

Reeves Puts a Ring On It

During November's season finale at Imperial Valley Raceway in Imperial, California, Stevie Reeves' became the new owner of a flat, oval shaped wedding ring after having an engine set down on it while his team performed a motor swap.

Fortunately, his finger maintained its original shape, and soon after, the 25-year-old was fitted for a different type of ring – a championship ring – as he wrapped up the 1992 USAC National Midget driving title with a 105-point margin to boot.

All of it came following a heartbreaking championship defeat in the final race of 1991 and led to a subsequent bitterly long offseason that saw Reeves step into a new role as the full-time driver of the "Nine Car" chosen to pursue the elusive title.

"The winter was tough," Reeves admitted. "We decided right after the finale to come back this year and make up for it."

Despite winning the second race of the season at Louisville (Ky.) Motor Speedway in April, for the most part, the year started slowly for Reeves and the Steve Lewis/Performance Industry/Beast/Gaerte team. At midseason, Reeves had slipped to an 83-point deficit after a particularly rough spring stretch which had relegated him back to fifth in points.

"The month of May was rough," Reeves said. "I broke my shoulder blade in three places and separated it after hitting the wall at IRP. Dr. Terry Trammell sent me to therapy, and I was able to race again, but I had a lot of points to make up."

After a string of bad luck, the turning point came with a win at Colorado's Beacon Hill Speedway in late July. Reeves passed the idle Dan Drinan for the point lead in September and promptly finished nine of the next eleven features inside the top-five, capping that run with his third and final victory of 1992 in September at Lebanon, Missouri's I-44 Speedway.

The consistency and the dagger of a third feature triumph solidified Reeves' position ahead of the pack as he entered the final stretch of the season, racking up a pair of top-four finishes to lock up the title before the finale, which he sat out and watched as a spectator knowing he had already clinched, a major contrast from his nightmare ending a year ago.

"It was a big relief to lock up the title early this time," Reeves said. "Last year's finale wasn't much fun, and it was kind of scary for me. I enjoyed it a lot more this time, knowing I already had it wrapped up."

Dan Drinan was among the standouts of ESPN's Saturday Night Thunder at IRP, winning twice, but suffered critical injuries in an August crash at the Illinois State Fairgrounds' Springfield Mile in which he flipped 12 times. He was leading the standings at the time but was unable to compete the rest of the year. He made a miraculous recovery and was able to return to action in time for the 1993 season. For his 1992 efforts, he was named the series' Most Improved Driver.

Doug Kalitta's first four career USAC wins came in 1992. Kenneth Nichols' trio of triumphs were the first three of his career after going winless since 1978. Steve Knepper's Hut 100 score at the Terre Haute (Ind.) Action Track came after Stan Fox was disqualified for failing post-race tech inspection, which found his car to be carrying fuel that didn't meet USAC specs.

Johnny Parsons' 4-Crown Nationals victory at Ohio's Eldora Speedway came in the first series win for a Vogler-powered engine. Ron Shuman's amazing run of Turkey Night Grand Prix success continued with win number seven at Bakersfield (Calif.) Speedway. Russ Gamester's triumph at Bloomington (Ind.) Speedway was a homecoming of sorts. Bob Tattersall had driven the Gamester family car to win the most recent series race at the track in 1970, 22 years prior. Mike Streicher was impressive in the 40-lap series debut at Portsmouth (Ohio) Raceway Park as he lapped the entire field. Page Jones was awesome in his last-lap victory over Tony Elliott at Kokomo (Ind.) Speedway, winning the race despite spinning twice!

Drivers Mack McClellan and Pepi Marchese were seriously injured in separate 1992 accidents. McClellan rolled over 15 times in a violent flip at IRP while Marchese rolled several times in a tangle at Eldora before being tagged by another car.

Tony Elliott won three features to propel Ralph Potter of Indianapolis, Ind. to the entrant championship by 24 points over Steve Lewis. Thereafter, the Potter family was named as the recipient of the Jim Blunk Award for their many contributions to USAC Midget racing. Brian Gerster, a fifth place finisher at Portsmouth, was named series Rookie of the Year.

Meanwhile, Copenhagen/Skoal Racing came on board as the series' title sponsor in 1992. Participants with the series also were required to use approved Hoosier Racing Tires under a new one-manufacturer tire rule at all pavement events.
