<b>Evidence of Learning</b>	What types of artefacts will students include (e.g. written work, media, designs, reflections)?	
<b>Reflection Framework</b>	What structured reflection model will guide student reflection (e.g. What? So What? Now What?)?	
<b>Platform &amp; Template</b>	What digital platform or template will students use to build their portfolio?	
<b>Student Support</b>	What guidance, training, or class time will support portfolio development?	
<b>Faculty Review Model</b>	How will portfolios be reviewed, mentored, or assessed by faculty?	
<b>Assessment Alignment</b>	How will portfolio evidence be used for programme-level assessment or accreditation?	
<b>Evidence of Impact</b>	What feedback or data will indicate improved learning or assessment quality?	
<b>Key Enablers</b>	What institutional support, templates, or partnerships are required?	
<b>Local Adaptation Notes</b>	Constraints, accreditation considerations, or contextual modifications
