Nelson Cruises! 2025 USAC Midwest Thunder Speed2 Midget Review

Originally, Tyler Nelson assumed his hopes and dreams for a USAC Midwest Thunder Speed2 Midget championship in 2025 were over.

While holding onto a 14-point lead in the series standings, Nelson had a pre-planned family vacation that was going to force him to miss the final three races of the season.

However, Mother Nature quickly came to Nelson's rescue. First, the penultimate event in late September at Ohio's Moler Raceway Park was rained out. From the high seas, Nelson quickly devised a plan to have his car ready for the double feature finale at Indiana's Montpelier Speedway on the first weekend of October.

At 7:30am on the morning of the season finale, Nelson had stepped off the cruise ship at Cape Canaveral in Florida. After the flight back home and a drive north to Montpelier, by 10pm later that same night, Nelson was the series champion.

With sixth and third place finishes on each end of the Montpelier double, Nelson secured the series title by a 50-point margin over Matt Lux. With it, Nelson, who originally hails from Olathe, Kansas but now resides in Indianapolis, Indiana, became the first series champion not from the state of Ohio!

The 28-year-old won once on the season, charging eighth to first and leading the final six laps to earn his first career series victory in June at Millstream Speedway aboard the Curtis Motor Sales – The Auto Spot Lynch Machining LynK chassis powered by a 4 Piston Racing Honda engine.

With crew chief Mike Hurst at the helm, Nelson was the lone driver to finish inside the top-10 in all 11 of his feature starts on the season. Hurst was a standout racer himself, winning three USAC Regional Midget main events during the 1990s at the Indianapolis Speedrome.

Rain was the biggest winner throughout the series season, claiming 12 victories. However, six drivers were able to stop the rain and reach victory lane in 2025: Nelson, Luke Hall, Bryce Massingill, Zach Wigal, Jakeb Boxell and Matt Lux.

Lux (Manilla, Indiana) finished a career best second in the standings, his third consecutive year inside the top-five. He won once at Honest Abe Roofing Lincoln Park Speedway in September, leading all 25 laps. Lux was recognized with the VMS Motorsports Quick Time of the Year award after accumulating a total five fast qualifying times between full points and non-points special events during the season.

Massingill (Troy, Ohio), the 2024 series champ, finished third in the championship with three points race victories while also becoming the winningest driver in series history with his 16th career score in the Mike Streicher Memorial at Limaland Motorsports Park. He added two more triumphs at Fremont Speedway and Moler for a total of three wins on the year and emerged with his fifth consecutive top-three points finish.

Hall (Ludlow Falls, Ohio) also notched three points wins on the season, leading all but the first lap at Lawrenceburg Speedway in August. Then, in October's season finale at Montpelier, he doubled up with two wins in a single evening. Ian Creager (Covington, Ohio) returned to the top-five of the points for the fifth time in his career. Brayden Schwartz (Troy, Ohio) earned the Most Improved Driver award after moving up from 11th in the 2024 standings to sixth this season.

The Wally Sexton Rookie of the Year award went to Buddy Hollmeyer (Cincinnati, Ohio), a former Kenyon Midget racer who migrated to the Midwest Thunder series to finish seventh in the final point tally. Jalen Cox (Winchester, Indiana) was the second best Rookie with the series, taking 13th. Cox was honored with the Rosewood Machine and Tool Company Precision Move of the Year.

Zach Wigal won twice, as the 2023 series champ wired all 25 laps on two separate occasions at both Atomic Speedway in June and again at Millstream in August.

Jakeb Boxell (Zanesville, Indiana) made the two biggest charges of the series season, and therefore, was awarded the 2025 Performance Powder Coating Hard Charger of the Year award. Boxell went 23rd to 2nd in June at Millstream, then made the most miraculous move of the year by racing from 18th to the win in September's Ashlea Albertson Memorial at Circle City Raceway, making the winning move around Michael Magic with three laps remaining.

Three non-points special events were held throughout the 2025 season. Hall has competed (and won) at Ohio's Eldora Speedway for more than two decades, but in May, he accomplished something he never achieved before – winning a midget race at the Big E by racing from eighth to first to check it off that list.

Furthermore, Massingill overtook Hall for the lead with three laps remaining to score the victory in a June special at Waynesfield Raceway Park. Daltyn England (Springfield, Illinois), meanwhile, closed out the season with a special event winning performance at Coles County Speedway, a race co-sanctioned by MARA.

Five drivers started all 11 points paying features during the season: Buddy Hollmeyer, Matt Lux, Cole Morgan, Tyler Nelson & Brayden Schwartz.

Massingill is First Two-Time Mike Streicher Memorial Winner

Elida, Ohio (May 9, 2025).....Troy, Ohio's Bryce Massingill became the first two-time winner of the Mike Streicher Memorial presented by Post Printing on Friday night at Elida, Ohio's Limaland Motorsports Park.

With heavy rain beginning the week, it was questionable whether Limaland would be able to run, but the staff and crew pulled together and the racetrack was pristine for the fifth annual event honoring the memory of the 1991 USAC National Midget champion.

In the 25-lap A-Main, Chett Gehrke and Massingill led the field to the green with Gehrke grabbing the early lead. Caution flew on lap two as Boxell came to a stop on the front stretch with a broken fuel pump, ending his bid to win back-to-back Streicher Memorial races.

Gehrke resumed his lead on the restart, but Massingill took the lead on lap five and never looked back. Zach Wigal, the 2023 Mike Streicher Memorial winner, charged to second on lap 18, but wasn't able to close on Massingill, who won and became the first two-time victor of the Streicher Memorial after also winning in 2022.

It's All Hall at Eldora's USAC Midwest Thunder Midget Race

Rossburg, Ohio (May 17, 2025).....Luke Hall has competed (and won) at Rossburg, Ohio's Eldora Speedway for more than two decades, but on Saturday night, he accomplished something he never achieved before – winning a midget race at the Big E.

The Ludlow Falls, Ohio racer checked that off the list during Saturday's Family Fireworks Night Presented by Casey's USAC Midwest Thunder Speed2 Midget non-points special event.

Starting eighth, Hall hustled his way to the lead by lap seven of the 20-lap feature, passing race long leader Matt Lux who had won both previous USAC Midwest Thunder features at Eldora in 2023 and 2024.

From there, Hall led the remaining 14 laps to score the win over reigning series champion Bryce Massingill while fast qualifier Lux crossed the line in third, Luke Lemons fourth and Michael Magic fifth.

Heat race victories were captured by Hall, Stratton Briggs, Lux and Jalen Cox.

A Full Nelson for Tyler at Millstream

Findlay, Ohio (June 15, 2025).....Tyler Nelson raced from his 8th place starting position to score a USAC Midwest Thunder Speed2 Midget victory on Sunday night at Findlay, Ohio's Millstream Speedway.

Nelson (Olathe, Kansas) picked his way through the field from the outside of the fourth row while Bryce Massingill and Luke Hall swapped the lead back and forth for much of the 25-lap main event.

Massingill led the opening 13 circuit before Luke Hall led the next three. Massingill surged back to the front to lead laps 17, 18 and 19. That's when Nelson made his charge to the front past defending series champion Massingill on lap 20.

From there, Nelson paced the final six laps to earn his first career USAC Midwest Thunder victory in his own No. 91.

Nelson, who was also the VMS Motorsports Fast Qualifier, was followed to the line by Performance Powder Coating Hard Charger Jakeb Boxell who made a miraculous +21 charge from 23rd to 2nd! Matt Lux grabbed third with Gunnar Lucius fourth and Buddy Hollmeyer fifth.

Massingill Marches to Waynesfield Victory

Waynesfield, Ohio (June 19, 2025).....Bryce Massingill overtook Luke Hall for the lead with three laps remaining to score the victory during Thursday night's USAC Midwest Thunder Speed2 Midget non-points special event feature at Ohio's Waynesfield Raceway Park.

Massingill (Troy, Ohio) started the 25-lap main event seventh on the grid but steadily worked his way forward to third on lap 20 and to second on lap 21. On lap 23, Massingill got by racelong leader Luke Hall (Ludlow Falls, Ohio) to take over the lead and the win in his family-owned No. 35.

Ninth starting Jakeb Boxell (Zanesville, Indiana) took second from Hall on the final lap to finish in the runner-up spot. Hall, who led a race-high 22 of 25 laps, came home third. Jalen Cox (Winchester, Indiana) crossed the line fourth while Tyler Nelson (Olathe, Kansas) rounded out the top-five.

Montpelier, Indiana (October 4, 2025).....Luke Hall doubled up by winning both 20-lap USAC Midwest Thunder Speed2 Midget feature events on Saturday night at Indiana's Montpelier Speedway, the final two series points-paying events of the season.

With his third and sixth place finishes in the two respective feature events, Tyler Nelson of Olathe, Kansas captured the 2025 USAC Midwest Thunder Speed2 Midget driving championship.

The first feature of the evening was the makeup date for the event rained out on August 16. In this one, Nelson led the opening nine laps before the eighth place starting Hall (Ludlow Falls, Ohio) took control on the 10th lap and led the remaining 10 circuits. Hall was followed to the line by Performance Powder Coating Hard Charger Bryce Massingill, Nelson, Ian Creager and Jalen Cox.

In the second of the two features, Hall started sixth and methodically moved his way forward. Drew Rader (lap 1), Michael Magic (laps 2-3) and Matt Lux (laps 4-8) swapped the lead early in the going before Lux once again found his way to the front in his Kyle Heitmeyer owned machine, then led the final 12 laps to win again over Bryce Massingill while Stratton Briggs took third with Rader fourth and Lux fifth.

For Hall, it was his second and third points-paying series victories of the year and the sixth and seventh of his career.

Nelson was the VMS Motorsports Fast Qualifier with a lap of 15.094 seconds. Lux was the winner of the Performance Electronics heat race one with Hall taking Stiefel Home & Auto heat race two, Stratton Briggs scoring Hoosier Auto Racing Fans heat three and Bryce Massingill Performance Electronics heat four.

Massingill captured Performance Powder Coating Hard Charger honors in the first feature, starting 19th after going to a backup car and advancing 17 spots to finish in the runner-up position.

Buddy Hollmeyer received the Rosewood Machine & Tool Precision Move after advancing 10 positions from 18th to 8th in the first feature.

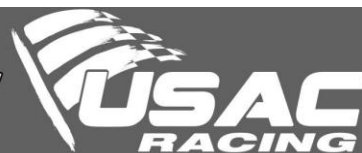
