

Vogler Doubles Up in the New Decade

Rich Vogler's aspiration at the beginning of 1980 was, among other things, to win the USAC National Sprint Car championship. He continued to drive midgets as often as possible but was resigned to the fact that he would run into conflicts of dates and would have to miss a few. It transpired that the conflicts were not as frequent as he had predicted, and on July 11, Rich became the USAC National Midget point leader.

"Can you believe it?" he mused. "I've tried really hard to win the championship in the past. This year, I'm only going to the races I could make, and just out there having fun. I'm leading the points and I wasn't even trying!"

Vogler, of course, was being nonchalant. What he meant was that he had not considered being in a position to lead a series in which he was not totally active. The musing continued in the middle of July as he glanced down the schedule and a smile crept across his face. "I wonder," he thought. "I wonder what would be the chances of winning both of them."

The result was that, amazingly enough, Vogler did win the Sprint and Midget titles in a single year. To that point, Pancho Carter had been the only driver to win both titles in a career. Nobody, not even back into the 1930s, could claim that.

The path to the Midget title was a topsy-turvy one with 16 lead changes among nine different drivers: Vogler, Mel Kenyon, Sleepy Tripp, Lonnie Caruthers, Bob Wente, Jeff Heywood, Jeff Nuckles, Jerry Weeks and Terry Wente. In terms of feature wins, 14 drivers recorded at least one in 1980 with Tripp the most proficient at six. Vogler and Kenyon recorded five each.

The point spread between Vogler and Kenyon after the 32-race season was a mere three points. Since Vogler never scored any less than seven at any event he attended, to have passed up one more would have cost him the title. Kenyon, who referred to himself as "just a 47-year-old kid," had now lost the last two titles by a mere seven points combined. In non-qualifiers race, he and brother Don's 3K Racing Enterprises team won their seventh career entrant championship.

Vogler had three regular rides during the year, starting out with Don Welch for dirt tracks and Bob Lockard (who succumbed to cancer near the end of the year) on paved tracks then finished with the family car. Rich and his dad, Don, made history by posting the first father-son 1-2 finish in USAC competition in July at Kokomo (Ind.) Speedway. Rich won.

For the second straight year, a driver from outside the USA border scored Rookie of the Year honors. In 1980, it was Canadian Trevor Boys of Calgary, Alta. Meanwhile, Indiana's Warren Mockler was named the series' Most Improved Driver. Colorado National Speedway race organizer and car owner Roger Mauro was the recipient of the Jim Blunk Award for his contributions to the image and prestige of the USAC National Midget division.

At Winchester (Ind.) Speedway in July, Ken Schrader pitted for an engine adjustment prior to the start of the 30-lap feature, then proceeded to pass every car on the track, catching leader Vogler on lap 20 and went on to win the caution-free race despite starting last in the 19-car field. His record time of 8:45.19 shattered Bob Wente's 1962 time by two whole minutes.

When Pam Drangmeister pushed off for the feature at Indianapolis Raceway Park in August, she became the second woman to start a USAC Midget feature, finishing 18th. Steve Lotshaw became the first driver ever to climb Pikes Peak in a midget on October 6, driving the Hank and Scot Hersh Truckers Volkswagen to the summit.

Tragedy struck November's Turkey Night Grand Prix when 23-year-old Bob Carey of Woodstock, Ill. suffered a fatal head injury during a qualifying attempt at Ascot Park. He passed away in an area hospital three days following the crash.

Safety committee recommendations that were passed starting this season included the requirement of quick-disconnect steering wheels in all cars; the banishment of titanium axles; and a beefing up of roll cage thickness.

The USAC board vetoed the inclusion of a new two-valve motorcycle engine in the USAC Midget division. The competition commission had recommended that a V-8 engine, which used a Kawasaki block and heads, be allowed to compete.

However, the board overturned that recommendation, with USAC president Dick King stating, "the direction we take should be to standardize engines to keep cost down, not to encourage innovation and sophistication that increases costs."

USAC charter member Les Kimbrell was appointed chief steward of the midget division, taking over for Herman Skiles. Starting work with AAA in the early 1950's, Les was also the official scorer for USAC's first Midget race on January 8, 1956.
