

Teenage Gordon Flashes to Title

"Few drivers ever win a National championship. It's something that helps bring a lot of attention to a driver's ability."

No driver caught more attention for his generational talent in 1990 than the sensation who uttered those very words – Jeff Gordon. In 1990, he performed exceptionally at dirt and paved tracks across the country while becoming USAC's first ever teenage national champion and emerging as the champ in a three-way battle for the National Midget driving title.

The 19-year-old Vallejo, Calif. native was phenomenal in the early season, winning six of the first seven races in which he drove. He also set fast time in his first eight appearances aboard Rollie Helmling's Diet Pepsi Pontiac out of Vincennes, Ind. His victories came for two different teams, winning seven for Helmling and once for Wisconsin's Wilke Racers.

Despite all the success, Gordon was absent from five of the 26 events, which kept him from clinching the title until the final race of the season, fending off reigning champ Russ Gamester by 45 points with Mike Streicher third, 51 behind.

"At first, we were just running selected races and winning," Gordon stated. "But then we started running for points and things started going downhill. It seemed we were taking every little chance to gain points and ended up hurting ourselves in the process. Fortunately, we were able to win enough and put together enough good finishes to hang on at the end."

The original rising star to make his name on ESPN Thunder, Gordon won the Night Before the 500 at IRP for the second straight May to become the first back-to-back winner of the event since Jimmy Davies won three-straight from 1960-62.

All throughout the year, Gordon was simply spectacular. In June, he set a new midget track record then proceeded to sweep both ends of a Sprint/Midget doubleheader in his first ever race visit to the high banks of Salem (Ind.) Speedway. This came after setting a new one-lap midget track record in qualifying the night before at Winchester (Ind.) Speedway.

On July 3, Gordon and Helmling took the specially designed pavement car to Tri-City Speedway in Granite City, Ill., and promptly won on the dirt utilizing the very same machine. Less than two weeks later, Gordon was back on top again, driving underneath Stan Fox through turns three and four on the final lap to reign at Wisconsin's Angell Park Speedway.

The following outing at Angell Park in September proved to be one of his finest performances, even though it was one of the very few he failed to win. Early on, he got upside down during the DASH and was forced to Helmling's backup car. Forced to start at the tail, Gordon charged from 13th to 1st in the D-Main, 14th to 1st in the C-Main and 18th to 2nd in the semi. He blew an engine in the feature after only six laps, which abruptly ended his memorable alphabet soup run.

In September, Gordon scored a welcome back victory during the 38th Hut Hundred, which returned to its Terre Haute (Ind.) Action Track roots after a four-year absence, then punctuated it with a chilly day score at Winchester in November.

Gamester won three of the first five and held a hefty early point lead in his bid to repeat, but a midseason crash at Salem (Ind.) Speedway and subsequent mechanical problems KO'd his chances, although he caught Streicher for second in the end. Streicher won at Lawrenceburg (Ind.) Speedway and in the series debut at Florence (Ky.) Speedway to earn enough points to claim a second career entrant title for his father, Jim Streicher, by a mere two points over Helmling.

Stan Fox finished fourth in the standings and corralled his share of big wins. A disqualification of winner Wally Pankratz during a post-race fuel check at Ohio's Eldora Speedway in September left Fox as the winner of the richest winner's share in series history up to that point, a record \$10,000 first prize at the 4-Crown Nationals. Fox bested a field of 107 entries to win the Turkey Night Grand Prix in November, the final event ever held at Gardena, California's Ascot Park.

Roy Caruthers ran up front and worked his way to fifth in the standings, which earned him the series' Most Improved Driver award. The Gamester family was feted with the Jim Blunk Award for their tireless dedication to USAC Midget racing.

Dan Ford, an aircraft mechanic for McDonnell-Douglas by day, became the series' first Rookie of the Year from Missouri. He finished 15th in the standings with multiple seventh-place feature results at the Illinois tracks of Santa Fe and Tri-City.

USAC was stunned in July when its winningest driver, 95-time National Midget feature victor and five-time National Midget champ, Rich Vogler, was killed on the final lap of a USAC Sprint Car race at Salem just five days shy of his 40th birthday.
