

2021 USAC WINGLESS SPRINTS OKLAHOMA SEASON

WILSON JETS TO THIRD CAREER USAC WSO TITLE IN 2021

Brett Wilson became the first USAC Wingless Sprints Oklahoma champion in 2018. He followed that performance up by becoming the second ever series champion in 2019. In 2021, the Coweta, Okla. native became the first driver to be named a three-time titlist with the series.

The all-time winningest series driver added two more wins to his tally in 2021, sweeping both races held at Oklahoma Sports Park in Ada in the opener on May 8 and in the penultimate round on July 31, upping his victory total with the series to 11.

Wyatt Burks (Topeka, Kan.) scores his second career WSO triumph on May 14. Three events were co-sanctioned by the USAC Wholesale Batteries Midwest Wingless Racing Association, which produced three first-time winners.

Wesley Smith (Billings, Mo.) snagged the victory at 81 Speedway in Park City, Kan. Tim Kent (Bristow, Okla.) did, likewise, at the Kansas State Fairgrounds in Hutchinson. Xavier Doney (Odessa, Mo.) raced to victory lane in the season finale at Salina Speedway in Kan.

Wilson's final margin of victory in the series' point standings (190) was the largest point differential in the four-year history of the series, breaking his own mark of 118 points set in 2019.

SMITH WINS BORDER WAR SHOWDOWN AT 81

Park City, Kansas (June 26, 2021).....From the agony of defeat just one week ago to the thrill of victory Saturday night at 81 Speedway, Billings, Missouri's Wesley Smith was back to where he has been most of the 2021 season, celebrating a victory in the 2nd annual Border Showdown featuring the USAC Wholesale Batteries Midwest Wingless Racing Association vs. USAC Wingless Sprints Oklahoma.

Smith bested Overland Park, Kansas driver Luke Howard, Odessa, Missouri's Xavier Doney, Coweta, Oklahoma's Brett Wilson, and Battlefield, Missouri racer Kory Schudy.

For Smith, driving the John Helm/WSR Racing #12, this was sweet redemption after losing the lead following a green, white, checker finish at Central Missouri Speedway last Saturday in a race he dominated for 24 of the 25 laps.

Saturday night at South Central Kansas's premier dirt track, Smith was the hunter, chasing teenage gunner Howard, who was having a great run driving the Howard Racing No. 2H wrenched by three-time WAR champ Rick Smith. Smith caught the ever-improving Howard with 10 laps to go after a slight bobble by the Jayhawker on the cushion.

From there, the racing continued to be heart-stopping as Howard chased leader Smith thru lapped traffic along with contenders Doney, Wilson, and the winner of the last two MWRA main events, Schudy, in a race that went 25 laps without a yellow flag.

As the leaders came around for double checkered flags, Smith lost power just before the finish line but was able to withstand the onslaught of "Cool Hand Luke," and the "X-Man" Doney to win his second Midwest Wingless Sprint feature of 2021, and his fifth overall this season.

Earlier in the evening, on a beautiful night for racing in the Sunflower State, Wesley Smith won his heat race as did WSO point leader and two-time champ Brett Wilson, and Gladstone, Missouri's Chris Parkinson.

After a weekend off, USAC MWRA will head to Iowa to race on July 10 in the 3rd annual Corn Belt Clash at the famed half-mile oval of Knoxville Raceway, in a non-points special event

KENT CORRALS 65TH HUTCHINSON GRAND NATIONALS

Hutchinson, Kansas (July 16, 2021).....Tim Kent of Bristow, Oklahoma took advantage of race-long leader Riley Kreisel's mechanical misfortune to win Friday night's 65th annual Hutchinson Grand Nationals 20-lap feature at the Kansas State Fairgrounds.

The event was sanctioned by both USAC Wingless Sprints Oklahoma and the USAC Wholesale Batteries Midwest Wingless Racing Association.

Kreisel led early before retiring with just four laps remaining, allowing Kent to race into the lead and score the victory on the half-mile dirt oval.

Koby Barksdale was leading the first heat race when, on the final lap, he tagged the turn three wall and flipped. He was checked out at the hospital and later cleared with a little racing rheumatism.

The event was a full points race for USAC WSO and a non-points special event for USAC MWRA.

A NIGHT OF FIRSTS FOR DONEY AT SALINA

Salina, Kansas (August 28, 2021).....Xavier Doney, a 15-year old Rookie of the Year candidate from Odessa, Mo., won his first ever Sprint Car Race at Salina Speedway Saturday night over fellow Missouri drivers Jack Wagner of Lone Jack, Mo. and Kory Schudy of Battlefield, Mo. while Jayhawker Chad Goff from Spring Hill Kan. and Show-Me-State chauffer Wesley Smith of Billings, Mo. rounded out the top-five.

Samuel Wagner of Lone Jack, Chris Parkinson from Gladstone, Mo., Luke Howard racing out of Overland Park, Kansas, Spencer Martinez from nearby Wichita, and Michigander Brad Wyatt, now hailing from Kearney, Mo., completed positions six through 10 at this Central Kansas venue.

For Doney, who came up thru the micro ranks, his win was not only his first ever in sprint cars running in his first full season of competition. It also represented his first win with USAC's Wholesale Batteries Midwest Wingless Racing Association and the Wingless Sprints Oklahoma, who co-sanctioned the event for non-winged sprints for the first time in 40 years at Salina Speedway.

In an epic feature which saw the X-Man (Doney) hold off charges from Wesley Smith, who bounced into the air running on a technical track, trying to wrestle the lead away from Doney, as well as later "Jack of all Trades" Jack Wagner trying a similar maneuver between corners one and two. The youngster from Odessa never cracked and never lost his composure, winning in the Doney/Lawson #74.

Second place Jack Wagner, meanwhile, also had another great night after winning the last time on Kansas soil at Lakeside Speedway on August 6 driving the Jesse Hockett Racing #77. The Lone Jack gunner fought his way from 5th to 2nd before harassing Doney all the way to the finish.

Another great night for point leader Kory Schudy found him finishing on the podium in third place and extended his point lead over Wesley Smith driving the JSR Racing #28 of Jon Sawyer after a steady run.

"The Lawman" Chad Goff, coming off his best result of the season at I-35 last weekend where he finished 2nd, got the Design Source Flooring Hard Charger Award on this night coming from 9th to 4th place in the 25-lapper. Wesley Smith, an early contender, ran 5th in the John Helm Racing/WSR Racing #12.

Before the main event, Smith, Doney, and Jack Wagner took heat race wins.

Next weekend, Saturday September 4th and Sunday September 5th, the USAC Midwest Wingless Racing Association continues the road to the 2021 championship with the Lawson Memorial on the 4th at I-35 Speedway in Winston, Mo. and at Bethany (Mo.) Speedway on the 5th. Only 3 races remain this season.
