

Reeves-Peat for Stevie

Stevie Reeves lost the title in the 1991 finale, then held a late season lead en route to the 1992 crown. He experienced both plot lines down the stretch in 1993, holding the lead, losing it, then regaining it – all within the span of weeks – to become the first back-to-back champ since Sleepy Tripp in 1975-1976, a driver he felt a championship kinship with.

“I’d been through both scenarios before. I took my best shot this year and it worked out okay,” the humble 26-year-old Reeves noted following his 1993 USAC National Midget championship season. “It’s neat to win two-in-a-row and match Sleepy’s feat. When I was nine years old, I used to go over to Sleepy’s garage and watch him work on his car.”

While standing just two points behind Kenny Irwin Jr. in July, Reeves’ season almost came to an abrupt halt at Indianapolis Raceway Park. There, his car climbed the wheel of another and launched into the catch fence between turns three and four. Despite the violence of the crash, Stevie never considered it a threat to his drive for the title.

“I didn’t know I was knocked out,” he related. “When I woke up, I turned the fuel off and I thought we probably couldn’t fix the car in time for the semi. I didn’t realize the fuel tank was gone and I didn’t even know I was over the wall!”

Reeves won five races, all on different tracks, driving the Steve Lewis/Performance Racing Industry Beast/Gaerte to scores at Winchester (Ind.) Speedway, Indianapolis Raceway Park and Lawrenceburg (Ind.) Speedway, while adding wins at Louisville (Ky.) Motor Speedway and Bloomington (Ind.) Speedway, but had to outlast a late-season challenge from Irwin to win the crown in dramatic come-from behind fashion in November’s finale at Ventura (Calif.) Raceway.

Irwin entered the final three races with a two-point lead over Reeves, then fell behind after failing to transfer into the feature during the penultimate event, the Turkey Night Grand Prix, at Bakersfield (Calif.) Speedway. Irwin then trailed Reeves by 10 entering the finale at Ventura (Calif.) Raceway, and chances seemed dire when Irwin hit the wall during hot laps. However, after repairs, Irwin returned to post the second fastest qualifying time, which cut Reeves’ lead to four.

Reeves’ subsequent heat race victory extended his lead to seven, then he came from behind to pass Irwin in the feature. Irwin finished ninth while Reeves took sixth to lock up the title in a nail-biting affair, which was made all the more daunting due to mechanical woes that crept up on Reeves to begin the night and lingered all the way to the checkered.

“The engine problems at Ventura were frustrating,” Reeves lamented. “I switched cars with (teammate) Stan (Fox), and I wasn’t very familiar with the four-bar car, then the motor started to sour during the last 10 laps of the race. A lot of things can happen fast at Ventura, so I was glad to see the checkered flag. That’s when I knew I had the title.”

While 1993 proved to be the final championship for Reeves, for the Steve Lewis team with Bob East as crew chief, it was just the beginning of a dynasty. This year, the team captured the first of its 10 entrant titles over the next 12 seasons.

Irwin Jr., who won the season opener at Toronto, Ontario’s SkyDome, became the first series winner in Canada since Tripp in 1975. Irwin finished as the championship runner-up, 11 points behind, with three wins, which also included the richest victory in series history at the time, a record-breaking \$12,000 in August’s inaugural Mel Kenyon Classic at IRP.

Andy Michner finished third in the standings and was named the Most Improved Driver. The former motocross star, who won such events as the 250cc Outdoor Nationals and the World Mini Grand Prix, nailed his first USAC feature win in November at California’s Kings Speedway, which resulted in possibly the first Polish victory lap in USAC Midget history.

Chuck Leary, who won the first race he ever competed in at the age of 13 in a dirt dragster at Haspin Acres in Laurel, Ind., captured Rookie of the Year honors for 1993. Jim Naylor, the energetic Ventura Raceway promoter, announcer, track preparer and PR man, was the recipient of the Jim Blunk Award for his continued devotion to the sport.

Mark Gerke escaped serious injury during the most spectacular incident of the season, when a stuck throttle sent him over a wheel, into the wall, over the wall and into the woods beyond turn three during a July heat race at Winchester.

Onboard starters and clutches became required equipment for teams in 1993 with the intention of USAC presenting a more efficient program without the requirement of push trucks. Al Unser Jr. took the ceremonial honors of pacing the field in the fully equipped self-starting midget, the Steve Lewis No. 9, during the Hoosier Dome Invitational in January.
