

No Wins, No Problem for Olson

"I can see that National Championship in my grasp. It's there, and I really want it. It's the last thing I think about when I go to bed at night and the first thing I think about in the morning."

The words of Kevin Olson, a steady and heady 31-year-old from Rockford, Ill., came to fruition in 1982 as he became the first driver to win the USAC National Midget title without winning a single feature. Showing up for every race, making features and producing consistent top-10 finishes were the key ingredients of Olson's title performance in Lee Carey's Volkswagen midgets, evidenced by top-ten finishes in 14 of 21 features, two seconds, three thirds and three fifths.

Olson ran third in January's season opener indoors at the Allen County War Memorial Coliseum in Fort Wayne, Ind. behind first-time series victor Dick Pole and runner-up Kenneth Nichols. Another first-time winner, Alan Brown, won the second Fort Wayne event in January while Steve Lotshaw became the first driver in 24 years to claim back-to-back indoor titles.

Ascot Park in Gardena, Calif. was where KO took over and clinched in 198, 2. Olson assumed the point lead for the first time with a sixth-place finish in March's outdoor opener at Ascot Park. As events unfolded, Olson was destined to stay in front of the pack for the remainder of the season as he secured the championship in October at Ascot by finishing 13th.

Olson's championship represents a magnificent personal triumph for his own car owner, Lee Carey. Two years prior, Lee lost his son Bob in the family midget. The younger Carey was fatally injured when his car flipped during QUALIFYING for the Turkey Night Grand Prix at Ascot Park on Thanksgiving night in 19, 80. One would have forgiven the heartbroken Lee Carey had he completely turned his back on racing. But he did not.

Chris Maxson of McHenry, Ill. finished 24th in points to earn Rookie of the Year honors, now named in memory of longtime series supervisor Bob Stroud. Steve Knepper was named the Most Improved Driver. Indianapolis (Ind.) Speedrome promoter John Stiles was honored as the recipient of the Jim Blunk Award for his contributions to USAC Midget racing.

Mel Kenyon reached a major milestone in July at Kokomo (Ind.) Speedway as he notched his 100th career series victory. Just four days prior, Kenyon came narrowly close to the century mark when he was passed by Greg Leffler for the lead on the last lap in the Night Before the 4th at Indianapolis Raceway Park. In May, Kenyon's 99th win at Santa Fe Speedway in Hinsdale, Ill. gave him an all-time series record of 21 straight seasons with a feature win between 1962-198, 2. Mel went on to finish as the runner-up in the series standings for the sixth time and was voted as the series' Most Popular Driver.

Third in the standings was Ken Schrader who won four times in 16 starts. Schrader won the June 10 feature at Kokomo (Ind.) Speedway, then scored a double at Raceway Park in Beaver Dam, Wis. on July 31, winning both the midget and companion sprint car A-Mains. He repeated the next day with another victory at South Dakota's Hartford Speedway.

Finishing fourth in just 12 starts was Vogler who put together a string of three consecutive victories in August and September, winning at Springfield (Ill.) Speedway, followed by more at Belle-Clair Speedway in Belleville, Ill. and at Godfrey (Ill.) Speedway. He grabbed the fourth in October with a win in the 4-Crown Nationals at Ohio's Eldora Speedway.

Ron Shuman swept both 100-lap dirt races, besting a 33-car field in the Hut 100 at the Terre Haute (Ind.) Action Track during September, then scored an incredible fourth consecutive Turkey Night Grand Prix dub at Ascot Park in November.

Shuman won the Hut 100 for car owner Nick Gojmeric, whose cars won six features in 1982 with three different drivers at the helm. Shuman scored once, Schrader four times and even sprint car ace Doug Wolfgang graced victory lane by putting one in the win column for the first and only time with the division at the Iowa State Fairgrounds in April. The combined effort earned the entrant championship for Belleville, Ill. native Nick Gojmeric and his Nick's S.O.S. Garage Volkswagen.

During a March event at California's Baylands Raceway Park, driver Floyd Alvis blew the engine in his Lennie Gonsel-owned Volkswagen during hot laps. So, he hopped into his truck and made the 50-mile round trip to his home, returning after qualifying concluded with his own midget in tow. He made it back in time to finish third in his heat and ninth in the feature.

USAC registrar M.A. Todd passed away during the 1982 season, as did winning car owners George Gamester, John Noutary and Dallas Garman as well as driver Gays Biro, a three-time feature winner with the series in its inaugural year of 1956.
