

The Wise Choice for Champion

Ever since joining Tony Stewart Racing at the beginning of 2004, Josh Wise had experienced more than enough “seconds” in his USAC National Midget career. His best finish for TSR came in a second place run in 2004 and his second-place finish in the standings that same year had him, we assume, counting down the seconds until he could get redemption in 2005.

Entering his – you guessed it – second season for TSR in 2005, the Riverside, Calif. native made extra sure that he’d be first where it counted: in feature victories, in consistency and in the point standings. And that’s exactly what he made happen.

Wise landed the title by 172 points on the strength of a series-leading four victories, topped with consistency that saw him finish inside the top-ten in 18 of 21 starts to become the first Californian since Jason Leffler in 1999 to win the crown.

While TSR’s driver finished atop his respective standings, the entrant championship did not fall in line accordingly. Wilke-PAK Motorsports, with its combo pack of drivers Jerry Coons Jr. and Tracy Hines, earned their third entrant title, and their first since 1988, and thus, put an end to Steve Lewis’ streak of seven-straight entrant championships between 1998-2004.

Wise immediately got a jump on the competition. In the second showdown of the season in early May at The Raceway at Powercom Park in Wisconsin, he hit paydirt for the first time since the 2003 Belleville (Kan.) Midget Nationals, a performance which bumped him up to second in points. He then slotted into the top spot with a fifth-place result in late May at the Indianapolis Speedrome and steadily increased his lead throughout the summer without ever relinquishing it.

As the season progressed, Wise kept his distance as his closest competition came down with a bout of subpar results.

Wise added a pair of triumphs on high speed paved ovals in July at Ohio’s Toledo Speedway and Wisconsin’s Milwaukee Mile. His advantage became slightly less comfortable in August as Jerry Coons Jr. knocked down nine-straight top-fives, culminating in back-to-back winning performances at the Belleville (Kan.) Midget Nationals and at Salem (Ind.) Speedway.

USAC Indiana Midget Week debuted in August of 2005 as a trio of drivers earned their one and only victories of the season. Jay Drake captured the first round at Lawrenceburg and Davey Ray collected the second night at Gas City while reigning USAC Western States Midget champ Johnny Rodriguez migrated to the Midwest to snare the finale with a late-race pass to win the Hut 100 at Terre Haute. The consistent Shane Cottle came out on top as the inaugural USAC Indiana Midget Week titlist.

By Gas City, Coons had shrunk Wise’s point lead to 42, but he never got any closer. Wise stretched the interval out to over 100 in the ensuing weeks by virtue of five consecutive finishes within the top-seven, including a fourth win in the latter half of August during the final half-mile event at Illinois’ Tri-City Speedway before the track was converted to three-eighths.

Coons finished as the points runner-up while veteran Brad Kuhn, who won his first career series feature during June’s Buckeye Nationals at Ohio’s Limaland Motorsports Park, wound up third in points and was named the Most Improved Driver. Eighth in the standings was Darren Hagen who topped the voting for the USAC National Midget and Sprint Car Rookie of the Year awards, becoming the first driver ever to take both honors in the same season after finishing a best of fifth during September’s 4-Crown midget feature at Ohio’s Eldora Speedway. Ford Racing received the Jim Blunk Award.

Dave Darland won a pair of dirt races on bad fast half-mile dirt tracks, first in June at Ohio’s Eldora Speedway and during a July prelim night at Belleville. J.J. Yeley returned to the series to win the season-opening Copper World Classic at Phoenix International Raceway for the second year in a row, giving car owner Steve Lewis his team’s only victory of the year.

Michael Lewis took the Night Before the 500 with a last lap pass in May at IRP, then found the path to victory at Colorado’s Pikes Peak International Raceway in July. Teddy Beach grabbed his fourth and final career series A-Main in May at the

Indianapolis Speedrome while Dave Steele picked up a dub in July at Ohio's Mansfield Motorsports Speedway. In his only 2005 series start, Jason Leffler built his own car to top November's Turkey Night Grand Prix at Irwindale (Calif.) Speedway.

Five first-time winners emerged alongside Kuhn and Rodriguez in 2005. Longtime racer Scott Hatton did so in August at Angell Park; Danny Stratton dominated with a complete 4-Crown midget sweep at Eldora; and Bryan Clauson in October at Columbus, Ohio where he became the newest youngest winner in series history at 16 years, 3 months and 23 days old.

Owen Snyder III assumed the role of Director of Competition and Technical Operations for the series after working alongside Mike Devin in 2004. Snyder was the Indianapolis 500 winning chief mechanic in both 1992 and 1998.
