When you come in, come with the intention to

- Introduce yourself to people you don't yet know. Ask them about their projects. Share with them about yours.
- Work on your project, experiment, or research.
- Start or join meaningful conversations with other scholars.
- Contribute to the collective atmosphere of creativity.

Care for the space as if it were your own

- Leave no trace—tidy, reset furniture, wash dishes, and treat equipment gently.
- Take off your shoes or boots when entering.

Hard rules

- Work: Building 21 is a dedicated workplace for scholars actively pursuing projects. We ask that scholars refrain from using this space for work unrelated to their B21 project.
- Access: Only let in people you know or who are registered for an event (event hosts verify guests)
- Hours: Use the space only during regular hours (Mon–Fri, 10 AM–5 PM) unless approved by B21 staff
- Emergency Exits: Do not use emergency exits except in an actual emergency
- Alcohol: No alcohol without an official permit (violation = immediate suspension of access)
