt Burks in the Rumsey #11w.

In heat number 3, Springfield, Illinois, chauffeur Vinnie Ward came home victorious over Lane Stone, and 2020 Most Improved driver Dakota Earls. And in heat number 4, Higginsville racer Brad Ryun won over Chris Parkinson, and Danny Billings.

After the redraw which saw high point man Baker role a zero to start on the pole for the main event. Spring Hills Kyle Lewis won the B feature in impressive fashion over Wesley Smith racing the WSR/ Helm #12, J.D. Black, Luke Howard, Mitchell Moore, and rookie Heath Murry, competing for the first time in a sprint car. Setting the field for the 22 car A feature.

A wild and exciting race saw Baker hold off Schudy throughout the 25-lap contest. Including some nail biting restarts where Kory would pull almost even with Cody coming out of the second turn, before Baker would race past the Springfield area driver going down the backstretch to lead the entire distance.

When the checkers flew, Baker would take his first ever MWRA feature win, while Schudy would come 2nd, and Parkinson raced his way to the podium finishing in 3rd place. Photos by John Lee HighFly-nphotos.com

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WAGNER WINS HOCKETT TRIBUTE RACE AT DOUBLE X

California, Missouri (May 30, 2021).....Sunday night at Double X Speedway, Lone Jack Mo. racer Jack Wagner won his first ever USAC Wholesale Batteries Midwest Wingless Racing Association Sprint Car feature at Double X Speedway in California, Mo.

Wagner held at bay Wesley Smith of Nixa, Mo., Wyatt Burks of Topeka, Kan. Quinton Benson of Sweet Springs, Mo. and Zach Daum of Pocahontas, Ill., who rounded out the top-five. Riley Kreisel, Tom Curran, Bradlee Ryun, Xavier Doney and Kory Schudy finished in positions 6th thru 10th in the 22-car feature event.

Wagner was a very popular winner on this night driving the JHR Hockett Racing No. 77 to the win in the Jesse Hockett Tribute Race which saw him pass Quinton Benson early in the feature on the bottom before later holding off spirited charges from Benson, and Wesley Smith, who marched through the field on the high side running the John Helm/WSR Racing No. 12 from 9th to 2nd.

Defending MWRA champion Wyatt Burks drove the family-owned No. 11w to third place also running the high side around the Double X quarter mile while Riley Kreisel, the “Buzzsaw from Warsaw,” won the Hard Charger Award coming from 15th to 6th place, working the cushion from the back of the field.

In separate incidents during the 25-lap feature, Chris Parkinson and Chad Goff crashed on the front stretch. Both drivers were okay but, unfortunately, neither were able to restart. Later in the A feature, a spectacular wreck on the front stretch involving Cody Baker and Luke Howard led to both drivers walking away. Both cars were out of commission for the night.

Earlier in the program, which featured a 32-car field, Tyler Burton, Wagner, Curran and Doney won the four heat races with Cody Baker and Brad Wyatt taking twin B Feature victories.

The MWRA returns to action next Friday and Saturday night, June 4th and 5th, at U.S. 36 Raceway in Osborn, Mo. and at Bethany (Mo.) Speedway, respectively.

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BURKS BESTS USAC MWRA FIELD AT U.S. 36

Osborn, Missouri (June 4, 2021).....Friday night at U.S. 36 Raceway, Topeka Kansas' Wyatt Burks held off a stellar field of non-winged sprint car competitors to win his first USAC Wholesale Batteries Midwest Wingless Racing Association race of 2021.

Burks had previously won at Red Dirt in Meeker in Oklahoma's USAC Sprint Series this year and had finished 3rd place at Double X Speedway in California, Mo. last Sunday night. For the "Sheriff" it was also his 8th career feature win in the series after 7 w's in 2020.

The race Friday night would be hard fought throughout the pack with Battlefield, Missouri, driver Kory Schudy coming home second, for the second time in the three races conducted in MWRA competition in 2021 driving the JSR #28 of Jon Sawyer. While Edgerton, Kansas Chauffeur Mitchell Moore raced from 12th to 3rd, making his first podium for the MWRA in 2021.

After an accident on the front stretch at Double X Sunday, Spring Hill's Chad Goff would rebound nicely driving his red and white #9 to a 4th place finish at US 36, while Nixa's Wesley Smith had a very eventful feature go racing the John Helm/WSR #12 to 5th place.

After earning high point honors following his exciting last turn, last lap heat win, Smith would roll a 3 sending him to the third row for the feature. Wesley from there worked his way up to second and was closing on Burks with two laps remaining when he tried a massive slider going into one. Unfortunately for Smith the effort failed, and he spun the white Helm/Smith effort. With three laps remaining after the restart Wesley would however work his way from the tail end to come home in 5th place.

Other MWRA racers on Friday night at the Osborn dirt track saw Gladstone's Christopher Parkinson, Burks, Topeka's Chris Morgan, and the before mentioned Smith take heat race wins.

While Tom Curran, Zack Clark, Chad Tye, Heath Murry, Tyler Burton, and Mark Lane would all advance to the 22 car A feature from the B. Olathe driver Clark would then move steadily thru the field going from 18th to finish 9th in the A main.

The MWRA will race again tonight at Bethany Speedway just up the road from US 36. And the program will also once again feature the winged 305 URSS Sprint Cars of Rick Salem. Friday night at Osborn, Wathena, Kansas driver Jay Russell would win that feature event.

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SMITH GETS REDEMPTION WITH USAC MWRA AT BETHANY

Bethany, Missouri (June 5, 2021).....After a slide job went south Friday night going for the lead with two laps to go at U.S. 36 Raceway in Osborn, Mo., Nixa, Missouri's Wesley Smith came back strong Saturday night to win at Missouri's Bethany Speedway in the John Helm Racing/WSR Racing #12.

Trailing Smith at the finish was the "X Man" Odessa, Missouri's Xavier Doney, in the Doney/Lawson Racing #74, "Q" Quinton Benson of Sweet Springs, Mo., racing the 15B, Battlefield, Missouri's Kory Schudy, running the JSR Racing #28 of Jon Sawyer, and rounding out the top 5, after a slew of Missouri racers, was Topeka Kansas driver Chris Morgan in the 81A.

Running in positions 6 thru 10, Chris Parkinson finished 6th for the second night in a row. Nebraska driver Terry Richards came home in 7th, Chad Goff 8th, and the "Zach Attack" Zach Clark, and Zach Sanders rounding out the top-10.

Smith rebounded in the Helm #12 to win his first MWRA race in 2021 at Bethany, after winning at the same track last year in MWRA competition (his 4th win overall this season).

Rival Wyatt Burks of Topeka, Kan. wasn't as fortunate. Burks dropped out of the contest on lap six in the 11w, relegating the defending champ to a 22nd place finish.

Benson was flirting with his first win in MWRA competition, and had another great outing, with Doney, the 15-year-old Rookie of the Year candidate, having his highest finish so far racing in USAC MWRA.

Earlier in the evening at the historic facility, which has conducted sprint car racing both non-winged and winged for decades, Spring Hill Kansas' Kyle Lewis won the first heat race, Schudy the second, and Smith the final 8-lap heat race.

USAC MWRA travels back to Northwestern Missouri to race at I-35 Speedway in Winston next Saturday night June 12 for race number five of the 2021 campaign.

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SUPER SCHUDY SAILS TO VICTORY AT I-35

Winston, Missouri (June 12, 2021).....Twenty-six USAC Wholesale Batteries Midwest Wingless Association Sprint Cars invaded I-35 Speedway in Winston, Mo. for a full night of racing Saturday night.

When the dust settled, it was Battlefield, Missouri's Kory Schudy taking the win in the JSR #28 owned by Jon Sawyer, and wrenched by Kris Schudy, who took an impressive win.

Wesley Smith finished second in the John Helm Racing/WSR #12, Zach Clark 3rd, Wyatt Burks in the Rumsey #11w was 4th and Luke Howard rounded out the top-five, finishing 5th.

For Schudy, it was his first MWRA win since 2020 after finishing second twice this season. Kory's big W also represented the fifth different winner during the MWRA season through the first five races,

Action throughout the field on this night led to other impressive results as well. Olathe, Kan. driver Zach Clark in the #26 had a great night with the MWRA, winning his heat by outlasting defending champ Burks for a career best 3rd place run with the MWRA.

Overland Park, Kan. teenager "Cool Hand Luke" Howard also had a career night racing with the MWRA, running in the top-five. The 17-year-old drove for the first time the car number #2H painted with the legendary Dick Howard maroon and gold shield livery, running to his best result so far in the series.

While Kearney, Mo.'s Zach Sanders in the #69 was relegated to the B Feature after making contact with Wyatt Burks at the end of the third heat race. The former modified winner at I-35 then put on the performance of the night, winning the B, and then charging up to 5th place at one point in the A before coming home in 6th place, blowing a tire at the finish line.

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A NIGHT OF FIRSTS FOR DONEY AT SALINA

Salina, Kansas (August 28, 2021).....Xavier Doney, a 15-year old Rookie of the Year candidate from Odessa, Mo., won his first ever Sprint Car Race at Salina Speedway Saturday night over fellow Missouri drivers Jack Wagner of Lone Jack, Mo. and Kory Schudy of Battlefield, Mo. while Jayhawker Chad Goff from Spring Hill Kan. and Show-Me-State chauffer Wesley Smith of Billings, Mo. rounded out the top-five.

Samuel Wagner of Lone Jack, Chris Parkinson from Gladstone, Mo., Luke Howard racing out of Overland Park, Kansas, Spencer Martinez from nearby Wichita, and Michigander Brad Wyatt, now hailing from Kearney, Mo., completed positions six through 10 at this Central Kansas venue.

The youngster from Odessa never cracked and never lost his composure, winning in the Doney/Lawson #74.

Second place Jack Wagner, meanwhile, also had another great night after winning the last time on Kansas soil at Lakeside Speedway on August 6 driving the Jesse Hockett Racing #77. The Lone Jack gunner fought his way from 5th to 2nd before harassing Doney all the way to the finish.

Another great night for point leader Kory Schudy found him finishing on the podium in third place and extended his point lead over Wesley Smith driving the JSR Racing #28 of Jon Sawyer after a steady run.

“The Lawman” Chad Goff, coming off his best result of the season at I-35 last weekend where he finished 2nd, got the Design Source Flooring Hard Charger Award on this night coming from 9th to 4th place in the 25-lapper. Wesley Smith, an early contender, ran 5th in the John Helm Racing/WSR Racing #12.

Winston, Missouri (September 4, 2021).....Saturday night at I-35 Speedway Wesley Smith, driving the John Helm/WSR #12, broke the curse of bad results to win the inaugural Lawson Memorial for USAC Wholesale Batteries Midwest Wingless Racing Association Sprint Cars.

Wyatt Burks took second over Kory Schudy, Luke Howard, Don Droud Jr., Chris Parkinson, Tom Curran, Chad Goff and Brad Wyatt with Chad Frewaldt rounding out the top-10 in the 22-car field.

The change of fortune for the Billings, Missouri chauffeur came after rains blasted the greater Kansas City area, causing cancellations throughout the region on Saturday night.

As a result, it led to a lightning fast and tacky surface at I-35 Speedway which was perfect for Smith who blasted his way to victory using both the high side, and then the low side, to pass the leader Burks for his third Wholesale Batteries USAC MWRA Sprint Car victory of 2021 and a career best "Lucky Number 7" sprint car win in all groups this season after a DNF cost him the points lead at the Winston track last time out.

"The Sheriff" Wyatt Burks from Topeka, Kansas, had a great night of racing as well, driving the Wyatt Burks Racing #11w, finishing second place, after taking the lead at the start of the 25-lapper until being passed by Smith.

Point Leader Kory Schudy of Battlefield, Mo., racing the JSR #28 of Jon Sawyer, continued to impress with yet another finish on the podium in MWRA after winning the first two races at I-35 Speedway in 2021.
