CARTER DARTS TO 2022 USAC WEST COAST SPRINT CAR TITLE

When the final checkered flag waved at Kern County on October 15th, Trent Carter became the new USAC West Coast Sprint Car Champion for 2022.

In doing so, the pilot of the family owned #13 Porterville Lock & Safe Maxim became the second past USAC West Coast Sprint Car Rookie of the Year to later win the title along with Austin Liggett.

Consistency and avoiding trouble proved to be the key for Torrance, California's Carter, a three-time Santa Maria Raceway track champion. After finishing second at the February 26th season opener, Carter posted seven top-5 finishes, two heat race victories, and six feature laps led. In doing so, Carter became the second consecutive winless West Coast champ, following D.J. Johnson in 2021.

Carter, the 2014 Co-Rookie of the Year faced challenges from Troy Rutherford and Kyle Edwards for the championship at the last point race. Troy Rutherford (Ojai, Calif.) was 41 points behind Carter and the owner/driver of the #11 Ford powered Trench Shoring Spike gave a valiant effort by setting fast time and finishing second in the main event. On the strength of one feature win, four fast time awards, three heat race wins, six top-10 finishes, and 36 feature laps led, the former VRA Champion ran second in points despite missing one race.

Kyle Edwards (Fountain Valley, Calif.) was 15 points behind Carter, but a mishap in qualifying nearly ended his night. The family owned #39 Safehouse Security Triple X suffered damage and the crew made repairs. Edwards gave a strong effort but had to retire early from the feature. With one fast time award, four heat race victories, six top-10 finishes, and five feature laps led, the third generation driver settled for third in the standings.

Three drivers had their sights on top Rookie honors at the final point race. Joey Bishop (Camarillo, Calif.) had a one-point lead over Tyler Hatzikian (Murrieta, Calif.) while Brent Yarnal (Phoenix, Ariz.) was also within striking distance. Hatzikian had tied Bishop after qualifying, but Joey gained more points after the heat races.

It all came down to the 30-lap main event where Hatzikian finished eighth, Bishop placed tenth, and Yarnal scored sixteenth. By a slim four point margin, Tyler Hatzikian earned Rookie of the Year honors aboard his #27 Tyler Surfboards Triple X that was a tribute to the famed Bubby Jones / Gas Chem Products car. Tyler finished fifth in the standings with one hard charger award and six top-10 finishes to his credit.

Brody Fuson (Bakersfield, Calif.) and Chase Johnson (Penngrove, Calif.) led all drivers with two victories apiece. Fuson scored a pair of late season wins at Bakersfield Speedway and at The Dirt Track at Kern County Raceway Park). Johnson, meanwhile, took top honors in February at Kern County Raceway Park and again in September at Ventura Raceway. Johnson also led all drivers in terms of feature laps led for the second consecutive season with 51.

Past series champion Brody Roa (Garden Grove, Calif.) returned to USAC West Coast victory lane for the fourth consecutive season while three pilots earned their first career series victories: Fuson, plus Oxnard, California's Ricky Lewis in March at Bakersfield; Ferndale, California's Daniel Whitley in June at Ventura.

With the championship already decided, a non-points special event was held for the series during the 81st running of the ARP Turkey Night Grand Prix at Ventura during late November. Ryan Timms (Oklahoma City, Okla.) topped the field of 49 to earn the big victory.

CHASE JOHNSON IS BACK ON TOP AT KERN COUNTY

BAKERSFIELD, CA – FEBRUARY 26, 2022... Taking control from Brody Fuson on the fourth circuit, Chase Johnson (Penngrove, CA) led the rest of the way to claim the \$1,500 season opening victory at The Dirt Track at Kern County Raceway Park. Piloting the May Motorsports' #8M Fastenal / Coopers Propane entry, Johnson's sixth career USAC West Coast Sprint Car win came ahead of Trent Carter, Ricky Lewis, fast qualifier Kyle Edwards, and Fuson.

Looking for his first win, pole sitter Fuson shook free from Lewis to lead the opening laps but could not fend off Johnson. Starting fifth, Johnson soon took command as the young driver held strong. A bobble cost Brody several positions as Carter settled into the runner-up spot. Chase had separated himself from the field, but Trent closed the gap. A few caution flags halted the action, including a lap nine flip by Jacob Tuttle. Tuttle walked away but had been reported to be a little sore.

Back out front, Johnson looked to regain his advantage with Carter in tow. The laps counted down at a torrid pace and the leaders were left with a green-white-checkered finish. Chase got a great restart and streaked to the checkered flags. Third running Lewis surged off the last corner and almost took second from Carter at the finish line.

After earning the 30-lap triumph, Johnson left Kern County as the new point leader after qualifying second overall and running second in his heat race to Ricky Lewis.

Kyle Edwards (Fountain Valley, CA) got things started early by shattering the track record with a time of 14.394 over the 19-car roster. Former track record holder Chase Johnson and Ryan Timmons had also qualified under the old standard. Driving the family owned #39 Safehouse Security / Van Dyne Engineering Triple X, Edwards earned the first Woodland Auto Display Fast Time Award of his career. Later, Kyle ran second to Cody Majors in his heat race and powered to fourth in the main event after starting sixth. Kyle heads to Bakersfield tied for second in the point chase with Ricky Lewis.

Cody Majors (Simi Valley, CA) returned to USAC West Coast action and won the night's 10-lap Extreme Mufflers Heat Race #1. Racing the family owned #54 Next Auto Body Spike, Majors was thirteenth quick in time trials and scored nineteenth in the feature after an early exit. Looking for sponsors, Cody left KCRP tied with Jacob Tuttle, Matt Day, and Camie Bell for sixteenth in the point standings.

Ricky Lewis (Oxnard, CA) claimed victory in the night's 10-lap Competition Suspension Incorporated Heat Race #2. Piloting his #41 Physical Medical Consultant / Stensland Racing DRC, Lewis qualified fifth overall and scored third in the main event. Splitting his racing between California and Indiana, Ricky is currently tied for second with Kyle Edwards in the chase for the championship.

Brody Fuson (Bakersfield, CA) took the checkered flags in the 10-lap Rod End Supply Heat Race #3. Driving Bob and Toni Van Meter's #51 W.E. / Taylor Backhoe Spike, Fuson was sixth fast in qualifying and placed fifth in the feature after leading the first three laps. As this writing goes to press, Brody sits fifth in the USAC West Coast Sprint Car point chase.

Travis Buckley (Auckland, NZ) earned Kern County's BR Motorsports Hard Charger Award with an eighth place run from eighteenth. Piloting the Kruseman Motorsports owned #7K Lucas Oil / Cory Kruseman Sprint Car and Midget Driving School machine, Buckley qualified eighteenth overall and finished second to Brody Fuson in his heat race. Sitting eighth in championship standings, Travis leads the Passing Master points heading to Bakersfield Speedway on March 12th.

By virtue of his thirteenth place finish, James Herrera (New Cuyama, CA) claimed the night's Wilwood Disc Brakes Lucky 13 Award. Piloting his #5J Cuyama Buckhorn / The Buck Stop Coffee Shop Maxim, Herrera was tenth fast in qualifying and took sixth in his heat race. At press time, James is ranked thirteenth in West Coast point standings.

The second point race for the USAC West Coast 360 Sprint Cars will be held on Saturday, March 12th at Bakersfield Speedway (Bakersfield, CA). The West's Fastest 1/3-Mile High Banked Clay Oval will also host Stock Cars, Mod Lites, and Mini Stocks.

RICKY LEWIS SPRINTS TO FIRST VICTORY AT BAKERSFIELD

BAKERSFIELD, CA – MARCH 12, 2022... Starting sixth, Ricky Lewis (Oxnard, CA) dodged several early tangles and led all 30 laps to score the \$1,500 victory at Bakersfield Speedway. Piloting his #41 Physical Medical Consultant / Stensland Racing DRC, Lewis shook free from challengers Jacob Tuttle and Troy Rutherford to claim the first USAC West Coast 360 Sprint Car win of his career. Tuttle, Brody Fuson, Rutherford, and Hannah Mayhew rounded out the top-five drivers.

Before becoming the 56th winning driver in series history, Lewis also earned his first Woodland Auto Display Fast Time Award. Ricky's time of 13.006 bested the 20-car roster and the young driver finished third in his heat race. Ricky left Bakersfield as the new point leader heading to Ventura Raceway on May 21st.

Troy Rutherford (Ojai, CA) made his first start of the season and raced to victory in the Extreme Mufflers Heat Race #1. Driving his #11 Trench Shoring / Grimes Rock Spike, Rutherford qualified thirteenth overall and charged from eighth to place fourth in the main event. The former Ventura track champion is now ranked seventeenth in the point chase.

Trent Carter (Terra Bella, CA) topped the 10-lap Competition Suspension Incorporated Heat Race #2. Racing the family owned #13 Porterville Lock & Safe / Porterville Collision Center Maxim, Carter was eleventh quick in Woodland Auto Display time trials. The multi-time Santa Maria champion was running in the top-five in the feature, before escaping from a fire that relegated him to a twelfth place finish. Trent left Bakersfield sitting fourth in the point standings.

New Kern County record holder, Kyle Edwards (Fountain Valley, CA) won the night's Wilwood Disc Brakes Heat Race #3. Driving the family owned #39 Safehouse Security / Van Dyne Engineering Triple X, Edwards was fifteenth fast in time trials and finished seventeenth in the main event after an early exit. The second generation driver ranks seventh in championship points.

Rookie contender Tyler Hatzikian (El Segundo, CA) earned Bakersfield's BR Motorsports Hard Charger Award with a ninth place run from twentieth. Piloting his #27 Original Roadhouse Bar & Grill / ZARP Incorporated Triple X, Hatzikian had early mechanical issues that resulted in qualifying twentieth and finishing seventh in his heat race. Tyler heads to Ventura ranked eleventh in West Coast standings.

Making the first West Coast start, Ben Worth (Coalinga, CA) claimed the night's Rod End Supply Lucky 13 Award. Driving the Josh Ford Motorsports' #73 Sun Valley Ag Transport / Raney Racing Engines Triple X, Worth qualified eighth overall and finished thirteenth in the feature after an early exit. At press time, the 2019 USAC Western States Midget Rookie of the Year is twenty-first in the point chase.

The third point race for the USAC West Coast 360 Sprint Cars will be held on Saturday, May 21st, at Ventura Raceway (Ventura, CA). Located on the Ventura County Fairgrounds, The Best Little Dirt Track in America will also host the USAC Western States Midgets, IMCA Modifieds, California Lightning Sprints, Hobby Stocks, and Kids Classes.

TROY RUTHERFORD TOPS VENTURA FEATURE

VENTURA, CALIFORNIA – MAY 24, 2022... Starting sixth, Troy Rutherford (Ojai, California) took command from Travis Buckley on the second lap and sailed to last Saturday's 25-lap USAC West Coast Sprint Car triumph at Ventura Raceway. Point leader Ricky Lewis, Trent Carter, Kyle Edwards, and Randy Nelson rounded out the top-five drivers.

Piloting his #11 Trench Shoring / Shine Supply entry, Rutherford quickly sliced his way to the front and set a torrid pace on the Ventura clay oval. Despite several caution flags, Rutherford was in control and maintained the top spot. As the laps counted down, the mandated curfew was approaching, and track and series officials were forced to shorten the main event. A lap 23 flip by Hannah Mayhew had erased Troy's advantage and gave challengers Ricky Lewis and Trent Carter one last shot to steal the win. It was not to be as the night belonged to Rutherford.

For Rutherford, the \$1,500 triumph was his first win of the campaign and eighth of his career. The veteran driver now moves into a tie with 2019 champion Tristan Guardino, Peter Murphy, and Jace Vander Weerd for seventh on the series win list. Earlier in the night, Troy earned his first Woodland Auto Display Fast Time Award of the year by posting a time of

13.974 seconds over the 17-car roster and ran second to Buckley in his heat race. Troy heads to the June 4th Ventura return ranked seventh in the point standings.

Travis Buckley (Auckland, New Zealand) raced to victory in the 10-lap Extreme Mufflers Heat Race #1. Driving the Kruseman Motorsports' #21K Lucas Oil / Kruseman Sprint Car and Midget Driving School entry, Buckley was fifth quick in time trials and finished fifteenth in the main event. After finishing sixth in the companion USAC Western States Midget main event, Travis is tied for fifth in the championship point chase.

Kyle Edwards (Fountain Valley, California) won the night's 10-lap Competition Suspension Incorporated / Vahlco Wheels Heat Race #2. Racing the family owned #39 Safehouse Security / Van Dyne Engineering entry, Edwards qualified tenth overall and charged to fourth in the feature from seventh. Kyle left the Ventura County Fairgrounds ranked third in the chase for the championship.

Making his first start of the season, veteran driver Rick Hendrix (Palmdale, California) earned the night's Rod End Supply Hard Charger Award with an eleventh place run from seventeenth. Driving his #15 Rick's Gate Works / Wilwood Disc Brakes Maxim, Hendrix was seventeenth in QUALIFYING and ran seventh in his heat race. The former USAC Western Sprint Car, Western States Midget, and TQ Midget Champion is now twenty-third in points.

By virtue of her thirteenth place finish, Camie Bell (Bakersfield, California) claimed the night's Wilwood Disc Brakes Lucky 13 Award. Racing the family owned #29C American Fabrication / Hydraulic Controls TCR, Bell qualified fifteenth overall and finished ninth in her heat race. The rookie contender is currently thirteenth in the point standings.

Before action began at The Best Little Dirt Track in America, Alexa Herrera (New Cuyama, California) won the Lucky Pill Draw Award presented by High Tech Performance and received five free gallons of fuel. Making her first career start in the family owned #16J Cuyama Buckhorn / The Buck Stop Coffee Shop Stinger, Herrera was fourteenth fast in time trials, ran eighth in her heat race, and scored fourteenth in the main event. Alexa is now twenty-fifth in the point chase.

DANIEL WHITLEY WINS WILD MAIN EVENT AT VENTURA

VENTURA, CALIFORNIA – JUNE 7, 2022... After six official lead changes plus several more, Daniel Whitley (Ferndale, California) emerged victorious last Saturday night at Ventura Raceway. Piloting Ted Finkenbinder's famed #3F Western Industrial X-Ray DRC, Whitley fought off challengers Steve Hix and Troy Rutherford to win the first USAC West Coast Sprint Car main event of his career. Fast qualifier Rutherford, Hix, new point leader Trent Carter, and Kyle Edwards chased Whitley to the checkered flags.

Polesitter Rick Hendrix led the opening two laps before problems knocked the multi-time USAC Champion out of contention. Hix took command was running strong as he looked for his first win with the series. Starting third, Whitley took the lead on the thirteenth circuit, but Hix regained the top spot on the following lap. The pair swapped the lead a few more times as Rutherford raced into striking distance. Whitley sped away from the field and claimed the \$1,500 victory at his first appearance at the Ventura County Fairgrounds.

Before becoming the 57th winning driver in USAC West Coast Sprint Car history, Daniel Whitley qualified fourth overall and won the 10-lap Extreme Mufflers First Heat Race.

Troy Rutherford (Ojai, California) opened the night by winning the Lucky Pill Draw presented by High Tech Performance and five free gallons of fuel. The former Ventura track champion then set a new track record of 11.941 seconds, breaking the 2019 standard by Tristan Guardino. Racing his #11 Trench Shoring / Westco International Spike with Ford power, Rutherford earned his sixth career Woodland Auto Display Fast Time Award over the eighteen car roster. After finishing second to Whitley in both his heat race and the main event, the veteran driver left his home track ranked fourth in the point standings.

Making his first start of the year, Charlie Butcher (Santa Barbara, California) raced to victory in the 10-lap Competition Suspension Incorporated / Vahlco Wheels Heat Race #2. Driving his #96 Ogio / Weld Wheels Triple X, Butcher was eleventh quick in time trials and finished eighteenth in the main event after an early exit. VENTURA, CALIFORNIA – AUGUST 29, 2022... After taking command from point leader Trent Carter on lap seven, The Pride of Garden Grove Brody Roa (Garden Grove, California) held off all challengers and earned last Saturday's win at Ventura Raceway. Racing the May Motorsports' #8M RDM Mechanics / Fastenal entry, Roa scored his first \$1,500 USAC West Coast Sprint Car victory of the campaign. BRODY FUSON BREAKS THROUGH AT BAKERSFIELD

BAKERSFIELD, CALIFORNIA – SEPTEMBER 14, 2022... With a full moon overhead last Saturday night, Brody Fuson (Bakersfield, California) was victorious in front of his hometown fans at Bakersfield Speedway. Starting fifth, the USAC Western States Midget standout took command from Troy Rutherford on lap fourteen and had the race well in hand. Brody shook free from all challengers after a late green-white-checkered restart to capture the first \$1,500 USAC West Coast Sprint Car victory of his career. Rutherford, fast qualifier Jake Andreotti, point leader Trent Carter, and Dawson Faria rounded out the top-five drivers.

Starting on the pole position, Kyle Edwards grabbed the early lead only to see Troy Rutherford slip by for the top spot. Rutherford set a torrid pace on the Bakersfield clay and was steadily making his way through slower traffic. Fuson took advantage of the traffic and took command on lap fourteen. A caution came out two laps later that restacked the field and, on the restart, Brody began to run away from the challengers.

Running the top groove, Fuson had extended his advantage to nearly a straightaway after four laps. A fierce battle for position followed the young driver as Carter and Andreotti had shuffled Rutherford back to fourth. The late caution for an Edwards spin bunched the field and allowed for one last shot for position. Once racing resumed, Andreotti dropped Carter to third, but a surging Rutherford powered by both drivers off the last corners to snag the runner-up spot behind Fuson.

Racing Bob and Toni Van Meter's #51 W.E. / RacePa Motorsports Spike, Brody Fuson became the 60th different winner with the series and sixth driver to claim victory in 2022. After qualifying second overall, placing fourth in his heat race, and earning the BR Motorsports / Rod End Supply Hard Charger Award, Fuson has climbed to thirteenth in the point chase. The young driver tied his grandfather, "The Bakersfield Bullet" Rusty Carlile on the series win list as Carlile topped Hanford's Cotton Classic on October 3, 2009.

After rain hit the speedway and continued to shower the surrounding area, Jake Andreotti (Castro Valley, California) opened the program by earning his first career Woodland Auto Display Fast Time Award. Making his first non-winged and USAC West Coast Sprint Car start, the pilot of the family owned #7P Buchanan Auto Electric / Lucas Oil KPC posted a time of 13.806 seconds over the 16-car roster. The USAC Western States Midget regular placed sixth in his heat race, claimed third in the main event, and left Bakersfield ranked twenty-seventh in points.

Troy Rutherford (Ojai, California) raced to victory in the 10-lap Extreme Mufflers First Heat Race. Driving his #11 Westco International Consulting / Shine Supply Spike with Ford power, Rutherford was fifth quick in time trials and finished second in the feature after leading the first thirteenth circuits. The former VRA Sprint Car Champion heads to his home track ranked second in points, just 19 markers behind Trent Carter.

CHASE JOHNSON POWERS TO VENTURA VICTORY

VENTURA, CALIFORNIA – SEPTEMBER 28, 2022... Starting fifth, Chase Johnson (Penngrove, California) grabbed the lead from Kyle Edwards on the seventh lap and powered to last Saturday's win at Ventura Raceway. Racing Keith Ford's #73 Naturipe / SureCan LLC Triple X, Johnson scored his second \$1,500 USAC West Coast Sprint Car victory of the season. Edwards, Tanner Boul, Steve Hix, and point leader Trent Carter rounded out the top-five drivers.

At the drop of starter Kris Kornder's green flag, Ventura USAC/CRA winner Tanner Boul took the top spot from the pole position. Looking for his first USAC West Coast 360 win, Boul's hopes were dashed as Edwards slipped by on the second circuit. Edwards set a torrid pace and soon faced the challenges from former track champion Troy Rutherford. Contact between the two knocked Rutherford out of contention, but Edwards would soon have to battle with Johnson. Chase proved to be too strong on this night and lapped the seventh running Hannah Mayhew before taking the checkered flag.

Before earning the seventh win of his career, Chase Johnson qualified second overall and finished second in his heat race to Rick Hendrix. After limited starts, Chase left the Ventura County Fairgrounds ranked thirteenth in the point chase.

Troy Rutherford (Ojai, California) opened the night by winning the Lucky Pill Draw presented by High Tech Performance and five free gallons of fuel. The veteran driver then posted his third Woodland Auto Display Fast Time Award of the campaign with a time of 12.461 seconds over the 19-car roster. Driving his #11 Westco International Consulting / Shine Supply Spike with Ford power, Rutherford won the 10-lap Extreme Mufflers First Heat Race and scored seventeenth in the feature after an early exit. Heading to the October 15th Championship Night, Troy sits third in points with a shot at the championship.

Veteran Rick Hendrix (Palmdale, California) raced to victory in the 10-lap Competition Suspension Incorporated / Vahlco Wheels Second Heat Race. Piloting his #15 Rick's Gate Works / Wilwood Disc Brakes Maxim, the multi-time USAC Champion was eleventh quick in time trials and scored sixth in the main event. Racing the May Motorsports' #8M RDM Mechanics / Keen Concrete Eagle, Roa qualified third overall and scratched before the main event with engine issues. After a couple of starts, the 2016 Champion heads to The Dirt Track at Kern County Raceway Park ranked twenty-second in points.

Gage Rucker (Truxton, Missouri) returned to USAC West Coast action and earned the night's BR Motorsports / Rod End Supply Hard Charger Award with a tenth place run from nineteenth. Driving the Kruseman Motorsports' #21K Kruseman Sprint Car and Midget Driving School / Lucas Oil machine, Rucker was nineteenth in QUALIFYING after mechanical issues and ran sixth in his heat race. For his efforts, Gage also earned a copy of Caged Heat, a sprint car racing photo book, courtesy of Steve Lafond. After his first start of 2022, Rucker is ranked thirty-fifth in championship points.

By virtue of his thirteenth place finish, James Herrera (New Cuyama, California) claimed his second Wilwood Disc Brakes Lucky 13 Award of the season. Racing his #5E Cuyama Buckhorn / The Buck Stop Coffee Stop Maxim, Herrera qualified fourteenth overall and placed sixth in his heat race. The 2015 Santa Maria Champion heads to the upcoming Championship Night sitting twelfth in the chase for the championship.

The USAC West Coast 360 Sprint Cars will take a break before returning to action on Saturday, October 15th, at The Dirt Track at Kern County Raceway Park's (Bakersfield, California) Championship Night and George Snider Classic. The final point race will also feature the USAC Western States and Bay Cities Racing Association (BCRA) Midgets.

BAKERSFIELD, CALIFORNIA – OCTOBER 17, 2022... Starting third, Brody Fuson (Bakersfield, California) took command from Sterling Cling on the fourteenth lap and raced to last Saturday's George Snider Classic victory at The Dirt Track at Kern County Raceway Park. Piloting Bob and Toni Van Meter's #51 W.E. / Taylor Backhoe Spike, Fuson claimed his second \$1,500 USAC West Coast Sprint Car victory of the season. Fast qualifier Troy Rutherford, Cling, Jake Andreotti, and Trent Carter, the 2022 Champion followed Brody to the checkered flag. Former champion Brody Roa had crossed the finish line in fourth but failed to go to post race scales.

At the drop of starter Jason Vance's green flag, Sterling Cling bested Trent Carter to grab the early lead. Making his first start at the Kern County oval, Cling began to inch away from the field. Brody Fuson found the outside line to his liking and caught the leader within a couple of laps. Brody competed the pass for the lead on the fourth circuit, but a bobble in the second corner cost the top spot. Once he regained the lead, Cling looked to increase his advantage, but Fuson stayed within striking distance. The lead duo caught slower traffic and Fuson made the most of the opportunity. Brody retook the lead on lap 14 and was not to be denied at the fast 1/3-mile oval.

Before earning the second win of his career, Brody Fuson qualified fourth overall and finished third in his heat race. Running double duty, the young driver ran third in the companion USAC Western States debut at Kern County. In limited starts, Fuson finished his season ranked twelfth in the West Coast point chase.

Troy Rutherford (Ojai, California) opened the night by posting his fourth Woodland Auto Display Fast Time Award of the campaign with a time of 15.297 seconds over the 19-car roster. Driving his #11 Westco International Consulting / Shine Supply Spike with Ford power, the veteran driver earned Top Qualifier honors, claimed second in his heat race, and ran second to Fuson in the main event. Troy finished his season ranked second in championship points.

Trent Carter (Terra Bella, California) raced to victory in the night's 10-lap Extreme Mufflers First Heat Race. Driving the family owned #13 Porterville Lock & Safe / Porterville Collision Center Maxim, Carter was seventh fast in time trials and scored fifth in the main event. After taking the Championship Night checkered flag, Trent clinched the 2022 USAC West Coast Sprint Car Championship.
