The Singapore Society of Oncology is organizing its 8th Medical Oncology Review Course in February 2026 for Medical Oncology Senior Residents, Registrars and Specialist Nurses. This course will be held via Zoom Video Conferencing.

The review course will be conducted over 4 days (13th – 15th February 2026, 21st February 2026).

Days 1-3 (13th February – 15th February 2026) will be a series of lectures, structured as an intensive revision course to prepare Senior Medical Oncology Trainees (SR3) for their specialist exit examinations. Medical Oncology Trainees (SR2) who are in the midst of their specialist training will also be able to appreciate this comprehensive 'survivor's guide' as they continue to accumulate knowledge and experience.

Day 4 (21st February 2026) is open only to local Singaporean Medical Oncology Trainees and those who will be taking their exit examination. This session will be a mock VIVA examination and is meant to give a semblance of what the actual examination will be like.

We also welcome Trainees and Specialist Nurses from Surgical Oncology, Palliative Medicine and Radiation Oncology to join us!
