

The Buckeye “Streichs” One

“I knew that if I was ever going to win a championship, this had to be the year,” an unabashed Mike Streicher confessed after wrapping up a come-from-behind 1991 USAC National Midget driving championship in the final race of the season.

Streicher’s accomplishment is remarkable when one considers that he built his own Hawk chassis, towed his own rig and handled the wrenches all while making every series feature in 1990-1991. Added to the equation is that the Findlay, Ohio native constructed a new car late in the season, made specifically for the title stretch, completing it in just eight days.

The workload of taking the lead on all sides of the operation takes its toll both physically and mentally. On Streicher’s mind throughout the season was the risk/reward factor and how much he could risk while chasing the ultimate reward.

“I guess I’m more conservative driving my own car. I think about what might happen if I make a mistake and how much it’ll cost to fix, etc.,” Streicher acknowledged. “I decided to build a new car after the race at Lakeside in late October, a compromise between a pavement and dirt chassis. I really believe the mechanic in me helped me win the title.”

In one of the most hotly contested title races in series history, Streicher earned his reward while scoring just one feature win at Richmond (Ky.) Raceway amid his come-from-behind title run, making him the first Buckeye to win the series driving championship. His father Jim also earned his third career series entrant title following previous crowns in 1983 and 1990.

Consistency kept Streicher atop the points as he maintained a comfortable edge on Rookie Doug Kalitta. By July, Stevie Reeves vaulted into contention when he caught Kalitta for second, then tallied back-to-back victories in September’s Pepsi Nationals at Wisconsin’s Angell Park Speedway and in the Hut 100 at the Terre Haute (Ind.) Action Track.

Reeves then won at Lakeside Speedway in Kansas City, Kan. in October to move into the number one slot for the first time, leaving him 17 points ahead of Streicher entering a critical four-race swing on the west coast to close the season.

Reeves stepped into the seat of the Zarounian Motorsports machine for the west coast swing when his Wilke Racers ride didn’t make the tow out west. For Streicher, bad luck and good fortune both hit in the penultimate round, the Turkey Night Grand Prix, which was held for the first and only time at Saugus (Calif.) Speedway, the series’ first visit since 1966.

“When we stalled on the front stretch, I thought the title went right out the window. I thought it was over,” reflected Streicher on his mechanical issues at Turkey Night. “Fortunately, we got restarted quickly and only lost one lap.”

Streicher finished ninth at Turkey Night, later passing the stricken car of Reeves who fell victim to a broken sway bar while running inside the top-10. Streicher’s subsequent fast time in the finale at El Centro, California’s Imperial Valley Raceway earned him eight valuable points, which boosted him from four behind to four ahead, and set up a spectacular conclusion to the season between the two friends. Streicher had helped Reeves when he was racing winged sprint cars in Ohio.

Meanwhile, Reeves’ terrible, horrible, no good, very bad day began with a practice crash in his Zarounian ride. Reeves second car of the evening, owned by Harry Conklin, erupted in flames at the finish of his heat race. In his third different car of the night, for Dave Calderwood, Reeves’ attempt to win the crown ended on the third lap of the feature when he hit the turn one wall and flipped. Under the red, Reeves promptly climbed out and walked over to congratulate Streicher.

Elsewhere, Scott Hatton suffered a broken ankle in a flip at Angell Park in July when his car came to an abrupt stop atop a turn one fence post. The lengthy extraction forced the cancellation of the night’s feature with 4 of 50 laps completed. Jeff Gordon pocketed \$10,000 with his 12th and final career series victory during the 4-Crown Nationals at Ohio’s Eldora Speedway. Stan Fox, at Saugus, became the first driver to win Turkey Night on dirt and pavement in consecutive years.

Shannon Finley of Kingsport, Mo. was killed in a four-car heat race tangle in April at Tri-City Speedway. The 1987-88 Saint Louis Auto Racing Association champ raced successfully despite having just one leg following injuries suffered while serving in the U.S. Navy during the Vietnam War. The veteran of nearly 20 years of racing was just 44 years old.

Future NHRA Top Fuel star Doug Kalitta finished an impressive third in the standings to win Rookie of the Year. Brendyn "Tyce" Carlson found the glamour of a ninth place finish in the points to earn Most Improved Driver honors. USAC Western States official Dick Hindman was the honoree of the Jim Blunk Memorial Award for his contributions to the sport.
