TELLSTROM TELLS 'EM: HE'S USAC'S RADICAL FOCUS MIDGET CHAMP

Kyle Tellstrom has excelled as a champion in west coast modified racing and, this year, he's now risen to the top in the open wheel discipline as the king of USAC Radical Focus Midget racing for 2022.

In six feature starts during his championship season, the Boise, Idaho native won twice in back-to-back fashion in his home state at Meridian Speedway during September's Chaz Groat Memorial at Idaho's Meridian Speedway.

Along the way, Tellstrom collected five top-fives and six top-tens on the journey to a first career USAC title, defeating his competition by a healthy 75-point margin.

River Merrill (Salt Lake City, Utah) finished as the runner-up in the final point tally with 2022 USAC Eastern Focus Midget champ Hunter Wise (Allentown, Pa.) third, Cheyenne Merrill (Salt Lake City, Utah) fourth and Chris Lamb (Colfax, N.C.) fifth.

Lamb added two victories to his Radical total this season with a complete sweep during the final weekend of the trail at Arizona's Havasu 95 Speedway in November. By season's end, Lamb upped his total to 65 career USAC Focus Midget victories across all platforms, most all-time.

Brady Allum (Gold Hill, N.C.) and Dakoda Armstrong (New Castle, Ind.) became first-time Radical feature victors when the series ventured east at the end of July for two shows at Indiana's Anderson Speedway. Allum scored a breakthrough triumph by reigning victorious as did Armstrong who led all series drivers with 79 laps led.

For Armstrong, a frequent competitor in NASCAR's Xfinity and Camping World Truck Series as well as a 2004 USAC Kenyon Midget titlist, it was his first USAC-sanctioned feature win in 14 years, with the last one also occurring at Anderson in 2008 when he topped the field to win a 400-lap midget main event.

ARMSTRONG IS TOPS AT ANDERSON

Anderson, Indiana (July 29, 2022).......Dakoda Armstrong returned to his roots to capture Friday night's USAC Eastern & USAC Radical SpeeD2 Midget co-sanctioned feature at Indiana's Anderson Speedway.

New Castle, Indiana's Armstrong, a 2004 USAC Kenyon Midget champion and a past pole winner in NASCAR's Xfinity Series, took over the lead from Brady Allum three laps into the 50-lapper, leading the final 48 laps en route to victory in the Radical Racing No. 5.

Armstrong was followed to the stripe by Eastern series point leader Hunter Wise (Allentown, Pa.), Logan Sulyi (Raleigh, N.C.) and Toby Alfrey (Miamisburg, Ohio) while Dillon Thomas (Clover, S.C.) rounded out the top-five.

TELLSTROM TAKES RADICAL/EASTERN NIGHT ONE AT MERIDIAN

Meridian, Idaho (September 23, 2022)......Idaho's own Kyle Tellstrom protected the home asphalt on Friday night when the Boise native took over the lead on lap three and raced to victory in the USAC Radical and USAC Eastern SpeeD2 Midget co-sanctioned event at Meridian Speedway.

Driving the Mike Creevan-owned machine, Tellstrom led the final 28 laps of the opening night of the Chaz Groat Memorial for his second career USAC Radical victory after winning the series' inaugural race in July of 2020.

In the process, Tellstrom took over the Radical series point lead.

A.J. Luttmer (Salt Lake City, Utah) led the opening two laps of the feature and ultimately finished third. Ashlyn Powell (Salt Lake City, Utah) took second while Devin Westover (Saratoga Springs, Utah) scored fourth and Anthony Quintana (Riverton, Utah) rounded out the top-five.

Fast qualifier Casey Tillman (Kuna, Idaho) originally finished second but was disqualified after his car was found to be too wide in post-race technical inspection.

LAMB CHOPS 'EM UP IN RADICAL MIDGET GO AT HAVASU 95

Lake Havasu, Arizona (November 11, 2022).......Chris Lamb was the class of the field on Friday night at Arizona's Havasu 95 Speedway.

The Colfax, N.C. native went coast-to-coast to pick up the win after taking over the lead from Dakoda Armstrong on lap 32 of the 50-lapper featuring the penultimate points race of the season for the USAC Radical SpeeD2 Midgets.

Friday's race was also a non-points special event for the USAC Eastern SpeeD2 Midgets.

Lamb led the final 19 laps to earn his 68th overall USAC sanctioned feature victory, which ranks 17th all-time in terms of wins across the board in all activity within the United States Auto Club since its inception in 1956.

Fast qualifier Kyle Tellstrom (Boise, Idaho) finished a distant second to Lamb while also increasing his Radical point lead to 60 entering Saturday's finale at Havasu 95.

Dakoda Armstrong (New Castle, Ind.) scored a third place result and recorded the quickest lap in series history at the track on lap six of the main event when he turned a 14.270 second lap.

USAC Eastern champion Hunter Wise (Allentown, Pa.) finished fourth with A.J. Luttmer (Salt Lake City, Utah) rounding out the top-10.

On Saturday night, the Colfax, N.C. native repeated his victory from the night before to capture his second consecutive win in as many nights during the season finale for the USAC Radical SpeeD2 Midgets.
